THINGS TO HOWL ABOUT


-The 2025 season marks the first for UWG as a Division I team, competing in the Atlantic Sun Conference.


- The Wolves welcome back last season's leading hitter, Cooper Prince. The senior outfielder led the team in 2024 with a .371 batting average, 66 hits and 36 walks. Prince also recorded a team-best 20 multi-hit games.

-UWG also brings back senior pitcher Seth Dudley who threw in a team-high 69.1 innings while striking out the second most batters for West Georgia with 58.

-Senior pitcher Brendan Parks also makes his return to the mound. Last season, Parks led all starters with a 4.93 ERA in 42 innings and finished third on the team with 48 strikeouts.

-Fans can also expect to see some new faces make an immediate impact for UWG, as the Wolves have brought in a talented group of freshmen and transfers over the offseason.

2024 UWG Baseball Team (Final Season in DII)



HEAD COACH JEFF SMITH



Since taking over as the head coach in 2019, the University of West Georgia Baseball program has continued to thrive under the leadership of Jeff Smith. Before assuming this role, Smith served as assistant coach to Skip Fite. As a nine-year member of Fite's staff, Smith helped guide the Wolves to a record of 241-208, reaching the Gulf South Conference tournament seven times and the NCAA South Regional in 2016 (first time since 1998). Although his first season as UWG head coach was cut short due to Covid-19, Smith continued to build on the program's success while leading the team through an unpredictable time. Since then, the Wolves have posted a 109-95 record and punched its ticket to the GSC tournament three times. UWG achieved 17 conference wins in both 2021 and 2023, with their most successful season resulting in a 31-18 overall record (17-13 GSC) in 2023.

During the Smith era, UWG has also experienced significant individual success, boasting two All-Americans, one GSC and South Region Player of the Year, four All-Region selections and eight All-GSC honorees. Dan Oberst and Brody Wortham both achieved All-American status in 2021, with Oberst adding GSC and South Region Player of the Year to his accolades.

Prior to joining the UWG pack, Smith spent five years at former Gulf South Conference rival, the University of Montevallo. While at Montevallo, Smith helped lead the Falcons to two South Central Regional tournaments in 2006 and 2007. During the 2006 season, UM captured the South Central Region and finished third in the NCAA Division II World Series. Smith was recognized by the Alabama Baseball Coaches Association as the Alabama Assistant Coach of the Year following the World Series run. Prior to his time at Montevallo, Smith had a successful six-year career as head coach at Volunteer State Community College (Tenn.). In 2000, his team won 48 games and was ranked as high as #1 in the NJCAA. In over two decades of coaching, Smith has produced 13 players who have gone on to play professionally, with three coming from UWG. As West Georgia enters this new era of Division I, head coach Smith and Wolves are enthusiastic about taking on the historic challenge. Smith played collegiately at the University of Louisville and graduated from Cumberland University.

ABOUT OPPONENT

- The Georgia Institute of Technology (GT) Yellow Jackets baseball team posts a 6-2 overall record with a 5-2 mark at home and 1-0 road record. Head coach Danny Hall is in his 32nd year as the program's lead.
- Georgia Southern transfer Kent Schmidt posts a team-high .400 batting average. Behind Schmidt, Kyle Lodise accounts for a second-best .370 batting average. Before becoming a Yellow Jacket, Lodise played for Augusta, a team that UWG began both the 2023 and 2024 seasons with threegame series. In his six games against the Wolves, the 2023 Peach Belt Conference Freshman of the Year posted a .333 batting average. In his 18 at-bats vs UWG, he recorded eight runs off of six hits while being struck out five times and walked three.
- GT is expected to start freshman right-handed pitcher Connor Chicoli on the mound. Chicoli was rated as the No. 22 shortstop in the country, the 83rd overall prospect in his class and the 9th best recruit out of the state of Georgia by Perfect Game.


