STORYLINES

- Georgia Tech makes its only true road trip of the non-conference schedule on Sunday, visiting in-state foe Mercer for a 2 p.m. tip in Hawkins Arena. The Yellow Jackets and Bears meet for the 24th time in program history on the hardwood, with Tech looking to extend its win streak over Mercer to 10-straight.
- Georgia Tech enters Sunday's tilt after picking up a marquee win over Mississippi State on Wednesday in the SEC/ACC Challenge. Tech hit 12 three-pointers to help overcome a halftime deficit and collect a 78-75 victory over the Bulldogs for its first win in the Challenge. Kara Dunn led the way offensively for Tech with 23 points, while Tonie Morgan added 15 and Dani Carnegie contributed 14. Tech dropped the rebounding battle and trailed at halftime for the first times this season against MSU.
- The Yellow Jackets took home the Hawaii North Shore Showcase trophy when it defeated No. 21 Oregon, 74-58, just before Thanksgiving. Four Yellow Jackets finished in double figure scoring totals paced by Ariadna Termis with 13 points behind a trio of three-pointers. Oregon finished with just one player in double digits, but a strong fourth quarter from the Jackets solidified the win. The ranked win marked the first over a ranked opponent since a 68-62 victory over No. 15 NC State on Feb. 2, 2023. It was the 10th win over a ranked opponent in the Nell Fortner era.
- A couple Yellow Jackets brought home some hardware from Hawai'i. Tonie Morgan was named the Tournament MVP, marking the second consecutive year she was named to an all-tournament team having earned a spot on the Cancun Challenge last season. Meanwhile, Ariadna Termis was named to the All-Star Team.
- Through Dec. 5 games, Georgia Tech ranks fourth in scoring defense in the ACC, limiting its opponents to a 56.50 points per game average. North Carolina sits in first, holding its opponents to 49.11 points per game, while Wake Forest and Clemson come in second and third, respectively. The Yellow Jackets were the only team in the ACC to not allow a three-pointer in its season-opener and have surrendered a league-low 30 on the season, as Tech remains in first in three-point field goal percentage defense (.242) in the league.
- Georgia Tech's freshmen class is making immediate impact through the first seven games and is leading the freshmen class in the Atlantic Coast Conference in several categories. Amongst all freshmen in the ACC, Dani Carnegie leads all freshmen in scoring, averaging 14.4 points per game (17th overall), three-point field goal percentage (.389, 4th overall) and three-point field goals made (2.63 per game, 4th overall). Nationally, Carnegie ranks 15th amongst all freshmen scorers.
- Homegrown talent: Georgia Tech's 12th-ranked recruiting class that joined the roster this season features four student-athletes from the Atlanta metro region - Chazadi 'Chit-Chat' Wright (Atlanta, Ga./Wesleyan School), Dani Carnegie (Mount Vernon, N.Y./Grayson (Ga.)), Gabbie Grooms (Sharpsburg, Ga./Trinity Christian School) and Tianna Thompson (Mableton, Ga./The Galloway School). In addition to its four-member freshmen class, fifth-year transfer, Zoe Smith, hails from Brunswick, Ga., and Kara Dunn calls Dallas, Ga., home.
- Among Tech's five-member newcomer class, fifth-year transfer Zoe Smith joined the roster after playing four seasons at Georgia. A Georgia native, Smith appeared in 74 games while at Georgia, while averaging 5.8 points and 3.5 rebounds per game in Athens. She shot 46.8 percent from the field in her four-years before a season-ending injury cut her senior season short last year. She scored a career-high 21 points as a junior against Georgia Tech.

SEC/ACC CHALLENGE

The 2024-25 season marked the second edition of the SEC/ACC Challenge. Georgia Tech drew Mississippi State this season in a rematch of the WBIT first round game that closed last season for the Yellow Jackets.

