STORYLINES

- Georgia Tech concludes the regular season on Sunday, making its first-ever trip to Stanford. The Yellow Jackets and Cardinal begin a series history at 4 p.m. ET on Sunday.
- This marks the first trip to California for the Yellow Jackets since 2022 when Tech was sent to Stanford for the NCAA Tournament first and second rounds. Tech dropped a heartbreaker to Kanas in first-round action. Tech last traveled to The Golden State for a regular season contest on Nov. 24, 2006 to face San Diego.
- Georgia Tech looks to snap a three-game skid after dropping a tough decision at California on Thursday. A trio of Yellow Jackets finished in double-figures against the Golden Bears, paced by Kara Dunn's 18-point performance. Freshman Tianna Thompson logged her second consecutive double-figure scoring outing, chipping in 11 points, hitting a pair of three-pointers. Tech hit six three-pointers in the outing, but a late first quarter run and strong shooting from Cal sealed the win for the Golden Bears.
- Continuing to draw national attention, Dani Carnegie and Kara Dunn were named to the midseason watch list for the Ann Meyers Drysdale Award, which is given to the nation's player of the year by the USBWA. The listed named the top 50 contenders for the award and nine were named from the ACC.
- Georgia Tech spent three weeks at No. 13 in the Associated Press Top 25 poll and spent 11 weeks ranked in the top 25 before falling out on Monday. The highest AP ranking in program history is No. 11, reached on Feb. 7, 2022. Tech was tabbed No. 10 in the WBCA Coaches Poll during the 2011-12 campaign.
- Freshman Dani Carnegie was voted ACC Rookie of the Week for the fifth time this season, and fourth-straight week, on Jan. 6 after helping Georgia Tech to its win over Syracuse. The freshman has scored in double figures in 18 outings.
- With its successes this season, Georgia Tech was tabbed the National Team of the Week by both the NCAA and USBWA on Tuesday, Dec. 11. The Yellow Jackets have garnered national attention and remained one of only four undefeated teams in the country until the loss to Virginia Tech. Kara Dunn has also started to garner national attention and was selected as one of five USBWA National Players of the Week on Dec. 31.
- Graduate transfer Zoe Smith has entered the conference rankings in rebounding after putting together a solid stretch of games. In conference play, the Jacket is leading Tech on the glass, securing 6.4 rpg to rank 19th in the league. Overall, Smith is pulling down a team-high 6.3 rpg.
- One of the nation's top assists leaders, Tonie Morgan jumped into Tech's top-5 all-time rankings in career assists with 447 assists. Owning 163 this season, Morgan ranks 13th in total assists nationally and 18th in assists per game (5.6). In the ACC, Morgan is second in the league in conference only games. Morgan logged a season-high 14 assists against Clemson (Jan. 19), which ties for the second-most by an ACC player in the league this season.
- Through Feb. 27 games, Georgia Tech ranks fourth in scoring defense in the ACC, limiting its opponents to 63.52 points per game. North Carolina sits in first, holding its opponents to 56.83 points per game and Duke follows in second at 58.52 points per game. The Yellow Jackets have surrendered 147 three-pointers on the season, as Tech sits in second in the ACC in three-point field goal percentage defense (.288) in the league.



GEORGIA TECH RESUME

Georgia Tech has put together quite an impressive resume this season. The Yellow Jackets have defeated three top-25 opponents and faced 11 teams ranked in the top 50 NET, defeating five. Tech also recorded the best start in program history.

With its win over Syracuse, Georgia Tech became the first team in the ACC to open a season 15-0 overall since 2017-18, when Louisville won its first 20 games of the season. The Yellow Jackets also opened ACC play 3-0 for the first time since 2010-11.

Tech returned to the Associated Press Top 25 poll on Dec. 9. After its first week in the poll, Tech leaped eight spots to No. 17 and then climbed four spots to No. 13. The Jackets sit just outside the top 25 at 26 in the latest poll on Monday.

The Yellow Jackets have a history of defeating ranked opponents under head coach Nell Fortner. In Fortner's first season on The Flats (2019-20), the Jackets edged four top-25 opponents, including two on the road.

20 WINS

With Georgia Tech's win at Boston College, the Yellow Jackets hit 20 wins on the season. The 20-win campaign marks the third under head coach Nell Fortner in her six-year tenure. It also marks the quickest a team has reached the mark in Georgia Tech women's basketball history in the NCAA era.

The 1977-78 team finished the year 23-4 overall and opened 20-3, marking the quickest to 20 wins in program history.

