KEY STORYLINES

LAST TIME

- STRONG START:** The Deacs limited the Blue Devils to just 11 points in the first quarter and turned them over 19 times throughout the contest. It marked the fifth-most turnovers by the Blue Devils this season and most since Jan. 9.
- MAKING OUR FREEBIES:** The Demon Deacons went 14-of-16 (87.5 percent) from the charity stripe Thursday night, their 10th game this season shooting above 80 percent. The Demon Deacons free throw percentage this season now ranks seventh in program history.
- DOUBLE-DIGITS:** For the 15th time this season and seventh-consecutive game, sophomore guard Rylie Theuerkauf reached double figures with 11 points against the Blue Devils and a perfect 4-of-4 clip from the free throw line. She has 100 points over the last six games (16.6) and now averages 11.1 on the season, which leads the team.

ELISE DOES IT ALL

- A LEADER IN EVERYTHING:** The Demon Deacons are led by senior guard Elise Williams who led the Deacs in scoring, rebounding, assists, steals, minutes played and free throw percentage a season ago.
- REACHING 1K:** Williams reached 1,000 points in the regular season home finale against Clemson. She enters the game ranked 15th in program history in scoring with 1,290 in 120 career games.
- HITTING THE FREEBIES:** Williams averaged a career-best 82.8 percent from the stripe (96-of-116) last season. Additionally, she is now ranks seventh in program history in career free throw percentage (77.9 percent)
- TOP-10 ASSISTING:** Heading into the game, Williams has tallied 373 career assists and is eighth on the all-time assist list.

SERIES HISTORY

- ALL-TIME VS. GEORGIA TECH:** Georgia Tech holds a 51-29 record all-time over Wake Forest with both matchups the last two seasons being split including last year having both games won by the visiting team.
- LAST TIME VS. GEORGIA TECH:** Last time against Georgia Tech, the Demon Deacons were led by Williams' career-high 31-point outing as she shot a stellar 10-of-15 from the floor and 3-of-5 from beyond the arc. Williams, a native of Raleigh, added six rebounds and four assists, while going nearly perfect (8-of-9) from the charity stripe. The Demon Deacons captured a 71-66 road win on Feb. 25, 2024.
- A WIN WOULD:** Give the Demon Deacons its second ACC victory of the season and the second-consecutive win against Georgia Tech.

In the last 65 games dating back to January of 2022, the Demon Deacons have forced 10 or more turnovers in 63 games.

FAST BREAK

LOCKDOWN DEFENSE

- Through 24 games, the Demon Deacons have allowed just 64.8 points per game which ranks top 150 nationally and seventh in the ACC.
- In the first two games, the Deacs held their opponents to 41 and 40 points. This marks the first time since the 2021-22 season that the Deacs have held back-to-back opponents to less than 50 points.
- Additionally, this marks the fewest points allowed in back-to-back games (81) since the 2010-11 season when the Deacs held Presbyterian and High Point to 77 combined points.
- The two points allowed in the fourth quarter against Campbell and Charlotte are the fewest allowed in a quarter in program history. This tied the second quarter of the Xavier game on Dec. 8, 2016 when the Deacs held the Musketeers to just two points.

TAKE IT AWAY

- Forcing the Blue Devils into 19 turnovers, Wake Forest continued its stretch forcing double-digit turnovers. The Deacs have forced 10 or more takeaways 64 times in the last 66 games. The 66-game stretch goes back to January of 2022. This marked the fifth-most turnovers by the Blue Devils in a game this season and most since Jan. 9 against North Carolina. Through 24 games this season, Wake Forest has totaled 222 steals including eight on Thursday.
- The 28 turnovers forced against Cal were the most forced in a single-game this season for the Deacs. Additionally, it was the second-highest turnover game of the season for the nationally-ranked Bears. The only game where they had more turnovers came on Thursday at No. 14 Duke when Cal turned it over 31 times.
- This marked the sixth time this season that Wake Forest forced 20-or-more turnovers. 21 turnovers forced against Louisville tied the most in a game this season for Louisville, with the other instance coming against UT Martin on Nov. 12. Wake Forest added 26 points off turnovers against the Cardinals.
- Against Virginia, Wake Forest forced 20 turnovers, marking the fourth time this season the Deacs have had 20 or more turnovers forced. In total, the Deacs forced 20 turnovers against George Mason, the third time this season that the Deacs have forced 20 or more turnovers. The three games with 20-plus turnovers forced nearly matches the total number of games last season when the Deacs finished with four such games.
- Additionally, the Deacs have forced 15.4 turnovers per game this season.
- In total, the Deacs forced 20 turnovers four times over the course of the 2023-24 season which were also the four highest turnover forced games in the Megan Gebbia era: 1. vs. BYU - 25 turnovers forced (Nov. 18, 2023) 2. vs. North Carolina - 24 turnovers forced (Feb. 18, 2024) 3. at Clemson - 20 turnovers forced (Jan. 28, 2024) 4. vs. NC A&T - 20 turnovers forced (Nov. 15, 2023)