In the seventh meeting between the programs, Georgia Tech avenged a loss to MSU last season, collecting a 78-75 victory over the Bulldogs. Tech hit 12 three-pointers in the victory to overcome a halftime deficit as the teams stood tied with five minutes to play. After struggling in the first half offensively, freshman Dani Carnegie came up big in the fourth guarter, scoring 10 points, including a pair of free throws in the final seconds to extend Tech's lead to three. Kara Dunn registered a team-high 23 points, while Tonie Morgan logged 15 points and eight assists in the win.

In the game, Tech attempted a program-high 38 three-pointers, surpassing the previous high of 36 set against Clemson on Feb. 19, 2004.

Rusne Augustinaite has seen success in the Challenge, having recorded a career-night in Tech's first Challenge game last year against Florida. The then-freshman dropped 30 points against Florida. The Jackets will seek their first win in the Challenge, having dropped a 68-58 decision to the Gators last year.

PROGRAM RECORD 3'S

Georgia Tech is setting records this season, having produced a new program single-game record against Florida A&M on Dec. 1. Connecting on 15 three-pointers, the Yellow Jackets topped the previous single-game record of 14 made against Appalachian State on Dec. 11, 2016. Seven different Yellow Jackets connected beyond the arc against the Rattlers to help Tech set the new program record. In the win, the Jackets shot an astounding 61.7 percent from the floor, marking the first time Tech has shot 60 percent or better since defeating Kennesaw State on Nov. 22, 2011 when it hit 63.5 percent.

In the immediate next game against Mississippi State, Georgia Tech connected on 12 three-pointers to mark the third time this season the Jackets have hit 10-plus from beyond the arc. To continue breaking records, Tech attempted 38 three-pointers to set a new program high in that statistical category.

OFF TO A STRONG START

Continuing the best start in the Nell Fortner era, Georgia Tech comes into Sunday's match-up with an 8-0 ledger, marking the best start to a season since 1995-96.

A win on Sunday would push Georgia Tech to 9-0 on the season and mark the best start since 1977-78 when the Jackets went 10-0 to open the year. Tech's best start in program history is in fact the 10-0 start in 1977-78.

Georgia Tech is currently one of only 15 teams still undefeated in the nation and the last remaining team in the ACC unbeaten.

HAWAI'I CHAMPIONS

Collecting two wins in Hawai'i, Georgia Tech was crowned the 2024 Hawaii North Shore Showcase Champions with wins over South Dakota State and No. 21 Oregon. Tonie Morgan was tabbed the Tournament MVP after averaging a team-high 15.5 points and 9.0 rebounds per game, while tying for team-high in assists with seven. Ariadna Termis also took home some hardware being named to the All-Star Team. Termis finished second on the team in scoring, averaing 10.5 points per game and hit a team-high five three-pointers between the two games.

The win over No. 21 Oregon marked the first ranked win since Tech defeated No. 15 NC State, 68-62, on Feb. 2, 2023. It was the 10th win over a ranked opponent in the Nell Fortner era.

WHAT'S NEW TERMIS?

Having spent the summer in Atlanta working on the court and in the weight room, sophomore Ariadna Termis has seen much improvement on the floor this season. Termis scored a career-best

13 points in Tech's win over No. 21 Oregon, leading the Yellow Jackets offensively in the victory. Termis reached 13 points hitting five field goals, including three triples to match her personal-best.

Termis hit two or more three-pointers in a streak of threestraight games, capped against Oregon. In two years, the sophomore has connected on multiple three-pointers in a game in seven outings. Currently averaging 8.9 points per game on the young season, Termis has increased her scoring average by nearly seven points since last year when she contributed 2.6 points per game as a freshman.

LENDING A HAND

Having logged 15 or more assists in every game but three thus far this season, Georgia Tech currently ranks second in the ACC in assists, averaging 17.38 per game. Tech recorded a season-high 28 in its win over Florida A&M (Dec. 1) and has dished out 20 or more assists three times this season. Duke leads the ACC at 18.50 assists per game. Tech was held to a season-low three assists against South Dakota State in the opening game of the Hawaii North Shore Showcase.

