KEY STORYLINES

- South Dakota State joins Georgia Tech and Oregon for the North Shore Showcase November 23-26 in Laie, Hawaii. Combined, these teams enter the tournament 14-1 on the season.
- SDSU is 3-1 on the year with its lone loss coming to No. 16 Duke by four points at First Bank & Trust Arena last weekend. Three of SDSU's four contests have been decided by five points or fewer.
- The Jacks are shooting 47.8 percent from the floor over four games and rank 33rd nationally in field goal shooting. They are nearly 40 percent from the 3-point line and rank 28th.
- Six Jackrabbits have scored at least 10 points at least once over the first four games. Six players have tallied at least five rebounds in a game this season.
- SDSU was voted No. 25 in the Nov. 12 version of the Coaches Poll but is now receiving votes in both the AP Poll and Coaches Poll. The Ducks will be the Jacks third ranked opponent of the season. Oregon is No. 23 in the Nov. 18 AP Poll and took over No. 25 from the Jackrabbits in the Coaches Poll on Nov. 19. SDSU is 18-42 against ranked opponents in the DI era.

- The Jacks' last win over a ranked opponent was a 76-71 win over then-No. 21 Creighton at home November 8.
- Brooklyn Meyer has picked up right where she left off a season ago, averaging 18.0 points, 6.0 rebounds and 1.5 blocks while shooting 55 percent. She scored a season-high 25 against Duke last week, four off her career high.
- Paige Meyer is doing a little bit of everything for SDSU, averaging 11.0 points, 5.5 assists and 4.0 rebounds per contest.
- Haleigh Timmer returns for her redshirt junior season after missing all of 2023-24 with an injury. She averages 13.0 points on 54 percent shooting.
- Mesa Byom comes off the bench to contribute 8.5 points and 6.5 rebounds per game.
- SDSU head coach Aaron Johnston won the 600th game of his 25-year SDSU career against then-No. 21 Creighton last week. Johnston's now-601 wins is 15th in the country among active DI head coaches.

MORE NOTABLES

ABOUT THIS MATCHUP

South Dakota State is set to take on Georgia Tech and Oregon at the North Shore Showcase in Laie, Hawaii Saturday and Tuesday, respectively.

The Jackrabbits enter the tournament with a 3-1 record. SDSU's only loss was a 75-71 defeat to No. 16 Duke at First Bank & Trust Arena.

Georgia Tech is 4-0 on the season and all four wins have been by a significant margin. Most recently, GT topped Georgia Tech 83-67 in Atlanta.

Oregon is 6-0 heading into the North Shore Showcase. Oregon has a 76-74 win over then-No.12 Baylor on its resume and is No. 23 in the latest AP Poll (November 18).

JACKRABBIT SUMMARY

South Dakota State enters the week with a 3-1 record in 2024-25. The Jacks have a ranked win over then-No. 21 Creighton on their resume and a loss to then-No.16 Duke.

The Jackrabbits are averaging 72.8 points per game with a 6.3 points per game scoring margin over their opponents. The team is shooting 48 percent on the year and 40 percent from the 3-point line. SDSU is also out-rebounding its opponents, 38 to 33 per game.

Four Jackrabbits are shooting better than 50 percent on the year - Mesa Byom (.556), Brooklyn Meyer (.547), Haleigh Timmer (.537) and Katie Vasecka (.500).

Brooklyn Meyer leads the Jackrabbits with 18.0 points and 1.5 blocks per game. She grabs 6.0 rebounds per game, one of three Jacks tallying 6.0 or more per contest.

Haleigh Timmer follows with 13.0 points and Paige Meyer scored 11.3 points per night. Paige Meyer also tallies 5.5 assists and 4.0 rebounds per game as the Jackrabbits' point guard.

Mesa Byom comes off the bench to add 8.5 points and a team-high 6.5 boards per game. Madison Mathiowetz scores 7.0 points per game to round out the top five scorers.

Kallie Theisen has started all four games and is tied for the team lead with 6.5 rebounds per game. She also averages 4.0 points.

SDSU returns 87 percent of its scoring from the 2023-24 season, including 93 percent of its 3-point buckets, and 85 percent of its rebounds from 2023-24.

SDSU is coming off a 27-6 record in 2023-24 and a fourth consecutive Summit League regular season title. SDSU returned to the NCAA Tournament for the 12th time in program history via its 11th Summit League Tournament Championship.