TEAMWORK

- The Deacs have done an excellent job of moving the ball so far this season, as they have assisted on 329 of 554 made baskets this season (59.4 pct.). Additionally over the last 20 games, the Demon Deacons have assisted on 289 of 474 made baskets or 61 percent.
- Last season, the Deacs assisted 404 of 694 made field goals (58.2 pct.). This matches the same percentage from last season and ranks in the 72nd percentile.
- Senior guard Elise Williams entered the top 10 in career assists earlier this season and currently is in eighth in program history:

FEELING 100

- The Demon Deacons scored 102 points in the opener against Queens, the most by a Megan Gebbia-coached team. Additionally, it marked the first time the Deacs have reached the 100-point mark since scoring 106 points against College of Charleston on Nov. 8, 2019.
- The 39 made field goals mark the most for Wake Forest since making 40 against College of Charleston in a 106-50 victory back on Nov. 8, 2019.
- The 62-point margin of victory was the most since defeating NC Central, 111-47, on Nov. 14, 2010.

SHARPSHOOTERS

- The Deacs have gotten off to a quick start from behind the arc in the 2024-25 season, knocking down 134 threes in the first 24 games (5.7 3FGM per game). Additionally, the Deacs came into the game, knocking down 30.2 percent of their threes.
- Overall, the 2023-24 Wake Forest team knocked down 204 threes last season which ranked fourth in program history:

DEACTOWN GREENSBORO

- Last season, Wake Forest advanced in the ACC Tournament for the fifth-consecutive season with ACC Quarterfinal appearances in 2023, 2021 and 2020.

- The Deacs own a 7-5 record over the past five years in ACC Tournament action.

- The first round win marked the second-consecutive season the Demon Deacons overcame a deficit of at least 15 points to advance in the ACC Tournament. Last season, the Deacs came back from 18-points down against Florida State to win 65-54 on March 2, 2023.

- It also marked the third-consecutive year that Wake Forest has defeated Virginia in the opening round of the conference tournament.

CLIMBING THE SCORING CHART

- Elise Williams reached 1,000 points in the regular season home finale against Clemson last season. She entered the 2024-25 season ranked 28th in program history in scoring with 1,065 in 99 career games. Williams has added to that total, scoring 223 points so far this season.

- Williams will now look to move up the scoring list on Thursday as she is 15th and is 19 points away from Lakevia Boykin (2009-13) in 14th place:

RYLIE RECENTLY

- For three consecutive games between North Carolina and NC State, Rylie Theuerkauf set a new career-highs in scoring including finished with 25 points against No. 17 NC State Wolfpack.

- 25 points is the most in a game by a Demon Deacon since Williams had 31 at Georgia Tech last season on Feb. 25, 2024. It marked her 12th game of the season with double-digit, fifth with at least 15 and second-consecutive with at least 20.

- She tied her previous career high (21) with seven minutes remaining in the first half. She opened the game 8-of-8 from the floor and 3-of-3 from deep.

- Theuerkauf has 100 points over the last six games (16.7 PPG) and now averages 11.1 on the season, the second-most on the team.

MALAYA'S HOME COOKING

- Malaya Cowles, who led the team in shooting percentage during the 2023-24 season shot a stellar 73-of-126 (57.9 percent) from the floor while inside LJVW Coliseum last year.