ACC ROOKIE OF THE WEEK

Freshman Dani Carnegie picked up ACC honors on Nov. 18, earning ACC Co-Rookie of the Week accolades. The newcomer averaged 17.5 points per game, helping lift Georgia Tech to a pair of wins over West Georgia and Georgia. She led Tech from three-point distance, hitting seven between the two games, and shot 46.4 percent from the field. Carnegie led Tech against West Georgia with 15 points before logging her first collegiate 20-point outing, dropping 20 against Georgia. It marked the first weekly honor for the Yellow Jacket.

SPREADING THE OFFENSE

Five different Yellow Jackets finished in double-figures against West Georgia, marking the second time this season four or more players posted double-figures. Four led the way offensively in Tech's season-opener against Winthrop.

Freshman Dani Carnegie has led Tech offensively in three outings to open the season. She currently leads all freshmen in scoring in the ACC.

In addition to spreading its offense, the Yellow Jackets are sharing the ball and have recorded 15 or more assists in five games with a season-high of 28 coming against FAMU.

THERE'S ALWAYS A FIRST

Junior guard Kara Dunn recorded her first collegiate double-double in Tech's win against Georgia State, logging 11 points and a career-high 13 rebounds. Dunn led Tech in rebounding on the night with her personal-high. She has led the Jackets in rebounding in four games this season.

Dunn flirted with a double-double multiple times in her career, but never surpassed the mark. Her 13 rebounds against Georgia State topped her previous career-high of nine, set three times last season.

CARNEGIE CAN

Freshman Dani Carnegie has made an immediate impact after her first eight games, leading the Yellow Jackets offensively in three. She opened her collegiate career with a 17-point performance against Winthrop (Nov. 4) before following with 14 points against Georgia State (Nov. 8). Carnegie then tallied 15 points in the win against West Georgia (No. 14) before logging her first 20-point outing against Georgia (Nov. 17) with a new career-high of 20 points.

Carnegie became the first freshman Yellow Jacket to post back-to-back double-figure games to open their freshman

season since 2018-19. Additionally, her 17 points in her collegiate debut marked the most by a freshman since Kaela Davis scored 20 points in her debut against Coppin State on Nov. 8, 2013. Davis would go on to score in double-figures her first eight games that season.

SEASON OPENING DOMINANCE

Georgia Tech opened the 2024-25 collegiate basketball season across the country, playing the first game of the year. Tech welcomed Winthrop for "Education Day" on Nov. 4 and collected a dominating win to improve to 6-0 in season-openers under head coach Nell Fortner. The Jackets collected an 85-39 victory over the Eagles behind a 53.8 percent shooting effort, paced by four in double figures.

Tech's highly-touted freshmen class combined for 32 points and 11 rebounds led by Dani Carnegie's team-high 17-point performance. Three of the four freshmen connected at least once from three-point distance - Carnegie, Grooms and Wright - while all four contributed offensively.

The Jackets distributed the ball well its in opener, tallying 25 assists on 35 made field goals. Three different Jackets - Mor-

PRESEASON TUNE-UP

Georgia Tech held its final preseason tune-up against Anderson University in an exhibition game on Halloween. A total of 11 Yellow Jackets took the floor and all 11 contributed offensively in the 109-53 victory. Zoe Smith and Kara Dunn led Tech offensively, each chipping in 18 points, as five Jackets finished in double-figures. Four of Tech's five starters finished in double-figures, including Arianda Termis who tallied 12 points and a team-best seven rebounds.

Tech's 12th-ranked freshmen class saw promising minutes in exhibition play, tallying a combined 31 points, 15 rebounds, eight assists, four steals and three blocks. Tianna Thompson paced the freshmen class with 13 points, going 5-for-7 from the field, including a 2-for-3 effort from three-point range.

RETURNING A CORE NUCLEUS

Tech returns a core nucleus of seven letterwinners, therefore5bringing back 92% of its scoring and 87% of its rebounding from last season. In addition, the seven letterwinners accounted for 88.6 percent of the shots taken and 95.7 percent the free throws attempted.