COACH OF THE YEAR WATCH LIST

Nell Fortner is one of 15 candidates named to the 2025 Werner Ladder Naismith Women's College Coach of the Year Watch List, the organization announced on Feb. 19. Fortner is one of three coaches representing the ACC on the list as she is joined by Niele Ivey (Notre Dame) and Wes Moore (NC State).

This marks the third time Fortner has appeared on the Watch List as she earned a spot in 2022 and was a semifinalist in 2020.

THOMPSON ON A STREAK

Over the last two games, freshman Tianna Thompson has put up some numbers. The freshman dropped a career-high 19 points against Florida State before posting 11 points at California.

In the two-game stretch, Thompson has averaged 15.0 points per game, shooting 63.2 percent from the field. She has converted 5-of-9 three-point attempts for a 55.6 percent efficiency.

Against Florida State, Thompson came off the bench to lead the Yellow Jackets in scoring with a career-high 19 points. Thompson shot 72.7 percent from the field, connecting on 8-of-11 attempts, including a 3-for-5 effort from three-point range. The game marked her second in double-figures this season.

Thompson is the third freshman on the team to drop a game with 15 or more points. Chit-Chat Wright owns two games with 15+, while Dani Carnegie owns 11. This trio of Tech's highly touted freshman class is contributing 24.6 points per game this season and shooting 39.71 percent (220-554) from the floor and 33.33 percent (105-315) from three-point distance.

STEAL PARTY

In Tech's game against Wake Forest (Feb. 16), the Yellow Jackets recorded 15 steals on the day, led by five from Kara Dunn and four from Inés Noguero. The 15 steals matched the season-high by the Jackets who previously recorded 15 steals against Louisiana Monroe (Dec. 11). It marked a season-high in ACC play for Tech.

On the season, Dunn leads the team in steals with 37 for a 1.3 steals per game average. Noguero closely follows with 36 steals (1.5 spg). They are closely followed by Tonie Morgan with 32

GETTING IT DUNN

Kara Dunn has been a consistent producer for the Yellow Jackets this season. Overall, the junior is Tech's leading scorer, averaging 15.8 points per game. Dunn is also second on the team in rebounding, collecting 5.9 on average per game.

In conference play, Dunn is averaging 17.1 points and 5.5 rebounds per game. She has dropped six 20-plus point outings, including a 33-point performance against Virginia Tech, and logged a double-double against the Hokies.

Overall this season, Dunn has recorded 24 double figure scoring outings and had a 13-game streak of double-figure performances snapped at Virginia. She owns eight games with 20 or more points and three double-doubles on the season. She has led Tech in scoring 15 times and rebounding 10 times.

She also second on the team in field goal percentage, shooting 51.4 percent from the floor overall this season. In league play, the junior is hitting 51.0 percent from the field. She ranks 7th in all games and 7th in conference only games in FG% in the ACC. In league play, Dunn is second in all guards in FG%.

IT'S HOW IT ZOES

Over Tech's last seven of nine games, Zoe Smith has been a prominent presence on the floor. The graduate transfer has recorded double-figures in four outings and logged double-doubles against Duke and Boston College (and just missed a double-double against SMU). During the seven-game stretch, Smith has averaged 10.9 points and 8.9 rebounds per game. She has shot 50.8 percent from the field and pulled down 25 offensive boards.

On the season, Smith is averaging 7.8 points and 6.4 rebounds per game. She owns 10 double-figure scoring games, four double-doubles and five double-figure rebounding outings.

SPREADING THE OFFENSE

Georgia Tech recorded 16 games this season with four or more Yellow Jackets finishing in double-figure scoring numbers, most recently with four against Wake Forest. Five players scored in double-figures five times this season - against West Georgia, at Mercer, at North Carolina, Clemson and at Miami. Tech's season-high was six players against Clemson on Jan. 19.

As of Feb. 24, Georgia Tech is one of only six teams in the ACC to own five or more games with five or more players scoring in double-figures.

In addition to spreading its offense, the Yellow Jackets are sharing the ball and have recorded 15 or more assists in 20 games with a season-high of 28 coming against FAMU and Clemson.

IN THE WRIGHT SPOT

Chit-Chat Wright earned her first collegiate start at Notre Dame (Jan. 16) and started eight-straight games. In her eight starts, the freshman averaged 8.4 points, while dishing out 29 assists. She shot 34.2 percent from the field and logged four double-figure scoring outings.

A DOMINATING ZOE AGAINST DUKE

Against Duke, Zoe Smith logged her fifth career double-double, and third at Georgia Tech, with a game-high 16 points and game-high 13 rebounds. Smith came ready to play, owning 10 points and seven rebounds at halftime. The graduate transfer was a perfect 5-for-5 from the field after the first two quarters.

