CLEMSON OVERVIEW

- Clemson, which has a 1-0 road record, split two midweek home games, an 8-2 loss to No. 21 Coastal Carolina and a 9-1 win over Presbyterian.

- The Tigers are averaging 7.9 runs per game and hitting .287 with a .444 slugging percentage, .429 on-base percentage and 34 steals.
- The pitching staff has a 3.91 ERA, .206 opponents' batting average and 2.73 strikeout-to-walk ratio, and Clemson is fielding .975.

GEORGIA TECH OVERVIEW

- Georgia Tech, which has a 14-3 home record and is averaging 9.7 runs per game, is led by 32nd-year Head Coach Danny Hall.
- The Yellow Jackets won at Kennesaw State 15-4 on Tuesday. They are hitting .334 and have a 4.14 ERA and .977 fielding percentage.
- Kent Schmidt is hitting .415, Kyle Lodise has nine homers, Alex Hernandez has 37 RBIs and Mason Patel has a 7-0 record and an 0.61 ERA.

QUICK HITS

- Clemson (27) and Georgia Tech (23) are first and second, respectively, in the nation in sacrifice flies (through games of March 26).
- Clemson's bullpen has a 17-0 record, 12 saves, a 3.12 ERA, .208 opponents' batting average and 177 strikeouts in 150.0 innings pitched.
- Sophomore lefthander Noah Samol was a pitcher for the Yellow Jackets in 2023.

- Clemson is ranked as high as No. 3 in the nation by Perfect Game this week.
- Clemson was ranked in the top 10 of at least one poll in all 18 weeks in 2024. It has a current streak of 25 top-10 rankings in a row.
- Clemson has a current 33-week streak of being ranked in the top 25 of at least poll dating to the 2023 season.
- The Tigers have been ranked in at least one weekly poll every year since 1987, when Clemson began tracking weekly polls.

DOUG KINGSMORE STADIUM



Doug Kingsmore Stadium, the home of Tiger baseball since 1970, has seen many changes and improvements over the years, but it has not lost its aesthetic beauty and unique feel on the west side of the Clemson University campus.

Doug Kingsmore Stadium has over 4,500 permanent seats, but is capable of holding 6,272 fans thanks to a hill area down the left-field line that is popular with students.

The park features a terrace in the outfield adjacent to the fence, similar to the old Crosley Field in Cincinnati. Former Head Coach Bill Wilhelm liked the look and practicality of a field with grass around the outfield instead of gravel or dirt.

In 2015, a three-story building was constructed behind the first-base dugout. It houses a state-of-the-art clubhouse, coaches offices and a player lounge among other amenities.

ATTENDANCE

- Clemson is averaging 4,844 fans per home date (22), the 11th-highest figure in the nation and second in the ACC (through games of March 26).
- In a 5-3 win over South Carolina on Feb. 28, Clemson set a school record with 6,891 fans in attendance at Doug Kingsmore Stadium.
- Entering the 2025 season, Clemson had a top-20 national figure in average home attendance for 31 straight seasons.

ACC STANDINGS

- Clemson is tied for fourth place in the ACC standings with a 4-2 league mark, behind first-place Florida State (5-1).

SHRINERS SHOWDOWN RECAP

- Clemson was one of four teams in the six-team Shriners Children's College Showdown with a 2-1 record to tie for the best record.
- The showdown at Globe Life Field in Arlington, Texas from Feb. 14-16 marked Clemson's first three games in an MLB stadium and a dome.
- It marked Clemson's first regular-season game outside the Eastern time zone since 2005.
- Clemson defeated No. 13 Oklahoma State 6-5 in the first game, then beat No. 12 Arizona 16-5 in its second game before falling to Ole Miss.
- Oklahoma State and Arizona were the top-two teams, respectively, in the Big 12 Conference coaches pre-season poll.
- The Tigers hit .324 with 10 doubles, 27 runs, a .418 on-base percentage, two steals and a .990 fielding percentage in the showdown.
- Dominic Listi was 5-for-9 (.556) with seven RBIs, four runs, two walks, two hit-by-pitches and a .643 on-base percentage in three games.

