NOTES FROM THE DIAMOND

A SPECIAL WEEKEND

A mountain of special performances and accolades highlighted the Owl's series win over Western Kentucky. Not only did they secure their first Conference USA win but they handed WKU their second and third losses of the season. The Hilltoppers came into the weekend with the second-best ERA (2.59) in the NCAA while the Owls compiled 18 runs over the three games, averaging six runs per game on the Conference USA leader. The Tops also stood atop CUSA in runs scored while the Owls pitching staff held them to 14 runs scored, sporting three pitchers that went more than four innings deep (Gold, Cain & Rhudy). KSU cemented its largest margin of victory with a six-run win on Sunday. With two wins versus WKU, The Black and Gold rocketed up the RPI ranks, jumping 38 spots.

CASH IN THE BOOK

First baseman Donovan Cash is methodically working his way up the DI career records in KSU history. Entering the midweek, he is just two home runs away from breaking Andy Chriscaden's record of 29. Cash has placed himself second in career RBI with 149, three away from breaking Ronnie Freeman's record of 151. He has placed himself ninth in career hits with 221.

SERIES HISTORY

Turning the tides in the series history, Coe seeks to earn his third win versus Georgia Tech. The Yellow Jackets swiped the first game on March 4 in Atlanta with a 1-4 final. The all-time book favors the Yellow Jackets 26-8 while Kennesaw State has snagged two wins in the Coe era with the most recent victory coming in 2023. In KSU's previous victory (5/10/24), Smith Pinson earned the start while Nolan Sliver nabbed the win by pitching 2.2 innings with two punch outs in the 6-5 win.

100 FOR OUR GUY

On March 12 at Mercer, Kennesaw State scored in five-straight innings to defeat the in-state rival. The win marked head coach Ryan Coe's 100th career victory at the helm - joining his former coach and KSU Athletics Hall of Famer Mike Sansing as the only two to eclipse 100.

COLE CONTINUES TO BURN

Center fielder Chris Cole has been the poster child of “picking up where you left off” this season. The junior has slashed a .348 Avg. and 12 stolen bases. Cole ended the ‘24 campaign with a team-high .345 average. Through 72 at-bats, Cole maintains a .483 on-base percentage alongside a .955 on-base plus slugging. The lefty from Dallas, Ga. is hitting a whopping .486 when leading off an inning. He broke into the top 10 in Division-I program history in career stolen bases, standing in sixth place with 32 bags. He is four stolen bases away from cracking the top 10 all-time list.

PUNCHES IN BUNCHES

The stat sheet will tell much of the story for the Owl’s turnaround in the last two games versus Columbia, they collected a plethora of hits and runs. Over the final 18 innings of the series, KSU posted 25 hits and 17 runs. The Black and Gold registered 15 hits in Sunday’s battle versus Columbia, maintaining a perfect record in the Ryan Coe era. Since he began in 2022, KSU is now 20-0 when racking up 15 or more hits in a single game.

DROP-OFF

There is quite a bit of familiarity with the Owls through the first month and a half of the season as they have at least one game played versus the first eight opponents. Through the rest of the season, KSU will face eight opponents for the first time in program history including six first-time CUSA matchups.

BRIGHT SPOTS IN THE PEN

Among all of the arms from the pen versus Columbia, there were a few that had show-stopping performances. Ty Bayer tossed his first collegiate winning performance as his line read: 4.1 IP, six strikeouts and one hit allowed, sustaining life for the Owls in the cornerstone Saturday win. Harry Cain was lockdown in Sunday’s win, pitching three innings without allowing a run. The hard-throwing reliever showcased his power on the mound with three punch outs and only one hit allowed. Finalizing the series win was preseason All-CUSA selection Bo Rhudy, the sophomore earned his second save of the year recording the final eight outs, and striking out six Lion batters.

