» QUICK HITTERS

- Auburn is 18-4 in non-conference play this season, including 8-2 in midweek games.
- The Tigers are 18-5 at Plainsman Park, including 11-3 against non-conference teams.
- Auburn is outscoring non-conference opponents 120-63 in 14 home games.
- Tuesday's game marks Auburn's 20th game against a ranked opponent in the last 24 contests.
- The Tigers are 12-9 against ranked opponents this season, including 8-2 at home.
- Christian Chatterton makes his third straight midweek start Tuesday.
- He has turned in a 1.00 ERA with 10 strikeouts and one walk in his last two midweek starts and is 2-0 with a 2.15 ERA in six starts vs. non-conference teams.
- Ike Irish leads the team in average (.354), home runs (11) and RBI (36) and is hitting 23 points higher than any other SEC hitter in league play (.417).
- He homered four times in three games at Texas, including his third multi-homer game of the year.
- Auburn leads the all-time series against Georgia Tech, 126-113-6, and is 67-46-2 against the Yellow Jackets at Plainsman Park.
- The Tigers have won three straight and five of the last six matchups, including a 9-8 come-from-behind win at Georgia Tech on Apr. 8.

Butch Thompson enters his 10th season at the helm of the program in 2025, posting a record of 283-213-1 in his first nine seasons. He has led the program to the College World Series in two of the last five postseasons.

Butch Thompson was named Auburn's head baseball coach on October 22, 2015 and enters his 10th season with the Tigers in 2025.

Thompson has returned the Tigers to prominence in his nine seasons on The Plains as he has guided the team to a 283-213-1 overall record and has advanced to the NCAA Tournament five of the last seven postseasons, including three Super Regional appearances in the last six years and two trips to the College World Series in the last five postseasons.

Thompson, who spent three seasons as an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator at Auburn from 2006-08, returned to The Plains after seven seasons at Mississippi State as both associate head coach and pitching coach.

A native of Amory, Miss., Thompson has coached 33 Division I All-Americans and 48 all-conference performers. He has seen 24 of his former pitchers called up to Major League Baseball, including 18 since 2014. Thompson has also turned 42 pitchers who went undrafted out of high school into MLB draft picks.

Along with his pitching pedigree, Thompson is also considered one of the top recruiters in the country. Since 2003, he has secured 17 recruiting classes that were ranked in the top 10 by either Baseball America or Perfect Game, including the program record No. 3 freshman class in 2024, surpassing the 2017 signing class (No. 4) for the highest in program history.

In 32 years of coaching at the collegiate level, including 23 in the Southeastern Conference, Thompson has coached nine College World Series participants, including leading the Tigers to the program's first trip to the College World Series in 22 years in 2019 and taking the team back for the second time in three postseasons in 2022. Thompson became one of five active SEC coaches who have taken their program to a pair of College World Series in a three-year span. Thompson has also coached one national champion and a national runner-up, won nine conference championships and made 19 postseason appearances.

Thompson was named the 2006 Fellowship of Christian Athletes SEC Coach of the Year while at Auburn and the 2014 Baseball America and American Baseball Coaches Association (ABCA) National Assistant Coach of the Year while at Mississippi State.

During his tenure with the Tigers, Thompson led the team to three straight NCAA Tournament appearances from 2017-19 for the first time since 2001-03, including back-to-back super regionals in 2018 and 2019 for the first time in program history, and hosted back-to-back regionals for the first time in program history in 2022-23.

Auburn's second straight regional host bid in 2023 came thanks to a second-half run for the record books, and the Tigers became one of five programs in the country and two in the SEC to host each of the last two seasons.

Auburn posted a league-best 12-3 record in the final five weeks of conference play and finished the SEC season with 17 wins, the most since winning the SEC West in 2010. The Tigers finished top five in the league in back-to-back seasons for the first time since 2002-03. The 12-3 stretch was the program's best since also going 12-3 in the final 15 games of the 2010 season and the nine-game SEC winning streak at the end of the regular season and first game of the SEC Tournament was the team's longest since 1995.

Auburn has finished six of Thompson's nine seasons in the top 25, including three in the top 10. The No. 5 national ranking to finish 2022 was tied for the second highest mark in program history.