The Jackrabbits finished the Summit League slate with a 16-0 record, going unbeaten for the third time in four seasons. They were the first team in conference history to run the table in consecutive seasons.

SDSU's Brooklyn Meyer (POY, first team), Paige Meyer (first team) and Haleigh Timmer (second team) picked up preseason recognition from the Summit League.

The Ducks were among the favorites to win the NCAA Tournament that season before it was canceled due to Covid-19. Sabrina lonescu just missed a triple-double in that game with 12 points, 11 assists and seven rebounds.

Brooklyn Meyer, a junior, is the reigning Summit League Player of the Year and Defensive Player of the Year after a breakout sophomore season. She averaged 16.8 points on the season and shot .588 from the floor. Her 7.6 rebounds and 1.8 blocks per contest in 2023-24 also led the Jackrabbits. Meyer scored at least 20 points nine times last season, including a career-high 29 twice - vs. South Carolina State and North Dakota State.

Paige Meyer, a senior, was a Summit League First Team selection last season and is the reigning Summit League Tournament MVP. She was second on the team in 2023-24 with 15.2 points per game while dishing a team-best 4.0 assists per contest. Meyer was .503 from the floor and .422 from the 3-point line on the season. She set a new career high and SDSU Division I record with 37 points at Northern Arizona.

Haleigh Timmer returns for her redshirt junior season after missing 2023-24 with an injury. She was a Summit League second team selection as a sophomore in 2023 and was the Summit League Tournament MVP that year. Timmer was the Jackrabbits' second-leading scorer as a sophomore with 12.1 points per contest to go with 3.6 rebounds per game.

Madison Mathiowetz and Mesa Byom are also back from the 2023-24 starting lineup. Mathiowetz scored 11.5 points per game as a sophomore and played more than 30 minutes per game. She was deemed honorable mention all-Summit League. Byom contributed 6.7 rebounds and 1.1 blocks per game, both second on the team, and added 7.7 points, on average.

Kallie Theisen is back for her sixth and final season as a Jackrabbit. She also missed 2023-24 with an injury but was the Summit League Sixth Woman of the Year as a junior in 2022-23. Theisen tallied 6.1 points, 6.4 rebounds (team high) and 1.3 blocks (team high) that season.

Ellie Colbeck and Jenna Hopp played in all 33 games a season ago, scoring 4.9 and 4.8 points per game, respectively.

Madysen Vlastuin appeared in 21 contests as a junior in 2023-24 before a season-ending injury. Prior to her injury, Vlastuin played a team-high 30.9 minutes per game with 7.2 points and 5.0 rebounds her game. Her .413 clip from 3-point range was second on the team.

Hilary Behrens is a redshirt-freshman after missing her first season on campus with an injury. Five true freshmen join the Jackrabbit roster - Mahli Abdouch, Jaidyn Dunn, Emilee Fox, Claire Sheppard and Katie Vasecka. All five are South Dakota natives with a lot of success in their high school careers.

SUMMIT LEAGUE SUCCESS

South Dakota State has won a Summit Leagueleading 10 regular season titles and 11 tournament championships in the program's 17 years in the conference. The Jackrabbits have won at least a share of the regular season title five of the last six seasons.

Entering 2024-25, SDSU has won 47 straight Summit League regular season games and 40 consecutive games against Summit League opponents (including postseason contests). The Jackrabbits are 65-1 in the Summit League regular season beginning with the 2020-21 season.

The Jackrabbits went 16-0 in 2023-24 to win their fourth consecutive regular season. They were the first Summit League team in history to go unbeaten in back-to-back seasons.

SDSU has made 12 trips to the NCAA Tournament by way of 11 Summit League tournament championships and one at-large berth. The Jackrabbits are 36-5 all-time in the Summit League postseason.

The Jacks beat No. 9 Omaha, No. 4 South Dakota and No. 2 North Dakota State in their way to the 2024 Summit League Championship crown. Paige Meyer (MVP), Brooklyn Meyer and Madison Mathiowetz were named to the all-tournament team

WATCH LISTS

Junior Brooklyn Meyer was one of 20 players named to the watch list for the Lisa Leslie Center of the Year Award.

Junior Brooklyn Meyer and senior Paige Meyer were named to the watch list for the Becky Hammon Mid-Major Player of the Year Award.