SLATED FOR ‘25

Kennesaw State’s first season in CUSA comes with a slew of impressive opponents. The Owls will face five 2024 regional squads in Georgia, Georgia Tech, West Virginia along with CUSA foes Dallas Baptist and La. Tech. KSU will face 12 teams who registered an above .500 record last season featuring eight of the first ten opponents. They will leave February playing only one below .500 team. Four futures foes registered a Top 50 RPI

UNBEATEN NO MORE

The Black and Gold traveled on the country roads during the second weekend of March for their first-ever series against West Virginia. In game two of the series, the Owls entered the ninth down 9-7 before a game-tying blast from Cam Suto allowed a go-ahead grand slam from Donovan Cash. Ryan Renfroie threw the final three innings of scoreless, one-hit ball to slam the door on the Mountaineer offense. The KSU victory ended West Virginia’s perfect start to the season of 13-0 and was the only loss of the non-conference season for West Virginia.

MADNESS IN MARIETTA

Feb. 22’s win over reigning Ivy League Champion Columbia was packed full of drama, with KSU walking it off via the wild pitch in the 10-9 ninth-inning victory. A five-run final inning completed the largest comeback since March 22, 2022, when the Owls overcame seven runs from UNF.

It’s the second-largest comeback of the Ryan Coe era. They did so with patience and aggression at the plate with four base knocks (three doubles) and three straight free passes (walk, hit by pitch and wild pitch). Freshman catcher James McGee entered as a pinch hitter in the ninth and lined a double down the left field line, scoring Chris Cole and marking his first collegiate hit.

ANDERSON’S CAREER DAY

Sunday against Columbia not only secured the Owl’s first series win of the season but it showcased an astounding performance from outfielder Nate Anderson.

The lefty pounded his second homer of the season as he lifted a three-run shot over the right field fence, solidifying the win for KSU. Earlier in the game, he ripped a triple, scoring two runs and creating a five RBI day, a career-high for the redshirt senior. It’s the first time since Nick Colina on Feb. 19, 2023 that an Owl collected a triple and a home run in the same game as he fell just one double shy of hitting for the cycle.

RESPECT THE NAME

During the fall, D1Baseball declared the Owls as the 85th best program in the country. D1Baseball releases its “Top 100” every few years with the last rankings coming in 2022, 2019, 2017, 2015. It’s the Owls highest ranking and the last ranking since 2005 when they were tabbed 86th.

S. WALTER KELLY SR. MEMORIAL FIELD

For the duration of the 2025 season, Kennesaw State will be returning to Marietta, Ga. as they will play at S. Walter Kelly Sr. Memorial Field for the first time in 10 years. With Mickey Dunn Stadium still under construction, the Owls will return to their roots as the field served as the home to Southern Polytechnic baseball from 1975-2014. Recent upgrades have been made to the historic field including improved lights, dugouts and much more.

S. Walter Kelly (1896-1973), a WWI Navy veteran, was a vital part of brokering the land deal that allowed STI to move to Marietta from its initial location, a repurposed Army base in Chamblee, DeKalb County.

NOTES FROM THE DIAMOND

PITCHING BRILLIANCE

Facing a lethal lineup versus the Hilltoppers, Kennesaw State's arms shined. Out of the pen, Ryan Gold dialed in his strongest performance of the season with five scoreless innings and racking up a career-high seven strikeouts in the win. Although Saturday didn't go the Owl's direction, Harry Cain tossed a career-best 5.1 inning while allowing only two earned runs. Dazzling in Sunday's throw-down was Bo Rhudy as he stacked 4.1 scoreless innings of work, allowing just three hits in his win.

RETURN OF THE JACK

After battling an injury, Jackson Chirello made his season debut versus Georgia Tech (3/4/25). The highly touted outfielder came into form at the tail end of the 2023 season. In May, the 6'6" lefty raised his batting average by .22 while posting 16 hits in just 14 games.

During that stretch, he garnered seven hits in the final regular season series versus the then defending ASUN champion Lipscomb Bisons. During the offseason, Chirello was listed in DiBaseball's Top 150 College MLB Draft Prospects while also cracking the Top 300 among Perfect Game's ranks. The junior was tabbed at 146th and 254th. He is

currently riding a reached-base streak of 10 games.