In seven seasons at MSU, Thompson made four NCAA regional trips, two Super Regionals, won the SEC Tournament and advanced to the College World Series



finishing as NCAA runner-up in 2013. In three of his last four seasons in Starkville, the Bulldogs' staff ERA finished no higher than 3.06. Thompson's 2013 pitching staff was one of two nationally to finish in the top 15 in ERA, strikeouts per nine innings and hits allowed per nine innings.

In addition to his experience at Auburn and Mississippi State, Thompson also spent four seasons at Georgia from 2002-05, including a trip to the College World Series in 2004. While there, he guided the development of future Major Leaguers Josh Fields, Mitchell Boggs and Brooks Brown.

Thompson launched his coaching career as pitching coach and top assistant at Huntingdon College (Ala.) in 1993, before returning to his alma mater in Birmingham, where he helped lead the Panthers to back-to-back Southern States Conference Championships and in 1995 coached BSC to its first NAIA World Series berth.

Thompson left BSC briefly to serve as head coach at Jefferson State Community College in Birmingham in 1997. While at JSCC, he was honored as the Regional Tournament Coach of the Year, the ABCA Alabama Junior College Coach of the Year and the Southeast Region Coach of the Year after guiding JSCC to a 39-21 mark, the AJCAA Region 22 State Championship and a third-place finish in the NJCAA Division II World Series.

He returned to Birmingham-Southern as top assistant the following season, beginning a four-year run during the most successful span in BSC baseball history. The Panthers won 196 games and four TranSouth Conference Championships and made three-consecutive appearances in the NAIA World Series. BSC's 2001 team posted a school-best 55-11 mark and captured the NAIA National Championship.

In 2002, Thompson joined the SEC baseball coaching fraternity as a pitching coach and recruiting coordinator at Georgia and has been a part of the league for the past 23 seasons.

Thompson currently serves as the large-school representative for the Alabama Baseball Coaches Association and is an All-American committee member representing the South region for the American Baseball Coaches Association.

Thompson prepped at Amory (Miss.) High School and later starred as a pitcher at Itawamba (Miss.) Community College from 1989-90. He is a member of both the ICC Athletic Hall of Fame (Class of 2014) and MACCC Hall of Fame (Class of 2021).

Thompson earned a Bachelor's Degree in History at BSC in 1992 and completed a Master's Degree in Sports Administration at UAB in 1996. He is married to the former Robin Ashe of Birmingham, Ala., and they are the parents of three daughters -- Anna, Olivia and Madelyn Gail --and the grandparents of Mary Gail and Hayes Grady Moreman.

SAMFORD STADIUM-HITCHCOCK FIELD AT PLAINSMAN PARK

Auburn baseball's home for the past 75 seasons, an expanded and renovated Samford Stadium-Hitchcock Field at Plainsman Park makes its debut for the 2025 season.

After completing a \$30+ million project that has spanned the last two seasons, the ballpark now features premium club areas including the Broadway Club at Plainsman Park located at the top of the stadium behind home plate and the 984 Club located down the first base line to go along with the pre-existing Hall of Fame Club located at field level behind home plate, which opened prior to the 2024 season.

Along with the premium club areas, Plainsman Park now features multiple expanded general admission areas. The renovated Tiger Terrace now includes three tiers of paved terrace space with the bottom tier featuring nine terrace boxes equipped with soft seating and drink rail viewing areas, Traeger pellet grills, refrigerators and more. Additional general admission areas include the two-tiered standing room space atop the War Eagle Wall in left field and the expanded Plainsman Patio at concourse level down the first base line.

The new and improved ballpark, which continues to feature the timeless elements inspired by Camden Yards, Wrigley Field and Fenway Park that were included in the initial renovation spearheaded by former head coach Hal Baird nearly 30 years ago, has a capacity of 7,189. The design continues to combine the look of old-time ballparks with academic buildings on the Auburn campus to create a facade of brick and painted steel.

Kickstarted by the completion of the Josh Donaldson Hitting Facility prior to the 2021 season, Auburn baseball's player development areas also continue to take a step forward. Along with the hitting facility, the program has a new state-of-the-art locker room, bullpen and pitching lab, weight room and nutrition center, and soon-to-be new coaches offices and team meeting space.

Plainsman Park, which has hosted six NCAA Regionals (1978, 1999, 2003, 2010, 2022, 2023) and also had the privilege of hosting President George W. Bush on Oct. 24, 2002, has twice been named one of the best facilities in college baseball. Baseball America initially voted it the best facility in the country prior to the 2003 season, and D1 Baseball named it one of the top venues in the nation in 2016.