It marked her seventh game in double figures as a Yellow Jacket, while matching her season-high. Smith followed that performance with 16 points at Miami, tying for the team-high.

JOINING AN ELITE CLUB

This season, two Yellow Jackets have surpassed the 1,000-career points mark. Tonie Morgan hit the record against Virginia Tech to become the 35th player in program history to do so. Morgan sits at 1,178 career points in 92 games. She hit the mark in her 79th career game.

Five games later against Duke, Kara Dunn surpassed the milestone, becoming the 36th player in program history. Dunn currently owns 1,137 career points in just 87 games.

WELCOME BACK, DANI

After missing three full games, and playing just under six minutes against Virginia Tech, freshman Dani Carnegie returned to the floor at Virginia. Carnegie logged a career-high 29 points for her 14th game in double-figures and sixth 20-plus point outing.

Carnegie reached 29 points hitting seven field goals, including five three-pointers, and converting a career-high 10-of-11 free throws. She just missed a double-double with nine rebounds.

DOUBLE-DOUBLE X TWO

In Tech's game at Virginia, a pair of Yellow Jackets finished with double-doubles in Kayla Blackshear and Tonie Morgan.

Blackshear hit her second double-double of the season with 10 points and a team-high 10 rebounds, while Morgan owned 11 assists and 11 points.

For Morgan, it marked her sixth career double-double on points and assists, and 14th double-double overall. It was also her second-straight double-double after posting a triple-double against Clemson in the game prior.

The game marked the first a pair of Jackets posted double-doubles since 2019.

TRIPLE-DOUBLE MORGAN

Junior Tonie Morgan recorded her first collegiate triple-double performance against Clemson on Jan. 19. Morgan logged a career-high 14 assists to go with 12 points and 12 rebounds. It marked only the fourth triple-double in Georgia Tech women's basketball history and the first since 2002.

It was also the first-ever triple-double recorded against an ACC opponent in program history.

Only five players - Kymora Johnson (Virginia), Ta'Niya Latson (Florida State), Rose Micheaux (Virginia Tech), Olivia Miles (Notre Dame) and Tonie Morgan - have recorded triple-doubles in the ACC this season.

SIX IN DOUBLE FIGURES

Against Clemson, Georgia Tech registered six Yellow Jackets in double-figures - Kara Dunn (20), Kayla Blackshear (19), Tianna Thompson (13), Tonie Morgan (12), Rusne Augustinaite (11) and Chit-Chat Wright (10).

In the game, Tech also matched its season-high in assists, finishing with 28. Tech also recorded 28 against FAMU on Dec. 1.

It marked the first time six players finished in double figures since Dec. 5, 2015 when Georgia Tech edged USC Upstate, 87-46. In that game, Aaliyah Whiteside posted a double-double and Roddreka Rogers just missed a double-double with 19 points and nine rebounds.

The Jackets also recorded six in double figures against Mississippi Valley on Dec. 13, 2009, resulting in an 89-41 victory.

As of Feb. 24 games, Georgia Tech is one of eight teams in the ACC to have six players reach double figures in a game - Duke (2), Louisville (2), North Carolina (2), NC State (1), Notre Dame (2), Syracuse (1), Wake Forest (1).

DUNN, MORGAN COMBINE

Against Virginia Tech, Kara Dunn and Tonie Morgan combined to score 61 points in the double-overtime loss. Dunn finished with a game-high 33 points to mark a season-high and her third game scoring 30 or more points in her career (her career-high is 39 set against Georgia State last season).

Meanwhile, Morgan dropped in a career-high 28 points, helping the junior surpass 1,000-career points. Morgan became the 35th player in program history to join the elite club. Morgan hit 1,000 on a driving layup at the 7:03 mark of the second quarter.

With Dunn and Morgan both contributing over 20 points in the game, it marked the fourth time this season at least two players scored 20-plus points. Additional times include:

*vs. Georgia (11/7/24) - Dunn (25), Carnegie (20)

*at North Carolina (12/15/24) - Morgan (23), Carnegie (22)

*vs. Pittsburgh (12/29/24) - Dunn (28), Carnegie (24)

The double-overtime contest was the first since a loss to Pittsburgh on Feb. 12, 2023. It also marked the first overtime game for GT since a 71-66 win over Miami on March 3, 2024.