FANTASTIC FRESHMEN CLASS

The Owls staff aren't the only ones who are excited about the current freshmen class. Perfect Game recognized KSU with the 44th best recruiting class in the country. They are ranked as the best class in CUSA, pacing FIU at 51st while they are also just one of three teams in the top 100.

The program ranks well in the state of Georgia, ranking well above in-state rivals Georgia Southern (76), Georgia State (71) and Mercer (57).

Perfect Game listed three Owls in its "Top 500 Fresh Arrivals on Campus," with Tyler Bayer (210), Nolan McKinstry (423) and Ethan Osada (471).

BACK IN THE FOLD

Returning to KSU are three studs in the field with Chris Cole, Jackson Chirello and Shamaar McDuffie.

Cole paced the Owls last season with a .345 average, knocking on the door of top 10 all-time in program history in a single season.

Outfielder Jackson Chirello ended the '24 campaign with a .290 average, 49 hits along with an Atlantic Sun All-Tournament team bid. ASUN All-Freshman member Shamaar McDuffie is back to anchor down shortstop in his sophomore season. The sure-handed infielder turned 25 doubles plays while leading the team with 140 assists.

NO DONUTS AT HOME

Inside the friendly confines of Stillwell Stadium and Walter Kelly Field, Kennesaw State baseball had not been shutout in an CUSA-best 189 home contests - the fourth-longest streak in the nation.

KSU was last shutout at home on Feb. 27, 2018. The Owls have not placed a zero on the home scoreboard under head coach Ryan Coe

FIRST OF MANY

In the first square-down of the season, KSU defeated Rutgers 5-3 on the back of a five-run seventh inning. It marked not only the first win of the season but also the first win as a member of CUSA for the Owls. KSU knocked off a Big 10 opponent for the first time since they defeated Michigan in 2023.

NEW BATTERIES

The Owls have met the tall task of replacing a five-year starting catcher (Nick Hassan) with a youth movement. Starting behind the dish is junior Aaron Posey who recorded 29 starts in his 32 games last year but the rest of the position has been filled with freshmen. James McGee, Ethan Finch and Evan Holstein are a trio of newcomers all from the Peach State.

It's the first time in the Ryan Coe era that there have been three freshman catchers on a roster and the first time since 2021.

THE STREAK

Kennesaw State pitcher Blake Aita was selected 177th overall in the sixth round of the 2024 Major League Baseball First Year Player Draft Monday afternoon by the Boston Red Sox.

Aita's selection marks the 16th-consecutive year an Owl has been drafted not counting the shortened 2020 MLB Draft. He is the second-straight Owl taken by the Red Sox after Blake Wehunt was drafted in 2023.

NEW IN THE NEST

Supplementing the existing core of the team are 17 newcomers including 12 freshmen and five transfers. Coe and the Owls brought in six freshmen arms ranging from Hiram, Ga. to Dana Point Calif. Highlighting the freshman position players is Wes Alig, a winner of the Mr. Baseball Award of Tennessee in 2024.

Lee University transfer Cam Suto is returning home after spending three with the Flames after graduating from Sprayberry High School in Marietta. The infielder posted 40 home runs over his three seasons in Cleveland, Tenn.

HYPE TRAIN

The incoming freshman class is boldened by RHP/UTL player Ty Bayer. The do-it-all freshman was selected in the 19th round of the 2024 MLB Draft by the Arizona Diamondbacks.

Bayer was tabbed as the Preseason Freshman of the Year by Perfect Game. The righty was a two-time PG and PBR All-American. The Cumming, Ga. native was the 29th ranked prospect from the state of Georgia.

NOW YOU KNOW BO

Sophomore relief pitcher Bo Rhudy was selected to the Conference USA Baseball Preseason All-Conference Team, serving as the first CUSA award in program history. Rhudy burst onto the scene as a freshman, racking up a 4-1 record on 19 appearances with six saves out of the bullpen. The righty posted a 2.78 ERA in his 35.2 innings of work, collecting 32 strikeouts. The Chickamauga, Ga. native earned a stockpile of awards in his first season earning Atlantic Sun All-Freshman Team, Atlantic Sun All-Tournament Team and All-Atlantic Sun First Team, receiving the most votes of any relief pitcher.