Head Coach Aaron Johnston was named to the watch list for the Kathy Delaney-Smith Mid-Major Coach of the Year Award.

SUPER SENIORS

Kallie Theisen, Mesa Byom and Madysen Vlastuin are set to exhaust their NCAA eligibility this season as they use their Covid-19 bonus seasons.

Paige Meyer is also a senior, however she is only in her fourth season as she does not qualify for the Covid-waiver season.

NEWCOMER NOTES

SDSU adds five freshmen to the roster this season, joining redshirt freshman Hilary Behrens.

Hilary Behrens joined the Jackrabbits for the 2023-24 season following her high school career at Brandon Valley High School in Brandon, South Dakota. She was a three-time first-team all-state selection for the Lynx and the 2023 Class AA Player of the Year. She scored 1,382 points in her high school career and averaged 17.3 points, 5.5 rebounds and 2.7 steals as a senior

Mahli Abdouch was the 2024 recipient of the South Dakota Miss Basketball honor and was named the SD Player of the Year by a number of organizations, including the SDBCA, Max Preps Player of the Year, Sioux Falls Live, KELO and Argus Leader. Also in 2024, Abdouch was a McDonald's All-American nominee and played in the South Dakota all-star game. Abdouch was a three-time all-state and all-conference selection and four-time all-state tournament team honoree. She won two state championships with O'Gorman High School (2022, 2024) and was a consolation state champ in 2023. Abdouch scored 1,261 points in her high school career, which ranks second in O'Gorman history, and tallied 362 career assists, 249 career steals and 163 career 3-pointers, all of which rank first all-time at O'Gorman.

Jaidyn Dunn was a finalist for South Dakota Miss Basketball and was named to the Sioux Falls Live Super Six squad in 2024. She played in the 2024 South Dakota all-star game and was a three-time all-conference and two-time all-state selection in high school. She finished in third place at the high school state tournament three times and was on three all-state tournament teams. As a senior, Jefferson averaged 12.5 points, 8.0 rebounds and 2.5 blocks per game.

Emilee Fox was a finalist for South Dakota Miss Basketball as a senior in 2024 and played in the 2024 South Dakota all-star game. She was a five-time all-state selection and six-time all-conference honoree since her varsity debut as a seventh grader. Fox tallied 21.1 points, 7.3 rebounds and 3.8 assists per game as a senior and graduated from Mount Vernon as their all-time leading scorer. She helped the Titans reach two state tournaments in her career (2019, 2024).

Claire Sheppard was a finalist for South Dakota Miss Basketball in 2024 and played in the 2024 South Dakota all-star game. She was a four-time all-state and eight-time all-conference honoree and graduated as Flandreau's all-time leading scorer with 1,666 career points. She also graduated first on Flandreau's single-season assists list (128) and second in career assists (302). As a senior in 2024, Sheppard averaged 14.0 points, 6.3 rebounds and 5.3 assists and was a consolation state champion.

Katie Vasecka was named the 2024 South Dakota Gatorade Player of the Year after producing 21.6 points, 9.5 rebounds, 3.7 assists, 3.0 steals and 1.5 blocks per game as a senior. She was an ESPN Top 100 recruit for the class of 2024. Vasecka was also honored as the SDBCA Player of the Year, Midco Class A Player of the Year and South Dakota Girls Player of the Year. She was also a McDonald's All-America nominee, finalist for South Dakota Miss Basketball and played in the 2024 all-star game. Vasecka was the conference MVP as a senior and led Tea Area to a runner-up finish at the state tournament. She graduated as Tea Area's all-time leader in points, rebounds and blocks and was a four-time all-conference and all-state honoree.

Miller is South Dakota State's all-time leading scorer with 2,355 career points and led the Jackrabbits to the Sweet 16 as a senior in 2019. She was a graduate assistant for the Jacks in 2020-21, then took an assistant coaching job at NAIA Northwestern (lowa) under former Jackrabbit Kristin Rotert for three years. She is in her first season back at SDSU.

Assistant coach Kacie Jones was a graduate assistant at NAIA Northwestern in 2019-20 when assistant coach Erika Sage was in her third season on the Red Raiders' team.

Assistant coach Shelby Selland played collegiately at Augustana. Her younger sister, Myah, is SDSU's second all-time leading scorer and the only player to be ranked in the top-five in program history in career scoring, rebounds and assists.