- Georgia Tech enters the week with a 29-9 overall record and a 14-7 mark in ACC play. The Yellow Jackets lost all four games last week and failed to score more than two runs in a game.
- Offensively, Georgia Tech ranks sixth in the country with a .327 team average. They lead the country with 110 doubles and rank top 10 in hits (444), runs (371) and slugging (.552). Sophomore outfielder Drew Burress went 2-for-4 with a 2B, 3B and 3 RBI in the previous matchup and is hitting .344 with 19 2B, 12 HR and 46 RBI on the year.
- On the mound, the Yellow Jackets have turned in a 4.38 staff ERA with 371 strikeouts and 154 walks and 56 hit batters in 337.0 innings pitched.

TAKING ON TECH

- Auburn won this season's previous mathcup with Georgia Tech (Apr. 8), 9-8, after scoring three runs in the eighth inning to overcome a 7-5 deficit through six innings.
- Deric Fabian drove in the tying run with a double before Ike Irish drove in the eventual game-winning run with a single up the middle.
- Dylan Watts pitched the final 3.1 innings, allowing one runs, to earn the win.
- The Tigers have won three straight and five of the last six in the series that dates back to 1897.

IKE'S ON ANOTHER LEVEL

- After missing six games from Mar. 9-18 with a fractured scapula, Ike Irish is hitting .408 (31-for-76) with seven doubles, one triple, 10 home runs and 23 RBI in 19 games since his return.
- Irish homered four times in three games at Texas, becoming the first Auburn player since Cooper McMurray in 2023 to homer four times in a SEC series (Mississippi State, Apr. 21-23).
- His multi-homer game Friday at Texas marked his third of the season, all coming since Mar. 22, and fourth of his career.
- He leads the SEC by 23 points with a .417 average in SEC play and by more than 150 points with a .950 slugging percentage while also tying for the league lead with eight home runs despite missing SEC Opening Weekend.
- Irish enters the week with 191 career hits, including 43 doubles and 31 home runs, and 145 RBI in 139 games played.

RANKED WINS

- Auburn enters the week 12-9 against ranked opponents, including 8-2 against ranked teams at Plainsman Park.
- At the end of Tuesday's game vs. Georgia Tech, 20 of the team's last 24 games will have been played against top-25 teams.

GOING THROUGH A GAUNTLET

- Auburn has played nine ranked teams already this season, including five in the top 10.
- Each of the first six and eight of 10 SEC series are against ranked teams, including the stretch of four straight vs. top-10 teams that the Tigers just completed at Texas.
- Starting with the weekend at Georgia (Mar. 28-29), Auburn's four-week stretch was against the No. 2, No. 8, No. 3 and No. 1 teams in the country.

RACKING UP WINS

- Auburn has already surpassed last season's SEC win total with a 9-9 mark in league play and the team's 27 wins overall match last year's win total.

FINDING A WAY

- The Tigers are 8-3 in one-run games this season after going 4-9 in such games last year.
- Seven of the team's last 10 games have been decided by two runs or fewer (5-2).

HAVING SUCCESS AT HOME

- Auburn is 18-5 at home this season, including 7-2 in SEC play, and has won five of its last six home games against top 10 teams.
- The Tigers have outscored opponents 176-98 and have outhit them .325 to .226 at home this season.

DOUBLE DIGIT DINGERS

- Cooper McMurray has hit double digit home runs in back-to-back seasons with 14 apiece in 2023 and 2024 and is second on the team with eight long balls this season.
- With two more home runs, McMurray would become just the fourth player in program history to have hit 10+ home runs in three straight seasons.

ENCORE EFFORT

- Freshman right hander Christian Chatterton is making his third straight midweek start after turning in a season-high 6.0 innings at Jacksonville State last Tuesday.
- Chatterton retired the first 18 batters he faced in the outing and eventually gave up two unearned runs after an infield single and error ended his outing in the seventh.
- Chatterton's eight strikeouts were tied for the fourth most by an Auburn starting pitcher this season.
- He is 2-0 with a 2.15 ERA and 33 strikeouts to seven walks in six non-conference starts and 29.1 innings pitched.

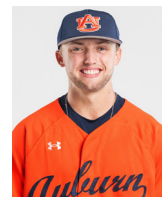