In addition to its scoring and rebounding returning, Georgia Tech brings back the majority of production from last season. The Yellow Jackets return solid production in blocks (89.8%), three-pointers (87.9%), steals (81.5%), minutes (80.5%) and assists (79.1%).

STRENGTH OF SCHEDULE

Georgia Tech will face a competitive schedule this year with 16 opponents on the slate having reached postseason play last season. Of those 16 postseason teams, 13 participated in the NCAA Tournament and three reached the Sweet 16. The Yellow Jackets will spend part of their Thanksgiving break in Hawai'i, opening the North Shore Showcase against Summit League defending champions, South Dakota State.

BACK FOR YEAR SIX

Georgia Tech returns for its sixth season under head coach Nell Fortner in 2024-25, looking to improve upon last season's 17-16 overall record and 7-11 mark in league action. Tech reached postseason play last year, participating in the inaugural WBIT.

In five years with Nell Fortner at the helm, the Yellow Jackets have reached postseason play three times (while qualifying a fourth time before Covid-19), including back-to-back appearances in the NCAA Tournament (2022 and 2021). In 2021, Tech reached the Sweet 16 for just the second time in program history. Last season, the Yellow Jackets earned a bid to the inaugural Women's Basketball Invitation Tournament (WBIT).

50TH ANNIVERSARY

Georgia Tech will celebrate the 50th anniversary of women's basketball on The Flats during the 2024-25 season. Tech's first varsity female sports team, women's basketball started in 1974-75 and has amassed 781 wins since. In 50 seasons, Georgia Tech has made 11 NCAA Tournament appearances, eight WNIT appearances, and seven GAIAW State Tournaments. The Yellow Jackets made their first postseason appearance in school history in 1992 and won the NWIT in Amarillo, Texas. The win also marked the first NWIT title for an ACC school.

Tech made its first NCAA Tournament appearance in 1992-93. The Jackets didn't return for 10 years, making its next trip in 2003, but then participated in every Big Dance from 2007-2012. In 2012, Tech made its first-ever run to the Sweet 16. The Jackets would return to the Sweet 16 in 2021 with Nell Fortner at the helm.

VERSATILE MORGAN

Tonie Morgan has put together quite the collegiate career on The Flats thus far. After earning ACC All-Freshman Team honors and two ACC Rookie of the Week nods in 2022-23, the Jacket continued her impressive ways as a sophomore last season. Morgan received all-ACC second team honors after leading the Jackets with 15.6 points and 6.8 rebounds per game. She added to her resume with ACC All-Tournament second team honors and a Cancun Challenge all-tournament team selection.

Morgan finished last year with eight double-doubles and posted double-figure scoring totals in 29 games. Morgan also led the Jackets in assists (170) and steals (55). Nationally, she finished the season ranked 33rd in assists (170) and 35th in assists per game (5.2).

The junior is approaching the 1,000-career points mark, currently owning 901 points through three seasons. Morgan will become the 35th player in program history to surpass the 1,000-career points mark.

GETTING IT DUNN

Kara Dunn narrowly finished outside the top spot on the team in scoring as a sophomore last season, averaging 15.5 points per game (Tonie Morgan averaged 15.6 ppg). She led the team in free throw percentage (.782), while finishing second in three-pointers made with 39 to earn her all-ACC second team honors. In ACC games only, Dunn finished 10th in scoring, dropping 16.72 points per game on average.

Among her accolades last season, Dunn had some impressive outings. In Tech's game at NC State, Dunn hit a remarkable three-pointer as time expired in regulation to force overtime, while also earning her a spot on ESPN SportsCenter Top 10.

Against Georgia State (Dec. 10, 2023), Dunn dropped a career-high 39 points to become the first Yellow Jacket since 1999 to score that many points in a game, earning her ACC Player of the Week honors.