The Jackrabbits have three South Dakota natives on their coaching staff - Macy Miller (Mitchell), Shelby Selland (Letcher) and Erika Sage (Fremont).

JACKRABBIT ACADEMICS

The Jackrabbits posted a 3.652 team GPA in 2023-24, which ranked 17th in Divsion I. SDSU has made the Top 25 list 17 times in the Division I era.

Four members of the SDSU squad were named to the 2023 Academic All-District team last season: Ellie Colbeck, Madison Mathiowetz. Paige Meyer and Tori Nelson. Paige Meyer and Tori Nelson were named academic all-Summit League.

NEW ARENA

South Dakota State opened its newly-renovated First Bank & Trust Arena this fall, about three years after the announcement of the project.

First Bank & Trust Arena includes new premium seating areas and suites, state-of-the-art video board and display systems, a new sound system, a more spacious concourse and improved restrooms to enhance the fan and event experience. New and improved locker rooms and coaching offices are also a part of the renovated arena, which will maintain a seating capacity of approximately 5,000.

The facility replaces the former home of many SDSU Athletics events in Frost Arena. The arena was opened in 1973 and served as the site of memorable Jackrabbit moments through the 2023-24 athletic season. The facility underwent a two-year renovation and expansion project that was spearheaded by a \$20 million commitment from Brookings-based First Bank & Trust.

AJ & TEAM USA

SDSU Head Coach Aaron Johnston completed his second stint as a coach with Team USA in July 2023. Johnston served as an assistant coach for the USA and helped the AmeriCup squad win a silver medal at the FIBA Women's AmeriCup in July. He was joined on the coaching staff by Washington State head coach Kamie Ethridge (head coach) and Cincinnati head coach Katrina Merriweather (assistant coach).

Johnston's first stint with Team USA was as an assistant coach for the 2021 USA U19 team at the FIBA U19 World Cup, where he won a gold medal. He also served as a court coach for the 2019 USA U19 and Pan American Games team trials.

SDSU CLIPPED BY NO. 16 DUKE

BROOKINGS, S.D. - South Dakota State basketball dropped a 75-71 decision to No. 16 Duke Sunday afternoon at First Bank & Trust Arena. The loss is SDSU's first of the season, moving the Jackrabbits to 3-1 while the Blue Devils improve to 4-1 overall.

SDSU never let the Blue Devils pull out of reach, but Duke did lead for the vast majority of the contest - 32 minutes compared to two minutes for the Jacks. The game was tied for 6:27 of game clock.

The Jacks led briefly at the midway point of the opening quarter, then not again until the third period. Down eight at halftime, 38-30, SDSU traded buckets with Duke out of the locker room, then an eight-point stretch for the Jackrabbits gave them the lead. Mesa Byom, Brooklyn Meyer and Haleigh Timmer put away consecutive layups in that run to tie the game at 45-all. Meyer hit two free throws to lead, 47-45, with 3:38 remaining in the third

Byom tied the game again at 59 with a 3-pointer at the 7:38 mark in the fourth, but Duke answered with a 7-0 run over the next four minutes. Paige Meyer and Brooklyn Meyer combined for five points to make it a two-point game, however the Blue Devils again responded with five straight.

Emilee Fox drained a triple to pull the Jacks within three with 17 seconds on the clock but Duke hit a free throw on the other end to seal the win.

Brooklyn Meyer led all players with a 25-point night on 9-of-13 shooting. She went 6-of-7 from the free throw line and connected on the first 3-point attempt of her career in the second quarter of action. Paige Meyer added 12 points and a game-high seven assists. Timmer was also in double figures, adding 11 points, four assists and two steals.

Madison Mathiowetz chipped in eight points and Byom contributed seven points, five rebounds and three assists. Kallie Theisen pulled down 12 rebounds.

The Jackrabbits outshot the Blue Devils, 46 percent to 43 percent, but Duke forced 15 SDSU turnovers that resulted in 21 points for the Blue Devils. SDSU knocked down eight 3-pointers at a 50 percent clip. Duke also corralled 14 offensive rebounds for 19 second-chance points.

Jadyn Donovan had a career day for the Blue Devils. The sophomore posted a 23-point, 15-rebounds double-double to lead the visitors.