- She is off to a similar start in this season, shooting 52.3 percent overall at LJVW Coliseum (46-of-88 FG) including shooting 77.8 percent from the field against Queens (7-of-9 FG), 87.5 percent from the field against Gardner-Webb (7-of-8) and 88.9 percent from the field against Campbell (8-of-9).

HINDS BACK

- Demeara Hinds announced that she is returning for the upcoming 2024-25 season in March. In her first game back against Queens, she finished with 12 points on 5-of-6 FG while grabbing five rebounds. She had 14 points and seven rebounds against Davidson, 12 points and 11 rebounds against Campbell, a then season-high 17 points and eight rebounds at St. John's and most recently a career-high 18 points and 13 rebounds against No. 25 Florida State. She is shooting over 52 percent from the field on the season.
- Hinds missed the 2023-24 season and was awarded a medical redshirt,

giving her two years of eligibility remaining. Her other year of eligibility comes from the COVID-shortened 2020-21 season.

- In 2022-23, she averaged a career-best 5.9 points while also leading the team with 6.6 rebounds per game and a 49.7 percent shooting percentage. Over the course of her first three seasons she has totaled 274 points (3.5 per game) and 367 rebounds (4.7 per game).

FROM THE STRIPE

- Elise Williams averaged a career-best 82.8 percent from the stripe (96-of-116) in 2023-24. Additionally, she is now ranks seventh in program history in career free throw percentage with the help of going 37-of-45 (82.2 pct.) from the line this season.

- Wake Forest saw a massive uptick in free throw percentage, going from 66.0 percent (343-of-520) in 2022-23 to 73.1 percent (324-of-447) in 2023-24.

- The Demon Deacons have shot 75 percent or from the line in 12 of the first 24 games this season.

- A key to the Demon Deacons success this season has been the massive improvement at the line from Demeara Hinds. She came into the season shooting just 37.3 percent from the stripe (38-of-102 FT) and this season is nearly 25 percent better at the line, knocking down 62.0 percent (49-of-79 FT).

DEACS FINISH 3-0 IN GREECE AND CROATIA

- The Wake Forest women's basketball team came home with a perfect 3-0 mark after defeating the Swiss National Team, 52-41, in the tour finale Athens, Greece.
- This is the second-consecutive game that Wake Forest limited its opponent to under 50 points as Dubrovnik Select posted just 43 points.
- Rising sophomore guard Rylie Theuerkauf capped off her impressive tour with eight points while also adding a pair of assists. Theuerkauf led the Deacs in points per game over the course of the trip with 15.3 points per game and she was leading scorer in the opening two contests including 20 points in the tour opening win over Split Select.
- Over the course of the trip to Croatia and Greece, freshman Aurora Sørbye averaged 8.0 points, 3.7 rebounds and 7.3 assists per game.
- In the first two games, the Deacs also had impressive offensive showing.
- They had four players in double figures while another two had nine points in the 40-point victory over Dubrovnik Select. The well-rounded offense had 25 assists on 37 made baskets including 18 combined from the point guard position. The Deacs shot 50 percent from the field on 37 of 74 field goals.
- In the tour opening win over Split Select, Wake Forest netted 100

points. The sophomore class combined to score 58 of the 100 points scored as Rylie Theuerkauf finished with a team-high 20 points while Makaela Quimby and Madisyn Jordan each poured in 19 points in the 30-point victory.

ADDITIONS

- The Demon Deacons have four new players to the team for the 2024-25 season in graduate transfers Tamia Jones and Emily Johns and freshmen Aurora Sørbye and Kennedy Moore.
- During her last season at SMU, Jones had her best season of her career, averaging career highs in points, rebounds and assists. Jones led the team with 4.1 assists per game, starting all 18 games she played in during the 2023-24 season while also improving her percentages from the field and behind the arc. In her four collegiate seasons, the Colony, Texas native saw action in 66 career games including 47 starts. Over the last two seasons, she has averaged over 30.0 minutes played per game.
- Johns transferred in over the summer from American University where she reached the 1,000-point milestone while averaging better than 10 points per game in 102 games played including 60 starts over the last two seasons for the Eagles. Johns will miss the season due to injury.
- Sørbye has been an integral part of the Norwegian national system and has shined on the international stage during competitions over the last two years. Sørbye led Norway on the international stage at both the 2023 U20 and U18 European Championships, finishing with double-digit points per game in both events while also leading Norway in assists. She becomes the first Norwegian signee, the first European signee since 2021 and the 11th overall in program history.
- Moore is a multi-time all-conference that has averaged a near double-double in each of her last three seasons playing at Flathead High School in Kalispell, Mont. Over the course of her four-years on varsity, Moore averaged 11.9 points per game, 8.0 rebounds per game and 2.9 steals per game, leading her team in scoring and rebounding in her sophomore, junior and senior seasons.

