KEY THINGS TO KNOW

- 1. 5TH STRAIGHT TOP 25 ACC SERIES - Cal is playing its fifth straight ACC series against a team ranked in the top 25 of at least one national college baseball poll.
2. ADVINCULA ALL-AMERICAN WORTHY - 2B Jarren Advincula has put together an All-American caliber season through 32 games.
3. CADE CAMPBELL RETURNS - 3B Cade Campbell has returned to the lineup for the last three games as the starter at third base after having missed four-plus contests due to injury.
4. FRENCH, HANDRON STREAKS - OF Jacob French and INF/DH Max Handron both currently have eight game hit streaks.
5. SMALDINO ON FIRE - 1B Dominic Smaldino has arguably been Cal's hottest hitter of late with four homers in his last six games.
6. TIGHT BATTING AVERAGE RACE - Three different Golden Bears are in serious contention for the team's batting title with leader Jarren Advincula (.390) followed closely by Cade Campbell (.389) and Jacob French (.387).
7. BALLPARKS MATTER - Cal's numbers have been significantly different at home and on the road in 2025.
8. STATISTICAL ADVANTAGES - Despite being just two games over .500, Cal has

- Cal and Georgia Tech have played just twice previously both in NCAA Regionals
- The Golden Bears were a 3-2 winner in an East Regional elimination game played in Gainesville, Fla., on May 24, 1992, on their way to a Regional title and a spot in the College World Series
- On May 25, 1995, Cal was a 4-3 winner in an opening game of the Mideast Regional in Knoxville, Tenn., before dropping its next two contests

- some significant statistical advantages over its opponents including batting average (.297-.248), runs (239-189), hits (336-265), doubles (71-44), triples (12-1) and home runs (47-37).
9. LOTS OF HITS - Cal's offense has been potent for most of the 2025 season and through games of April 7 ranks among ACC and national leaders in triples (12, 1/20), doubles (71, 4/23), hits (336, 5/31) and home runs (47, 5/34).
10. TRIPLES DISCREPANCY - While Cal's 12 triples are tied for the most among ACC teams and 20th nationally, the Bears have allowed just a single triple all season.
11. STARTING TRIO - Cal has three players who have started all 32 games in 2025 in 2B Jarren Advincula (1 start at DH), SS PJ Moutzouridis and CF Seth Gwynn.
12. ON THIS DATE IN CAL BASEBALL - On April 11, 2010, the Bears closed out a three-game sweep at USC. It was Cal's first over the Trojans in Los Angeles since 1972.
13. BIG LEAGUERS - Cal has six former players currently on MLB rosters in OF/1B Mark Canha (Royals), RHP Lucas Erceg (Royals), C Korey Lee (White Sox), MGR Bob Melvin (San Francisco Giants), INF Marcus Semien (Rangers) and OF Andrew Vaughn (White Sox).

**At Cal**

**Career (2023 – Present)**

- Has a 6-5 record and a 4.94 earned run average with four saves in 51 appearances and 16 starts that are the most by any active Cal pitcher, while striking out 91 in 94.2 innings pitched that are also both the most among active Golden Bears
- Has allowed 64 runs (52 earned), 99 hits, 38 walks and 18 hit by pitches

**2025 (Jr.)**

- Has a pair of seven-inning complete games that rank him tied for first in the ACC and tied for second nationally
- Shares the team-lead in wins with a 4-3 record and has a 4.94 ERA with team highs of 40.2 innings pitched and 48 strikeouts that rank tied for 12th in the ACC and tied for 84th nationally over eight appearances and a team-high-tying eight starts that also share the ACC lead and rank tied for 19th nationally with each of his appearances coming as Cal's starting pitcher in the first game of each of the first eight series
- Has already picked up career highs in wins, innings pitched and strikeouts, while his opponents' batting average (.239) is also currently a career best
- Has allowed 26 runs (20 earned), 37 hits, 14 walks and eight hit by pitches