UTILIZING THE DEPTH

Georgia Tech averages 29.4 points per game off its bench, ranking second in the ACC and sixth overall in the nation in bench points per game. A strong component of that comes from Dani Carnegie who is second on the team offensively, averaging 13.1 points per game off the bench. But the Yellow Jackets have also seen solid production from Chit-Chat Wright (6.9 ppg), Rusne Augustinaite (5.3 ppg) and Kayla Blackshear (6.2 ppg) who all average over 5.0 points per game off the bench.

South Carolina leads the nation off the bench, averaging 42.0 points per game. Duke is the only other ACC team to rank nationally in the top 10 in this statistical category, coming in at No. 3.

ACC ROOKIE OF THE WEEK X 5

Freshman Dani Carnegie is on pace to make Georgia Tech program history, picking up her fourth-consecutive, and fifth overall, ACC Rookie of the Week honor on Jan. 6. Carnegie now becomes just the fourth Jacket in program history to earn at least five weekly rookie honors, and the first since 2016-17 (Francesca Pan). Niesha Butler owns Tech's record for most recorded ACC Rookie of the Week accolades, earning seven in 1998-99. The ACC record is 12 held by Hannah Hidalgo (Notre Dame - 23-24).

Carnegie collected her fifth ACC Rookie of the Week nod on Jan. 6 after dropping a career-high 28 points in the win against Syracuse. The freshman connected on 6-of-8 from three-point distance (also a career-best), while adding seven rebounds and four assists.

She earned her fourth ACC Rookie of the Week honor, being voted as such on Dec. 30 for the third-straight week. Carnegie dropped in 24 points, a season-high for the freshman, against Pitt. It marked her fourth 20-plus point game. With her fourth weekly honor, Carnegie becomes the first Yellow Jacket since 2018-19 to collect as many honors.

Carnegie collected her third ACC Rookie of the Week accolade on Dec. 23 after the Jackets defeated Rice and No. 23 Nebraska. Carnegie scored 20 points against the Cornhuskers and averaged 13.5 points and 7.0 rebounds per game during the week.

Carnegie received her second ACC Rookie of the Week honor on Dec. 16 after helping the Jackets pick up a pair of wins against Louisiana Monroe and No. 14 North Carolina. The freshman averaged 18.0 points and 8.5 rebounds in Tech's two games to lead the Yellow Jackets on the week. She hit a team-high six three-pointers in the two games, while going a perfect 4-for-4 at the free throw line.

Carnegie collected her first weekly honor on Nov. 18, earning ACC Co-Rookie of the Week accolades. The newcomer averaged 17.5 points per game, helping lift Georgia Tech to a pair of wins over West Georgia and Georgia. She led Tech from three-point distance, hitting seven between the two games, and shot 46.4 percent from the field. Carnegie led Tech against West Georgia with 15 points before logging her first collegiate 20-point outing, dropping 20 against Georgia.

ARI THE HELPER

Sophomore center Ariadna Termis currently ranks third on the team in assists with 60 on the season. Termis ranked as high as second in the ACC in assist/turnover ratio and ranked 15th nationally in that statistical category until recently. She was the only non-guard to rank in the top 10 in assist/turnover ratio at the national level.

USBWA NATIONAL PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Junior Kara Dunn earned national recognition on Dec. 31, being named one of five USBWA National Players of the Week. Dunn helped Tech to a 100-61 rout over Pittsburgh, finishing with a team-high 28 points, 20 coming in the first half. The junior converted 10 field goals and went 7-for-8 at the free throw line, while pulling down a team-high seven rebounds and dishing out three assists.

The 28-point performance marked her third game this season with 20-plus points. She has recorded double figures in 23 games thus far.

Dunn joined teammate Tonie Morgan in the 1,000-career point club, surpassing the mark against Duke.

LOGGING 100

Against Pittsburgh, Georgia Tech logged 100 points for the first time since a 102-49 victory over Southeastern Louisiana on Nov. 18, 2015. It was also the first 100-point game against an ACC opponent since a 103-101 double-overtime loss at Virginia on March 2, 2008. Georgia Tech has scored 100 points against an ACC opponent only four times in program history.

The 39-point victory over Pitt also becomes the largest margin of victory over an ACC opponent in program history. The previous high was 37 points in an 85-48 win over Boston College on Feb. 19, 2012.

GOING THE DISTANCE

Sophomore Rusne Augustinaite held a three-point shooting clinic against Rice (Dec. 18), connecting of 7-of-11 from beyond the arc for a career-high made. Augustinaite finished with a season-high 23 points in the win over the Owls, leading a quartet of Jackets in double-figures.

In the game, Tech finished with 13 triples made. To date, Tech has hit 10 or more three-pointers in a game six times this season, most recently with 12 against Pitt. As a team, Tech is third in the ACC in 3-point field goals made, following only Florida State and California.