STEADY ON THE BOARDS

Kayla Blackshear has been a steady producer on the boards for Georgia Tech since she arrived on The Flats. Last season, Blackshear secured 6.3 rebounds per game to finish second on the team. She led the team in rebounding in nine games and recorded four outings with double-figure rebounding totals. In her three seasons on The Flats to date, Blackshear has led Georgia Tech in rebounding in 21 games dating back to the 2022-23 season.

TECH LEGACY

Freshman Tianna Thompson is no stranger to Georgia Tech, as her father, Rich, ran track and field for the White and Gold from 1988-91. An All-American and Olympic Trials finalist, Rich Thompson was inducted into the Georgia Tech Sports Hall of Fame in 2001. Thompson was tabbed outdoor all-American in the triple jump in 1989 and 1991, while collecting indoor honors in 1991, also for triple jump. He was also a multiple all-ACC honoree.

BASKETBALL HERITAGE

Continuing the theme of basketball families, freshman Gabbie Grooms shares a connection with teammate Kara Dunn as Grooms' mother also played collegiate basketball at the University of Georgia. Lady Grooms (Hardmon) played at UGA from 1989-92, played in 121 games and started 110, donning No. 23. She finished her collegiate career with 1,397 points for an 11.5 average and helped the Bulldogs to the 1991 SEC Championship.

Kara Dunn's mother, Stephanie Wheeler, also played at Georgia (1992-95) and was a member of the 1995 NCAA Final Four team.

HITTING THE PORTAL

Georgia Tech picked up a fifth-year transfer out of the portal over the summer in Zoe Smith, who played four seasons at the University of Georgia. The Brunswick, Ga., native appeared in 74 games and started in 19 while a Bulldog. Smith completed her four years in Athens averaging 5.8 points and 3.5 rebounds per game, while shooting 46.8 percent from the floor. She scored a career-high 21 points as a junior against Georgia Tech. Smith graduated from Georgia with a degree in human development and social sciences.

LAST SEASON RECAP

Georgia Tech capped last season with a 17-16 overall record, a four-win improvement from the season before when the Jackets went 13-17 in 2022-23. The Yellow Jackets reached the second round of the ACC Tournament last year, downing Pitt before falling to Duke in the second round.

For the third year under Nell Fortner, Tech reached postseason play, earning a bid to the inaugural Women's Basketball Invitation Tournament (WBIT). Tech dropped a first-round matchup at Mississippi State, but will meet the Bulldogs against this year in the SEC/ACC Challenge.

GOING DANCING

Under the direction of head coach Nell Fortner, Georgia Tech made back-to-back NCAA Tournament appearances in 2021 and 2022, marking the first time Tech has made consecutive appearances since six-straight from 2007-12.

Tech reached the Sweet 16 for just the second time in program history in 2021. Tech's appearance in 2022 marked the 11th in the Big Dance.

HOME SWEET HOME

All time, the Yellow Jackets are 424-236 (.620) when playing at home. The Jackets have won the last 11-consecutive home openers dating back to the 2012-13 season. Last season, Tech defeated Coastal Carolina in its home opener, 83-53. Under the direction of Fortner, the Jackets are 6-0 in home openers dating back

Nell Fortner was named the sixth head coach of Georgia Tech women's basketball on April 9, 2019. One of the most successful coaches in women's basketball history, Fortner has compiled a 401-251 (.615) record as a head coach at the collegiate, professional and international levels. She has led teams to Big Ten (Purdue – 1997) and Southeastern Conference (Auburn – 2009) championships and, perhaps most notably, coached the United States national team to three international titles from 1997-2000, including the gold medal at the 2000 Summer Olympics in Sydney, Australia. Fortner is the winningest coach in the history of the USA women's basketball national team, having compiled a 101-14 (.878) record. In addition to the 2000 Olympics championship, she also led the team to the gold medal at the 1998 World Championship in Berlin, Germany and the 1998 William Jones Cup in Taipei, Taiwan. At the collegiate level, Fortner has 14 seasons of experience as a head coach – one at Purdue (1996-97), eight at Auburn (2004-12) and six at Georgia Tech (2019-pres.) – and has compiled a 258-181 (.585) overall record in the college ranks.