KENNESAW STATE BASEBALL HEAD COACH RYAN COE

Ryan Coe enters his fourth season as head coach of the Owls in 2024. He was named the head baseball coach at Kennesaw State University in July of 2021 and became the sixth head coach in KSU history.

In 2024, the Owls tallied a 32-24 record including a seven-game win streak that featured three one-run wins in the ASUN tournament. The Owls defeated No. 10 Clemson 18-1 on Feb. 23, handing the Tigers their worst home loss since 1936. Coe's Owls also took two of three from eventual SEC Regular Season Champion No. 25 Kentucky. Kennesaw State defeated Stetson, FGCU and Central Arkansas en route to the second Atlantic Sun Championship Game berth in his three-year tenure.

KSU baseball continues to ascend nationally as the 2024 off season provided several accolades for the program. D1Baseball ranked the Owls the 85th best program in the country, cracking the organizations "Top 100". Perfect Game also highlighted the Owls as they landed three players in the top 500 prospects incoming D-I prospects. PG ranked the Owls as the 44th best recruiting class in the nation, besting three in-state programs (Georgia State, Georgia Southern and Mercer) and marking the best class in CUSA.

In 2024, the Owls tallied a 32-24 record including a seven-game win streak that featured three one-run wins in the ASUN tournament. Perfect Game also highlighted the Owls as they landed three players in the top 500 prospects incoming D-I prospects. PG ranked the Owls as the 44th best recruiting class in the nation, besting three in-state programs (Georgia State, Georgia Southern and Mercer) and marking the best class in CUSA.

In his first year leading the Owls, Coe became the only head coach in ASUN Conference history to win the league's tournament in his first season with the team. Coe led Kennesaw State to a 36-28 record and an appearance in the NCAA Regionals for the first time since 2014. The Owls finished conference play with a 19-11 record and were crowned co-champions of the ASUN East Division while setting a new program record for the most conference wins in a single season.

After suffering losses in their first two games of the conference tournament, Coe and the Owls battled back and won three-straight elimination games to earn the team's first ASUN Tournament Championship in eight years. KSU defeated Liberty 10-6 in the finale and had five players selected to the All-Tournament Team, including the ASUN Tournament MVP, Josh Hatcher.

At the Hattiesburg Regional, Coe led KSU to its first win in the NCAA tournament since Kennesaw State downed the University of Alabama in the 2014 Tallahassee Regional final. Coe and the Owls earned a tough win over Army West Point, 9-8, with two late runs that completed the comeback. At the conclusion of the tournament, the Owls placed two on the Hattiesburg Regional All-Tournament Team in Hatcher and Tyler Simon.

The duo of Hatcher and Simon paced the high-powered KSU offense that broke multiple single-season program records in 2022. These included most home runs (70), runs batted in (408), total bases (1,035) and runs scored (455) in a season. Coe's offense also collected a .301 batting average and marked the second time in KSU history the Owls finished over .300 in this category.

In his first year as head coach of the Owls, Coe guided Hatcher to one of the best individual offensive seasons in Kennesaw State history. The outfielder ended the year ranked first in the NCAA in both hits (109) and doubles (26). He was a first-team All-ASUN selection and Collegiate Baseball Third Team All-American.

Coe's second season as head coach featured a young team where 12 underclassmen saw significant playing time. The team was led by ninth-round MLB Draft pick, Blake Wehunt, the team's Friday night starter who was selected by the Boston Red Sox. Wehunt's selection extended Kennesaw State baseball's streak to 15 consecutive years with at least one player drafted (excluding the 2020 COVID shortened draft).

Immediately upon his arrival, Coe hit the recruiting trail. In his first month as head coach, Coe put together an inaugural class which was recognized by Perfect Game USA as the 57th-ranked