OPENING ACC PLAY

Georgia Tech kept their record unblemished picking up its second ranked win of the season with an 82-76 win at No. 14 North Carolina. Tonie Morgan logged her then seventh game in double-figures, leading Tech with 23 points. The Jackets shook off a slow start and scored 82 points against the ACC's leading defensive team. Tech also held UNC's leading scorer, Alyssa Ustby, to a mere two points at the charity stripe and no field goals. The Jackets went to the free throw line for a season-high 18 attempts and converted 16.

The win snapped a six-game skid when playing in Chapel Hill and was the fourth win over a Top 50 NET team this season.

60-POINT ROUT

Georgia Tech cruised to a 97-37 victory over Louisiana Monroe on Dec. 11 to improve to 10-0 on the season. Four different Yellow Jackets finished in double-figures. Rusne Augustinaite led Tech offensively for the first time this season, dropping 17 points after a 5-for-10 effort from three-point distance. Several Jackets were just shy of a double-double, including Dani Carnegie who finished with 14 points and eight rebounds and Zoesha Smith (nine rebounds, eight points).

Tech hit 14 three-pointers in the outing, nearly matching its program record set this season. Five Jackets connected from three-point land. To date, Georgia Tech has had five different Jackets connect on a three-pointer in seven games, highlighted by seven Jackets against FAMU.

ULM committed more turnovers than made field goals in the outing, owning 25 miscues to 16 made field goals. The Warhawks were limited to one player in double-figures and shot just 25.8 percent from the field. Tech has held three opponents to under 30 percent shooting this season - Georgia State, Mercer and ULM.

LENDING A HAND

Having logged 15 or more assists in every game but six thus far this season, Georgia Tech currently leads the ACC in assists, averaging 18.21 per game. Notre Dame sits in second, averaging 18.00. Tech recorded a season-high 28 in its win over Florida A&M (Dec. 1) and matched that in its win against Clemson on Jan. 19. Tech has dished out 20 or more assists 12 times this season. Tech was held to a season-low three assists against South Dakota State in the opening game of the Hawaii North Shore Showcase.

Tonie Morgan currently leads Georgia Tech on the year with 163 assists for a 5.62 assists per game average. The junior is third in the ACC in assists and 15th nationally in the statistical category. She also ranks third in the ACC in assist/turnover ratio. In ACC games only, Morgan is second in the league in assists, averaging 6.00 per game, recently surpassing Olivia Miles (Notre Dame).

SEC/ACC CHALLENGE

The 2024-25 season marked the second edition of the SEC/ACC Challenge. Georgia Tech drew Mississippi State this season in a rematch of the WBIT first round game that closed last season for the Yellow Jackets.

In the seventh meeting between the programs, Georgia Tech avenged a loss to MSU last season, collecting a 78-75 victory over the Bulldogs. Tech hit 12 three-pointers in the victory to overcome a halftime deficit as the teams stood tied with five minutes to play. After struggling in the first half offensively, freshman Dani Carnegie came up big in the fourth quarter, scoring 10 points, including a pair of free throws in the final seconds to extend Tech's lead to three. Kara Dunn registered a team-high 23 points, while Tonie Morgan logged 15 points and eight assists in the win.

In the game, Tech attempted a program-high 38 three-pointers, surpassing the previous high of 36 set against Clemson on Feb. 19, 2004.

Rusne Augustinaite has seen success in the Challenge, having recorded a career-night in Tech's first Challenge game last year against Florida. The then-freshman dropped 30 points against Florida. The Jackets recorded their first win in the Challenge this season, having dropped a 68-58 decision to the Gators last year.

PROGRAM RECORD 3'S

Georgia Tech is setting records this season, having produced a new program single-game record against Florida A&M on Dec. 1. Connecting on 15 three-pointers, the Yellow Jackets topped the previous single-game record of 14 made against Appalachian State on Dec. 11, 2016. Seven different Yellow Jackets connected beyond the arc against the Rattlers to help Tech set the new program record. In the win, the Jackets shot an astounding 61.7 percent from the floor, marking the first time Tech has shot 60 percent or better since defeating Kennesaw State on Nov. 22, 2011 when it hit 63.5 percent.

To continue breaking records, Tech attempted 38 three-pointers against Mississippi State to set a new program high in that statistical category. The 38 three-point attempts also ties for the second most attempts in the ACC this season - Cal attempted 40 against Stanford.