WAKE FOREST INVESTMENT IN BASKETBALL

- Over the last five years, Wake Forest has invested over \$27 million in basketball facilities. The latest investment was the \$7.2 million project for the Dr. Carol Guth and Chris Paul Family women's and men's clubhouses that were completed in September of 2022.
- Both clubhouses feature over 6,000 square feet of space, 18 expansive player lockers with built-in ventilation, wireless charging station for electronics, RGB LED lighting and 43" digital screens above each locker.
 - The players lounge in each clubhouse has three separate TV/multimedia areas with comfortable seating for rest, relaxation and a space for the student-athletes. Additionally, there is a nutrition area in this space with a community table for team meals.
 - Each Clubhouse features state-of-the-art sports medicine and performance elements, including recovery pods and hydrotherapy, as well as showers and bathrooms.
 - Wake Forest basketball student-athletes can enjoy an outdoor heated covered patio with a view of the beautiful Reynolda Campus and Kentner Stadium.

YEAR THREE IN WINSTON-SALEM

Megan Gebbia enters her third season as the head coach of the Wake Forest women's basketball program in 2024-25 after an impressive debut season at the helm.

In just her first season, Gebbia had a host of accomplishments:

- Winningest first-year head coach in program history
- 17 wins tied the most since the 2011-12 season
- Tallied the most wins against ACC opponents by a first-year head coach
- Wins over four NCAA Tournament teams including wins over two Elite Eight teams
- Grabbed 12 wins at home, the fourth-highest total in program history
- Finished second in program history with 227 threes made
- Ended the season ranked fourth in program history with 123 blocks
- Held ACC opponents at home to just 19.2 percent shooting from three
- Limited five of nine ACC teams at home to one or less three-pointer made
- Increased the team's assist percentage by nearly 20 percent
- Signed a top-25 recruiting class according to ESPNW
 - This marks the first time since the 2014 class that the Deacs have signed multiple top-100 players in the same class and just the second time in the ESPNW era.

Gebbia made an impact in her first season as the Deacs grabbed their most wins since the 2011-12 season and led the Demon Deacons to a memorable three-day run at the ACC Tournament. During their three days in Greensboro, Wake Forest had the second-largest halftime comeback in ACC Tournament history, erasing an 18-point halftime deficit to defeat Florida State. It was one of a number of big wins during the first season of the Gebbia era. The Deacs claimed a key road win in the final year of the ACC/Big Ten, defeating Minnesota in late November.

In the final week of January, the Demon Deacons recorded a pair of wins over eventual Elite Eight teams, taking down Louisville, the first win over the Cardinals in program history, and Miami. Both victories highlighted 12 total wins at Lawrence Joel Veterans Memorial Coliseum, the fourth-highest total in program history.

In the first season of the Gebbia era, Jewel Spear had one of the best scoring seasons by any player in program history, finishing the 2022-23 season with 546 points, the sixth-highest total by a Demon Deacon. En route to garnering All-ACC honors for the second-consecutive season, Spear had 11 20-plus point games including 30-plus points in wins over Coastal Carolina and Louisville.

Spear finished the season with the second-highest three-point total in program history, racking up 93 threes during the season. As a team, Wake Forest had their second-highest total of threes in program history as the motion-style offense of Gebbia produced 227 threes on the season.

The Deacs also got the job done on the defensive side of the ball, blocking 123 shots during the season which ranked fourth in program history and finished the season ranked in the top 100 nationally. Wake Forest also ranked in the top 70 nationally in points per game allowed and in the top 60 nationally in three-point defense.