TIGERS SWEEP RIVAL GAMECOCKS

- Clemson swept South Carolina in three games at three different sites by a combined score of 18-6 from Feb. 28 to March 2.
- The Tigers won 5-3 at Clemson, 5-1 at Fluor Field in Greenville, S.C. and 8-2 at South Carolina.
- Clemson never trailed in the series.
- Clemson had a 1.69 ERA, .160 opponents' batting average and 36 strikeouts against nine walks in 27.0 innings pitched in the series.
- A Doug Kingsmore Stadium record crowd of 6,891 saw the Tigers outlast the Gamecocks 5-3 on Feb. 28.
- Ethan Darden received the Bob Bradley Award as Clemson's MVP of the series.
- Darden pitched 7.0 scoreless innings of three-hit ball with six strikeouts to earn the win on March 1.
- Jarren Purify was 4-for-8 with a homer, double, three RBIs, a .636 on-base percentage and two steals in three games.

- It marked the third time in four years the Tigers swept South Carolina, as they won all three games in 2022 and both games in 2024.
- It upped Clemson's winning streak in the series to five, while the Tigers have won 10 of the last 12 meetings.
- Clemson has won eight of the last 11 series dating to 2015.

17-GAME WINNING STREAK

- Clemson had a 17-game winning streak that started with a 6-2 win over VCU on Feb. 21 and ended with a 7-3 loss to Notre Dame on March 16.
- The 17-game winning streak was Clemson's longest since it won 17 games in a row during the 2023 season.
- The 17-game winning streak tied for the fourth longest in school history.
- Seven of the 17 wins were comeback victories.
- Clemson hit .290 with a .480 slugging percentage, .439 on-base percentage and 8.3 runs per game during the winning streak.
- Clemson had a 2.84 ERA, .186 opponents' batting average and 184 strikeouts against 57 walks in 149.0 innings pitched in the winning streak.
- Clemson held opponents to .145 with runners in scoring position during the winning streak.

TAKING ONE FOR THE TEAM

- Clemson batters have been hit by a pitch 58 times in 28 games (2.1 per game) in 2025.
- The Tiger record for hit-by-pitches in a season is 80, set by the 2021 team.
- The 58 hit-by-pitches along with the 178 walks (6.4 per game) are a big reason Clemson has a .429 on-base percentage.
- Dominic Listi leads the team in hit-by-pitches with 15, tied for fifth most in a season in school history.
- Andrew Ciufu and Jarren Purify are tied for second in hit-by-pitches on the team with eight apiece.

CAPTAINS

- Andrew Ciufu, Jacob Jarrell, Aidan Knaak and Jarren Purify were voted team co-captains.
- Jarrell was voted a team co-captain for the second time in his career, as he was a team co-captain in 2024.
- Seven Tigers were voted to the leadership council (assistant captains).
- Those seven Tigers are Joe Allen, Tristan Bissetta, Cam Cannarella, Dominic Listi, Lucas Mahlstedt, Tryston McCladdie and Josh Paino.

BAILEY BACK

- Senior lefty B.J. Bailey missed all of 2024 due to injury after pitching 15.2 innings in 2023, but has become one of Clemson's top pitchers.
- He is 2-0 with an 0.43 ERA, a .171 opponents' batting average and 25 strikeouts against seven walks in 21.0 innings pitched in 2025.

- He has made eight relief appearances.
- He leads the team in pickoffs (2) and has not allowed a steal.
- He is holding opponents to .091 with runners on base and .087 with runners in scoring position.
- He allowed an earned run in his first outing of 2025 against Ole Miss, but has pitched the last 20.0 innings without allowing an earned run.
- In 5.2 innings pitched over three relief appearances in ACC regular-season games, he has allowed one hit and no runs with eight strikeouts.
- In two active years as a Tiger, he's 4-2 with a 1.96 ERA and .226 opponents' batting average in 36.2 innings pitched over 25 relief outings.
- He has 45 strikeouts against 13 walks in his two active years as a Tiger.

CANNARELLA RACKING UP THE HITS

- Junior outfielder Cam Cannarella continues to accumulate hits in his third season as a Tiger.
- He is hitting .330 with a homer, triple, five doubles, 22 RBIs, 28 runs, a .471 on-base percentage and steal in 26 games in 2025.
- He has more walks (23) than strikeouts (19).
- He is 14-for-32 (.438) with 10 RBIs and 10 runs in the last eight games.
- He went 5-for-5 with an RBI and two runs in Clemson's 6-4 win over The Citadel on March 18.
- In his career, he is hitting .358 with 211 hits, 37 doubles, seven triples, 19 homers, 129 RBIs, 158 runs and 26 steals in 143 games.
- In his career, he has a .541 slugging percentage and .445 on-base percentage.