To date, Georgia Tech has connected on 10-plus from beyond the arc in six games:

OFF TO A STRONG START

With its win at UNC on Dec. 15, Georgia Tech officially sealed the best start in program history at 11-0. The previous high was a 10-0 start in the 1977-78 season. Additionally, with its win over Pittsburgh, Georgia Tech recorded the best win streak in program history at 14 consecutive victories.

HAWAI'I CHAMPIONS

Collecting two wins in Hawai'i, Georgia Tech was crowned the 2024 Hawaii North Shore Showcase Champions with wins over South Dakota State and No. 21 Oregon. Tonie Morgan was tabbed the Tournament MVP after averaging a team-high 15.5 points and 9.0 rebounds per game, while tying for team-high in assists with seven. Ariadna Termis also took home some hardware being named to the All-Star Team. Termis finished second on the team in scoring, averaing 10.5 points per game and hit a team-high five three-pointers between the two games.

The win over No. 21 Oregon marked the first ranked win since Tech defeated No. 15 NC State, 68-62, on Feb. 2, 2023. It was the 10th win over a ranked opponent in the Nell Fortner era. Since Hawai'i, Tech has picked up two more wins over ranked foes to total 13 ranked wins under Fortner.

WHAT'S NEW TERMIS?

Having spent the summer in Atlanta working on the court and in the weight room, sophomore Ariadna Termis has seen much improvement on the floor this season. Termis scored a career-best 13 points in Tech's win over No. 21 Oregon, leading the Yellow Jackets offensively in the victory. Termis reached 13 points hitting five field goals, including three triples to match her personal-best

Termis hit two or more three-pointers in a streak of three-straight games, capped against Oregon. In two years, the sophomore has connected on multiple three-pointers in a game in nine outings. Currently averaging 4.4 points per game on the season, Termis has doubled her scoring average since last year when she contributed 2.6 points per game as a freshman.

THERE'S ALWAYS A FIRST

Junior guard Kara Dunn recorded her first collegiate double-double in Tech's win against Georgia State, logging 11 points and 13 rebounds. Dunn led Tech in rebounding on the night with her personal-high.

Dunn logged her second career double-double in its win over Nebraska with 16 points and a career-high 14 rebounds, and followed with her third double-double against Virginia Tech (33 points, 10 rebounds). She has led the Jackets in rebounding in nine games this season.

Dunn flirted with a double-double multiple times in her career, but never surpassed the mark. Her 14 rebounds against Nebraska topped her previous career-high of 13, set against Georgia State earlier this season.

CARNEGIE CAN

Freshman Dani Carnegie has made an immediate impact her inaugural season, leading the Yellow Jackets offensively in six games. To date, Carnegie owns 18 games scoring in double-figures and six with 20 more more points. She scored a career-high 29 points in the win at Virginia.

Carnegie became the first freshman Yellow Jacket to post back-to-back double-figure games to open their freshman season since 2018-19. Additionally, her 17 points in her collegiate

SEASON OPENING DOMINANCE

Georgia Tech opened the 2024-25 collegiate basketball season across the country, playing the first game of the year. Tech welcomed Winthrop for "Education Day" on Nov. 4 and collected a dominating win to improve to 6-0 in season-openers under head coach Nell Fortner. The Jackets collected an 85-39 victory over the Eagles behind a 53.8 percent shooting effort, paced by four in double figures.

Tech's highly-touted freshmen class combined for 32 points and 11 rebounds led by Dani Carnegie's team-high 17-point performance. Three of the four freshmen connected at least once from three-point distance - Carnegie, Grooms and Wright - while all four contributed offensively.

The Jackets distributed the ball well its in opener, tallying 25 assists on 35 made field goals. Three different Jackets - Morgan, Termis and Wright - led the way, all with six assists each.

PRESEASON TUNE-UP

Georgia Tech held its final preseason tune-up against Anderson University in an exhibition game on Halloween. A total of 11 Yellow Jackets took the floor and all 11 contributed offensively in the 109-53 victory. Zoe Smith and Kara Dunn led Tech offensively, each chipping in 18 points, as five Jackets finished in double-figures. Four of Tech's five starters finished in double-figures, including Arianda Termis who tallied 12 points and a team-best seven rebounds.

Tech's 12th-ranked freshmen class saw promising minutes in exhibition play, tallying a combined 31 points, 15 rebounds, eight assists, four steals and three blocks. Tianna Thompson paced the freshmen class with 13 points, going 5-for-7 from the field, including a 2-for-3 effort from three-point range.

RETURNING A CORE NUCLEUS

Tech returns a core nucleus of seven letterwinners, therefore bringing back 92% of its scoring and 87% of its rebounding from last season. In addition, the seven letterwinners accounted for 88.6 percent of the shots taken and 95.7 percent the free throws attempted.