**Notable Games**

- Pitched the first 3.0 scoreless innings and was declared the winner due to a predetermined pitching rotation of three or more pitchers in Cal's season-opening 14-1 win over Nevada, allowing just one hit and two walks while striking out four
- Threw Cal's first complete game of 2025 and the first of his career to earn the win in the Golden Bears' first-ever ACC game on March 7 at Duke, allowing just one run (one earned) on a home run by Blue Devil leadoff hitter Wallace Clark in the bottom of the first, striking out a career-high 10, and allowing just three hits, two walks and one hit batsmen over 97 pitches
- Limited Virginia to one run and three hits over 6.2 innings on March 14 while striking out seven over 107 pitches
- Threw the second complete game of his career and second in his last three outings March 21 at Stanford, scattering three runs

### Career (2024 – Present)

#### 2025 (R-Fr.)

– Has a 2-2 record and a 4.96 ERA in 32.2 innings pitched over eight appearances and a team-high-tying eight starts that are also tied for first in the ACC and tied for 19th nationally with each of his eight outings coming as Cal's second starting pitcher in each of the the Golden Bears' eight series

– Has allowed 20 runs (18 earned) and 24 hits while striking out 24 and walking 20

– Has not pitched more than 1.1 innings in either of his last two starts March 29 at Louisville or April 5 against Clemson

#### Notable Games

– Pitched 4.0 innings in his collegiate debut against Nevada on Feb. 15, allowing one run, two hits, one walk, one hit batsmen, and two wild pitches, including one that scored the only run against him while striking out four batters

– Tossed 5.0 hitless innings against Houston on Feb. 22, walking three and striking out four as he retired 15 of the 18 batters he faced, with Cal taking a no-hitter into the ninth inning

– Threw 5.1 innings against Santa Clara on March 1 and was charged with the loss despite not allowing an earned run and giving up only hit (5.1 IP, 1 R, 0 ER, 1 H, 6 BB, 2 SO, 1 BK, 1 HBP)

– Scattered three hits, two runs (one earned) and one walk over 4.1 innings with five strikeouts March 8 at Duke

– Limited Virginia to two runs and four hits with two walks in 5.0 innings on March 15

– Career highs of 6.2 innings pitched, eight strikeouts and 106 pitches while earning the win in a March 22 victory at Stanford

**At Cal**

**Career (2024 - Present)**

- Has a 2-2 record and a 6.48 earned run average with 40 strikeouts over 33.1 innings in 14 appearances and three starts
- Has allowed 24 runs (24 earned), 36 hits, 17 walks and two hit by pitches

**2025 (So.)**

- Tied for fifth on team with nine appearances while making two starts including in his most recent appearance March 6 against Clemson while also starting February 16 in the third game of the first series of the season against Nevada
- Has a 2-2 record and a 5.32 ERA with 29 strikeouts in 23.2 innings pitched
- Has allowed 14 runs (14 earned) and 19 hits while striking out 29 and walking 10

**Notable Games**

- Had arguably the best performance of his career in his most outing March 29 at Louisville when he pitched the final 5.2 innings (career-high) and earned the victory in a 14-10 Cal win, allowing just one run (earned) and none over the final four frames, and striking out a career-high-tying eight over 86 pitches
- Also effective in four of his five previous outings on March 3 at Santa Clara (3.0 IP, 1 H, 2 BB, 4 SO, 1 WP), March 9 at Duke (0.2 IP, 1 SO), March 11 against Utah (1.2 IP, 1 SO) and March 22 at Stanford (4.0 IP, 1 R, 1 ER, 3 H, 1 BB, 1 HBP, 3 SO)
- Kept Cal in the game April 6 against Clemson, striking out a career-high-tying eight while scattering three runs (all earned), four hits and three walks over a career-high 100 pitches

**2024 (Fr.)**

- Was 0-0 with a 9.31 ERA in five appearances including one start

- Allowed 17 hits and 10 runs (10 earned) while striking out 11 and walking seven in 9.2 innings pitched for a .395 opponents' batting average and a 2.48 WHIP
- Did not pitch after Mar. 19

**Notable Games**

- Made his collegiate debut on Feb. 17 in a 12-3 win against Georgetown, striking out a career-high six in the longest outing of his career with 4.0 innings of work in which he allowed five hits, two runs (two earned) and one walk