On the recruiting side, Gebbia signed top talent for her first class, inking a top-25 recruiting class according to ESPNW. It also was the first time since the 2014 class that the Deacs have signed multiple top-100 players in the same class and just the second time in the ESPNW era.

Welcome to the Gebbia Era

Gebbia was announced as the 11th head coach in the program history of Demon Deacons women's basketball on May 26, 2022.

In her 27 years in coaching, Coach Gebbia has helped her teams reach the NCAA Tournament 12 times including a Sweet Sixteen appearance as an assistant at Marist in 2007. She is American University's all-time winningest leader and the only head coach in program history to lead the Eagles to the NCAA Tournament. She has been named Patriot League Coach of the Year twice and has led the Eagles to five 20-plus win seasons.

"I'm extremely excited to join the incredible Wake Forest and Winston-Salem community and I am so thankful and appreciative of the opportunity to be the head women's basketball coach at Wake Forest University," said Gebbia. "I'm very appreciative of President Wente and John Currie for giving me the opportunity to fulfill a lifelong dream to coach in the premiere conference in the country and impact the lives of young women as we help them reach their full potential on and off the floor. Wake Forest presents an opportunity to be a part of a special brand at one of the top academic institutions in the country. My highest priority will be spending time and developing relationships with our current student-athletes, alumni and the young women who will make up the future of Demon Deacons basketball!"

During her time at the helm of the American women's basketball program, Gebbia accumulated a record of 160-105 (.604) including a 106-49 (.684), both the highest totals in program history. She became the all-time wins leader in 2021-22 after her fifth 20-win season with the Eagles.

A two-time Patriot League Coach of the Year, Gebbia's eight years with the Eagles have included three of the most historic seasons in program history starting with the then-program record 24-9 run during the 2014-15 season to lead the team to its first NCAA Tournament appearance. The Eagles topped that performance three years later with a 26-7 overall record to advance into the NCAA Tournament for the second time in program history.

The 23-8 season in 2021-22 ranks third in program history with all three seasons ending in trips to the NCAA Tournament.

Gebbia has mentored some of the top players in program history, including three Patriot League Players of the Year, five Patriot League Scholar-Athletes of the Year, one Patriot League Defensive Player of the Year, one CoSIDA Academic All-American First Team honoree, two CoSIDA Academic All-District selections, two ECAC Division I All-Stars, 25 All-Patriot League selections, and three NCAA Woman of the Year nominees.

Of the five Patriot League Scholar-Athletes of the Year, three were also selected as Patriot League Offensive Players of the Year with Jen Dumiak (2014-15), Emily Kinneston (2017-18) and Cecily Carl (2018-19), making American one of only two teams in league history to have players win both awards in a single season alongside Holy Cross (four from 1995-99).

In her first season in Washington, D.C., she became the winningest first-year coach in program history with a 22-10 record and the program's and Patriot League's first postseason at-large berth, facing Seton Hall in the First Round of the WNIT. A finalist for the Maggie Dixon Division I Rookie Coach of the Year award, Gebbia's squad also ranked 13th among Division I women's basketball teams with a 3.510 GPA to land in the WBCA Academic Top-25 Honor Roll.

Prior to her time at American, she helped build Marist into one of the best mid-major programs in the country. During her 10 seasons with the Red Foxes, Marist advanced to the NCAA Tournament nine times. During that stretch, they won five NCAA Tournament games, defeating Power-5 programs Georgia, Iowa State and Ohio State.

The Red Foxes, who advanced to the 2007 Sweet 16, won the MAAC regular season title every season Gebbia was on staff and won the conference tournament title nine times. Much like at American, Gebbia and the Red Foxes created an impressive home court advantage, compiling a 114-14 record (.891) in her time in Poughkeepsie, N.Y. including an 85-5 record (.944) in conference home games.

Gebbia previously was an assistant coach at Wright State for one season in 2002-03 and an assistant coach at UMBC for six seasons from 1996-02.

She got her start as an assistant coach in 1995-96 at American University.

A native of Frederick, Md., Gebbia was a key player on the 1989 Maryland 2A State Championship Middletown High School women's basketball team. As a senior she was named Co-Player of the Year by The Frederick News-Post. She played college basketball at Towson University from 1990 to 1994.