In addition to its scoring and rebounding returning, Georgia Tech brings back the majority of production from last season. The Yellow Jackets return solid production in blocks (89.8%), three-pointers (87.9%), steals (81.5%), minutes (80.5%) and assists (79.1%).

STRENGTH OF SCHEDULE

Georgia Tech will face a competitive schedule this year with 16 opponents on the slate having reached postseason play last season. Of those 16 postseason teams, 13 participated in the NCAA Tournament and three reached the Sweet 16. The Yellow Jackets will spend part of their Thanksgiving break in Hawai'i, opening the North Shore Showcase against Summit League defending champions, South Dakota State.

BACK FOR YEAR SIX

Georgia Tech returns for its sixth season under head coach Nell Fortner in 2024-25, looking to improve upon last season's 17-16 overall record and 7-11 mark in league action. Tech reached postseason play last year, participating in the inaugural WBIT.

In five years with Nell Fortner at the helm, the Yellow Jackets have reached postseason play three times (while qualifying a fourth time before Covid-19), including back-to-back appearances in the NCAA Tournament (2022 and 2021). In 2021, Tech reached the Sweet 16 for just the second time in program history. Last season, the Yellow Jackets earned a bid to the inaugural Women's Basketball Invitation Tournament (WBIT).

Tech's win against Rice on Dec. 18 marked the 100th win for Coach Fortner at Georgia Tech. As the head coach of the Yellow Jackets, Fortner boasts a 109-72 record.

50TH ANNIVERSARY

Georgia Tech will celebrate the 50th anniversary of women's basketball on The Flats during the 2024-25 season. Tech's first varsity female sports team, women's basketball started in 1974-75 and has amassed 795 wins since. In 50 seasons, Georgia Tech has made 11 NCAA Tournament appearances, eight WNIT appearances, and seven GAIAW State Tournaments. The Yellow Jackets made their first postseason appearance in school history in 1992 and won the NWIT in Amarillo, Texas. The win also marked the first NWIT title for an ACC school.

Tech made its first NCAA Tournament appearance in 1992-93. The Jackets didn't return for 10 years, making its next trip in 2003, but then participated in every Big Dance from 2007-2012. In 2012, Tech made its first-ever run to the Sweet 16. The

Jackets would return to the Sweet 16 in 2021 with Nell Fortner at the helm.

VERSATILE MORGAN

Tonie Morgan has put together quite the collegiate career on The Flats thus far. After earning ACC All-Freshman Team honors and two ACC Rookie of the Week nods in 2022-23, the Jacket continued her impressive ways as a sophomore last season. Morgan received all-ACC second team honors after leading the Jackets with 15.6 points and 6.8 rebounds per game. She added to her resume with ACC All-Tournament second team honors and a Cancun Challenge all-tournament team selection.

Morgan finished last year with eight double-doubles and posted double-figure scoring totals in 29 games. Morgan also led the Jackets in assists (170) and steals (55). Nationally, she finished the season ranked 33rd in assists (170) and 35th in assists per game (5.2).



The junior surpassed 1,000-career points against Virginia Tech to become the 35th player in program history to join the elite club.

DUNN LAST SEASON

Kara Dunn narrowly finished outside the top spot on the team in scoring as a sophomore last season, averaging 15.5 points per game (Tonie Morgan averaged 15.6 ppg). She led the team in free throw percentage (.782), while finishing second in three-pointers made with 39 to earn her all-ACC second team honors. In ACC games only, Dunn finished 10th in scoring, dropping 16.72 points per gamne on average.

Among her accolades last season, Dunn had some impressive outings. In Tech's game at NC State, Dunn hit a remarkable three-pointer as time expired in regulation to force overtime, while also earning her a spot on ESPN SportsCenter Top 10.

Against Georgia State (Dec. 10, 2023), Dunn dropped a career-high 39 points to become the first Yellow Jacket since 1999 to score that many points in a game, earning her ACC Player of the Week honors.

STEADY ON THE BOARDS

Kayla Blackshear has been a steady producer on the boards for Georgia Tech since she arrived on The Flats. Last season, Blackshear secured 6.3 rebounds per game to finish second on the team. She led the team in rebounding in nine games and recorded four outings with double-figure rebounding totals. In her three seasons on The Flats to date, Blackshear has led Georgia Tech in rebounding in 25 games dating back to the 2022-23 season.