## HEAD COACH MIKE NEU



Mike Neu is in his eighth season as Cal's head coach in 2025 and recently had the Golden Bears playing their best baseball of the campaign with a 7-2 mark on a season-long nine-game road trip March 18 - April 1 that included a historic series sweep March 21-23 at No. 14 Stanford that was Cal's first three-game road sweep of the Cardinal in recorded history and the first three-game sweep of the Cardinal regardless of location since taking all three in Berkeley in 1992. The five-game win streak came to an end when No. 6 Clemson swept the Bears this past Friday-Sunday before Cal recovered by pounding out a season-high 18 hits in a 14-8 win over Pacific in its most recent game April 7. Through 32 contests, Cal is 17-15 overall and 6-9 in ACC play.

Other big moments during the 2025 season in reverse chronological order have included a two-run rally in the top of the ninth April 1 to win at Sacramento State, a come-from-behind 14-10 win in the middle game of a three-game series March 29 at No. 18 Louisville, a win over No. 23 Virginia in the Golden Bears' first-ever ACC home game on March 14, knocking off defending ACC champion Duke on the road in its' first-ever ACC game on March 7, hitting a school-record-tying eight home runs in a 19-3 win at Santa Clara on March 2, walking off Cal State Bakersfield in 11 innings on Feb. 26 and a near no-hitter in a Feb. 22 win over Houston.

Cal's offense has been potent for most of the 2025 season and through games of April 7 ranks among ACC and national leaders in triples (12, 1/20), doubles (71, 4/23), hits (336, 5/31) and home runs (47, 5/34). All-American candidate 2B Jarren Advincula (.390, 5 HR, 24 RBI, 8 SB), 3B Cade Campbell (.389, 8 HR, 28 RBI, 1 SB), OF Jacob French (.387, 2 HR, 24 RBI) and 1B Dominic Smaldino (.271, 9 HR, 33 RBI) have led the 2025 offense.

In his eighth season as the program's head coach in 2025, Neu is leading the Bears into new territory in their first campaign as members of the Atlantic Coast Conference, which has traditionally been one of the nation's top leagues in college baseball and in 2024 sent four squads to Omaha for the College World Series. In 2025, Cal will play three of those teams - Florida State, NC State and Virginia - in Berkeley.

"We are looking forward to our first baseball season in the Atlantic Coast Conference," Neu said. "It is a competitive schedule and some of the best college baseball teams in the country are coming to Berkeley. We believe our fans will enjoy a good brand of baseball and show up strong to support their Golden Bears."

Neu's 2025 squad includes a pair of returning first-team All-Pac-12 infielders in Advincula and SS PJ Moutzouridis, as well as 2024 Pac-12 honorable mention outfielder Seth Gwynn. Advincula led the Bears with a .325 batting average in 2024 and then was the Cape Cod League batting champion this past summer with a .392 mark. Moutzouridis (.299, 6 HR, 42 RBI), also a second-team Perfect Game Freshman All-American in 2024, and Gwynn (.311, 7 HR, 29 RBI) both had strong campaigns at the plate for Cal in 2024. In addition, the 2025 team features 11 first-year transfers including nine from four-year schools.

"Adding a large number of transfers to a solid core of returnees was big," Neu said. "We have brought in guys that have some experience and also might have a bit of a chip on their shoulder. They are coming to Cal to get what they want in a college baseball experience and the chance to play a big part in it. Even if we are a little thin on returning experience, it is less of a concern than it is a challenge. We will gain experience through our preparation and opportunities, and that will give our players the confidence to compete and play at a high level."