DARDEN HAVING HIS BEST SEASON

- Junior lefthander Ethan Darden is having his best season as a Tiger.
- A majority of his appearances in each of his three seasons as a Tiger have been in a starting role.
- He is 3-1 with a 3.77 ERA, .221 opponents' batting average and 27 strikeouts against 12 walks in 28.2 innings pitched in 2025.
- Clemson has a 5-1 record in his six starts.
- He is holding opponents to .218 with runners on base, .194 with runners in scoring position and .219 with two outs.
- He pitched 7.0 scoreless innings of three-hit ball with six strikeouts to earn the win in Clemson's 5-1 win over South Carolina on March 1.
- He earned ACC Pitcher-of-the-Week honors and received the Bob Bradley Award as Clemson's MVP of the series against South Carolina.
- In his career, he is 11-8 with a 5.02 ERA, .271 opponents' batting average and 114 strikeouts in 150.2 innings pitched over 44 appearances.
- He has made 29 starts in his career.

KNAAK PILING UP STRIKEOUTS

- Sophomore righthander Aidan Knaak is continuing where he left off in 2024 by piling up strikeouts in 2025.
- He is 4-0 with a 3.41 ERA, .168 opponents' batting average and 54 strikeouts against 11 walks in 31.2 innings pitched over six starts.
- He has a 15.35 strikeouts-per-nine-innings-pitched mark in 2025.
- Clemson has a 6-0 record in his six starts.
- In two ACC regular-season starts, he is 2-0 with an 0.69 ERA, .073 opponents' batting average and 22 strikeouts in 13.0 innings pitched.
- He pitched 7.0 scoreless innings of one-hit ball with 12 strikeouts against one walk to earn the win against Notre Dame on March 14.

- He allowed two hits, one run and two walks with 10 strikeouts in 6.0 innings pitched to earn the win against No. 11 Wake Forest on March 21.
- He was named Perfect Game National Pitcher-of-the-Week and NCBWA National Co-Pitcher-of-the-Week for his efforts.
- He was named ACC Pitcher-of-the-Week for his efforts, as it was the third time in his career he earned that accolade.
- He is one of only seven Tigers in history to be a three-time ACC Pitcher-of-the-Week (first awarded in 1989) in a career.
- In his career, he is 9-1 with a 3.37 ERA, .207 opponents' batting average and 162 strikeouts in 115.0 innings pitched over 21 starts.
- Clemson has a 19-2 record in his 21 career starts.
- His 12.68 strikeouts-per-nine-innings-pitched mark in his career is first in Clemson history.
- His 4.05 strikeout-to-walk ratio in his career is sixth in Clemson history.

LISTI'S LISTS

- Senior and transfer outfielder Dominic Listi has become the starter in left field and leadoff batter while bringing energy to the team.
- He is hitting .330 with a homer, eight doubles, 28 RBIs, 31 runs, 26 walks, 15 hit-by-pitches and a .530 on-base percentage in 28 games.
- He is the only Tiger to start all 28 games.
- His 15 hit-by-pitches are tied for fifth most in a season in Clemson history.
- He is hitting .391 with runners on base and .444 with runners in scoring position.
- He has a .643 on-base percentage when leading off an inning.
- He began his Clemson career on a 12-game hitting streak and nine-game RBI streak.
- He is in his sixth year of college and has started all 231 of his teams' games during those six seasons.

MAHLSTEDT SOLID ON & OFF THE FIELD

- Senior and sidearm righthander Lucas Mahlstedt has been one of the team's best relievers since transferring to Clemson for the 2024 season.
- He is 1-0 with eight saves, an 0.87 ERA, .164 opponents' batting average and 29 strikeouts versus two walks in 20.2 innings pitched in 2025.
- He leads the nation in saves (through games of March 26).
- All 12 hits he has allowed have been singles.
- He is holding opponents to .120 with two outs.
- He pitched 3.0 innings, allowing no hits, no runs and no walks with four strikeouts to record the save against South Carolina on Feb. 28.
- He pitched 3.0 scoreless innings with three strikeouts to earn the win against No. 11 Wake Forest on March 23.
- In two years as a Tiger, he is 5-1 with a 3.65 ERA and .244 opponents' batting average in 74.0 innings pitched over 38 relief outings.
- He also has nine saves and 68 strikeouts against 17 walks in his two years at Clemson.
- On Feb. 26, he became a Weaver-James-Corrigan-Swofford Postgraduate Scholarship Award recipient.
- He was one of only 35 ACC student-athletes and three ACC baseball players to receive the 2025 award.
- He became the first Tiger baseball player to receive the accolade.

PURIFY EMERGING AT THE PLATE

- Sophomore Jarren Purify has always been solid on defense and one of the team's best leaders and energetic teammates.

HEAD COACH ERIK BAKICH