TECH LEGACY

Freshman Tianna Thompson is no stranger to Georgia Tech, as her father, Rich, ran track and field for the White and Gold from 1988-91. An All-American and Olympic Trials finalist, Rich Thompson was inducted into the Georgia Tech Sports Hall of Fame in 2001. Thompson was tabbed outdoor all-American in the triple jump in 1989 and 1991, while collecting indoor honors in 1991, also for triple jump. He was also a multiple all-ACC honoree.

MCKAYLA TAYLOR SIGNEE

On National Signing Day, Nov. 13, Georgia Tech signed Atlanta native McKayla Taylor to join the program in 2025-26. A GHSA 6A region 5 player of the year, Taylor has averaged 11.5 points and 11.8 rebounds per game in her three seasons at Langston Hughes High School. She is the No. 4-ranked center in the state of Georgia by Sandy's Spiel and was tabbed a 2023-24 6A all-state honorable mention by the same organization. Taylor was a 2024 Atlanta Journal Constitution 6A all-state second team selection and is a two-time Atlanta Public Schools MVP (2019 and 2020).

Taylor helped Langston Hughes reach the 2023 GHSA 6A Final Four after averaging 10.0 points and 10.7 rebounds per game her sophomore season. She currently owns over 500 career points and 500 career rebounds at Langston Hughes. Taylor played in the same AAU organization as current Yellow Jackets, Dani Carnegie and Chit-Chat Wright.

BASKETBALL HERITAGE

Continuing the theme of basketball families, freshman Gabbie Grooms shares a connection with teammate Kara Dunn as Grooms' mother also played collegiate basketball at the University of Georgia. Lady Grooms (Hardmon) played at UGA from 1989-92, played in 121 games and started 110, donning No. 23. She finished her collegiate career with 1,397 points for an 11.5 average and helped the Bulldogs to the 1991 SEC Championship.

Kara Dunn's mother, Stephanie Wheeler, also played at Georgia (1992-95) and was a member of the 1995 NCAA Final Four team.

HITTING THE PORTAL

Georgia Tech picked up a fifth-year transfer out of the portal over the summer in Zoe Smith, who played four seasons at the University of Georgia. The Brunswick, Ga., native appeared in 74 games and started in 19 while a Bulldog. Smith completed her four years in Athens averaging 5.8 points and 3.5 rebounds per game, while shooting 46.8 percent from the floor. She scored a career-high 21 points as a junior against Georgia Tech. Smith graduated from Georgia with a degree in human development and social sciences.

LAST SEASON RECAP

Georgia Tech capped last season with a 17-16 overall record, a four-win improvement from the season before when the Jackets went 13-17 in 2022-23. The Yellow Jackets reached the second round of the ACC Tournament last year, downing Pitt before falling to Duke in the second round.

For the third year under Nell Fortner, Tech reached postseason play, earning a bid to the inaugural Women's Basketball Invitation Tournament (WBIT). Tech dropped a first-round matchup at Mississippi State, but will meet the Bulldogs against this year in the SEC/ACC Challenge.

GOING DANCING

Under the direction of head coach Nell Fortner, Georgia Tech made back-to-back NCAA Tournament appearances in 2021 and 2022, marking the first time Tech has made consecutive appearances since six-straight from 2007-12.

Tech reached the Sweet 16 for just the second time in program history in 2021. Tech's appearance in 2022 marked the 11th in the Big Dance.

HOME SWEET HOME

All time, the Yellow Jackets are 431-239 (.620) when playing at home. The Jackets have won the last 11-consecutive home openers dating back to the 2012-13 season. Last season, Tech

HEAD COACH NELL FORTNER

6th Season • Texas '82

Nell Fortner was named the sixth head coach of Georgia Tech women's basketball on April 9, 2019. One of the most successful coaches in women's basketball history, Fortner has compiled a 414-259 (.615) record as a head coach at the collegiate, professional and international levels. She has led teams to Big Ten (Purdue – 1997) and Southeastern Conference (Auburn – 2009) championships and, perhaps most notably, coached the United States national team to three international titles from 1997-2000, including the gold medal at the 2000 Summer Olympics in Sydney, Australia. Fortner is the winningest coach in the history of the USA women's basketball national team, having compiled a 101-14 (.878) record. In addition to the 2000 Olympics championship, she also led the team to the gold medal at the 1998 World Championship in Berlin, Germany and the 1998 William Jones Cup in Taipei, Taiwan. At the collegiate level, Fortner has 14 seasons of experience as a head coach – one at Purdue (1996-97), eight at Auburn (2004-12) and six at Georgia Tech (2019-pres.) – and has compiled a 271-189 (.585) overall record in the college ranks.