Much of the reason the Bears are light on returning collegiate experience in 2025 is the large group of professional baseball players the program produced in 2024 beginning with first-round draft pick C Caleb Lomavita (Washington Nationals). Lomavita was responsible for much of the Bears' success in 2024 as a third-team Perfect Game All-American, second-team ABCA/Rawlings All-West Region, and first-team All-Pac-12 and All-Pac-12 Defensive Team selection. He started all 55 games and hit .322 (73-227) with 55 runs scored, 13 doubles, one triple, 15 home runs, 52 RBI and 12 stolen bases. OF Rodney Green Jr. (Oakland Athletics, fourth round), RHP Christian Becerra (Minnesota Twins, 12th round) and RHP Andres Galan (Tampa Bay, 17th round) were also on the 2024 MLB Draft, while RHP Tyler Stasiowski signed as an undrafted free agent with Minnesota, and LHP Luke Short and RHP Connor Sullivan caught on with the independent Oakland Ballers. Becerra (4-1, 4 SV, 3.68 ERA), Green (.267, 14 HR, 46 RBI, 15 SB) and Stasiowski (5-1, 4 SV, 2.65 ERA) each earned 2024 honorable mention All-Pac-12 honors.

Neu's squad was arguably the hottest team in college baseball at the end of the 2024 regular season with 20 wins in its final 25 games and finished 36-19 for a .655 winning percentage that was the program's best since the 1966 team was 32-14 (.696). The Bears' late-season run including wins in each of their first two games at the Pac-12 Tournament that put them in the semifinals and nearly earned them a spot in the NCAA Division I Baseball Championship.

Neu's long history with Cal baseball began with four seasons as the program's pitching coach from 2012-15. After leaving to serve as the head coach at Pacific for two seasons (2016-17), Neu returned to Berkeley as the school's 11th head coach on July 5, 2017, after former long-time head coach David Esquer took the head coaching job at his alma mater Stanford.

Neu has established a culture of player development that helped lead to 27 Cal players being drafted over the first seven seasons of his head coaching tenure and guided the Bears to five winning campaigns in his first six full seasons at the helm (2020 season shortened by COVID-19).

In year one as Cal's skipper in 2018, Neu guided the Bears to a 32-22 overall record and a 16-14 mark in the Pac-12. The season was highlighted by the emergence of 1B Andrew Vaughn as one of the nation's top players. With Neu on hand in Los Angeles, Vaughn became the first Cal baseball player to ever win the prestigious Golden Spikes Award as the country's top amateur baseball player after hitting .402 with 23 home runs and 63 RBI. Vaughn was also a consensus first-team All-American selection among a long list of honors. On the mound, the 2018 Bears showed dramatic improvement in Neu's first season as head coach. Under his tutelage, Cal's pitching staff lowered its collective ERA by almost a full run (5.17 to 4.20) from the year before. RHP Aaron Shortridge established himself as one of the Pac-12's top pitchers, compiling a 5-3 record and a 2.77 ERA with three complete games in 12 starts (17 appearances). RHP Tanner Dodson (2-1, 2.48 ERA, 11 SV) moved to the back end of the bullpen and set the school single-season record for saves.

Neu built upon his first season the following campaign in 2019 when Cal capped a 32-20 record with its first trip to an NCAA Regional since 2015. The Bears punched their ticket as an at-large bid and were the No. 2 seed at the Fayetteville (Ark.) Regional after finishing fourth in the Pac-12 and carrying a No. 31 RPI ranking at the conclusion of the regular season (eventually finished No. 30). Vaughn (.374, 15 HR, 50 RBI) and C Korey Lee (.337, 15 HR, 57 RBI) led the way offensively. Cal's 2019 success continued into the summer when seven Bears were selected in the MLB Player Draft, including first-round picks in Vaughn (No. 3 overall, Chicago White Sox) and Lee (No. 32 overall, Houston Astros). Vaughn and Lee - both of whom went undrafted out of high school -

became the first duo in school history to be taken in the first round of the same draft. Vaughn, who was the program's highest-drafted player ever, was also named a finalist for the Golden Spikes Award and a first-team All-American for the second straight year.

After posting back-to-back 32-win seasons and a combined 33-25 (.569) conference record in his first two years, Neu was awarded with and agreed to a contract extension in October of 2019.

Cal was 5-11 in the 2020 campaign shortened by COVID-19 but Neu oversaw a youth movement that included 11 freshmen earning playing time, five of whom later went on to play professional baseball. All told, 13 players from the 2020 roster would go on to play professionally including big leaguers in INF Darren Baker and RHP Grant Holman.

In the next two seasons after the COVID-19 shortened 2020 campaign, Neu's Bears were 29-26 overall and 15-15 in Pac-12 action in 2021 followed by nearly identical marks in 2022 of 29-27 overall and 14-16 in the Pac-12. Both squads were packed with star power as a combined 10 Bears ended up as top-10-round selections in MLB Drafts from 2021-24 including first-rounders in OF Dylan Beavers in 2022 (Baltimore Orioles) and Lomavita in 2024. Baker (NCAA Senior Class) and Beavers (NCBWA) were also All-Americans in 2022 with Lomavita picking up All-American honors in 2024. Baker led the 2021 squad with a .327 batting average, while part-time starter C/UT Dom Souto had a team-high .336 mark in 2022. Beavers had the top power numbers both seasons with 18 homers and 49 RBI in 2021 followed by 17 long balls and 50 RBI in 2022.

Five of the six Cal players who have earned Freshman All-American honors during Neu's tenure were on rosters from 2020-22 in RHP Joseph King (2020 - Collegiate Baseball), RHP Paulshawn Pasqualotto (2021 - Perfect Game/Rawlings), Beavers (2021 - Baseball America, NCBWA), RHP Josh White (2021 - NCBWA) and Lomavita (2022 - Collegiate Baseball).

The lone Neu team at Cal to finish under .500 was in 2023 when the Bears just missed the mark at 24-28. Part-time starter Nathan Manning had a team-high .330 batting average, while Lomavita (16) and INF Carson Crawford (47 RBI) produced the biggest power numbers. Pasqualotto was 5-1 on the mound.

Neu was Cal's pitching coach for four seasons from 2012 to 2015 before his two seasons as the head coach at Pacific, where he guided a rebuilding Tigers program to 40 wins over his two seasons. That turnaround started immediately in 2015 as Pacific won 12 games in the always-competitive West Coast Conference, the program's second-most conference wins since 1999.

Before making the move to Stockton, Neu had established himself as one of the Pac-12's top pitching coaches and recruiters under Esquer. In his final season as Cal's pitching coach in 2015, the Bears compiled a team ERA of 3.03, which was the second-best mark for a Cal pitching staff since 1976. That team reached the final of the Texas A&M Regional thanks in part to the contributions of three of Neu's pupils in RHP's Daulton Jefferies, Ryan Mason and Alex Schick who would be selected in the Major League Baseball draft.

Prior to his arrival in Berkeley, Neu's reputation in pitching circles was already well-known. Serving as head coach at Diablo Valley College from 2009-11, Neu led the Vikings to an 87-41 record and two Big 8 Conference titles. His 2011 squad was ranked No. 1 in Northern California and DVC pitchers led all California Community Colleges with a 2.13 team ERA.

As a player, the Napa, Calif., native and right-handed pitcher enjoyed a standout collegiate career at Miami before going on to play in the Dodgers, Marlins, A's and Reds organizations. Neu was called up to the Major Leagues with the A's on April 9, 2003, and compiled a 3.64 ERA in 32 relief appearances that season. He also pitched for the Marlins in 2004.

At Miami, Neu helped the Hurricanes win the 1999 College World Series and finished the season 3-1 with a 2.94 ERA and 110 strikeouts in 67.0 innings. Named a Collegiate Baseball All-American, Neu led the nation in strikeouts per nine innings (14.8) and was selected to the All-College World Series team after earning three saves and appearing in all four of Miami's games in Omaha.

Before transferring to Miami, Neu starred at Sacramento City College where he was named an All-American, as well as the Northern California and Bay Valley Conference Pitcher of the Year after going 15-0 with a 1.44 ERA and 139 strikeouts. He was also a standout for the same Vintage High program that produced Cal right-handed pitchers Jared Horn and Aaron Shortridge, setting Monticello Empire League records for career wins (21) and strikeouts (196).

Neu earned a Master's degree in physical education from Ball State in 2011. He and his wife, Nicole, have two sons, Damon and Maddax.
