The Blue Devils have tallied 92 home runs this season, 11th most in the country and first in the ACC.

164

Duke has produced two-out lightning this season, scoring 164 runs with two outs. That number is 37.1% of the Blue Devils run production.

348

Duke has recorded 348 walks this season, averaging 6.82 per game. The total walks tally is first in the country and first in the ACC. That mark set a new program record, passing the 1994 squad (304).

LEADING OFF

- Duke continues a trend of scoring throughout the middle innings of games once again this season, scoring 184 of their 442 (41.6%) runs this season from the fourth to the sixth inning.

- After already leading the program to its first three Super Regional appearances and a record six NCAA Tournament appearances, head coach **Chris Pollard** added another tally to his career mark against Cornell, passing **Jack Coombs** with 382 wins as the winningest coach in program history.

- Duke baseball has had a theme of scoring in bunches over the past two seasons, acting like sharks smelling blood in the water. On Saturday against No. 9 Clemson, the Blue Devils were trailing 6-5, after chipping away from a 6-1 deficit after the first inning. In the top of the seventh, Duke grinded out quality at-bats, batting around in the frame to score 10 runs against the Tigers. The 10-run seventh flipped the script for the ballgame, as Duke entered trailing down one run, to leading 15-6. On Sunday it was more of the same. Duke found itself in a 2-0 hole after the second inning, before freshman **Henry Zatkowski** found his groove and tossed three zeros onto the scoreboard. Duke responded with a pair of runs to tie it in the fourth, before a five-run grinding top of the fifth gave Duke the lead and secured a top 10 road series victory for the Blue Devils, its second top 25 weekend road series win.

- The 2025 Duke squad is steadier at the plate, drawing 348 walks so far this season. That mark is first in the country. The 348 walks are the most in the ACC, ahead of Wake Forest (326).

- Duke baseball has turned into one of the hottest teams in the country over the past 10 games of the season, posting an 8-2 record over that span. In their last 10 games, the Blue Devils have posted a .353 average at the plate, scoring 121 runs, including multiple three-plus run innings to stretch ballgames. Last weekend at No. 9 Clemson, Duke used a 10-run inning on Saturday to level the series against the Tigers, before scoring five runs in the fifth to take the series Sunday.

- Three Blue Devils have began the month of May on a heater, as **Ben Rounds**, **AJ Gracia**, and **Jake Hyde** all post averages above .420. Rounds leads the way with a .560/1.040/.621 slash line, while Gracia has slashed .520/1.200/.567, and Hyde is .429/1.190/.548. The trio has combined for 36 hits, six doubles, 13 home runs, 39 RBI, 15 walks, and two stolen bases.

TWO-OUT LIGHTNING

Two-out lightning has returned for the Blue Devils this season and especially as of late, as Duke has produced 164 two-out RBI. The 164 runs account for 37.1% of the Blue Devils' run production this season. **AJ Gracia** leads the team with 26 two-out RBI, while **Jake Hyde** (24), **Sam Harris** (22), **Jake Berger** (16) **Ben Miller** (15), **Tyler Albright** (13), **Macon Winslow** (12), **Wallace Clark** (12), and **Ben Rounds** (11) have all produced double-digit two-out RBIs.

GRACIA IS BACK

One of the most unlucky hitters to begin the 2025 season, is finally starting to turn the corner for the Blue Devils this season, as **AJ Gracia** continues to come alive in the second half. In his last 23 games, Gracia has posted a .416 average (37-for-89), scoring 28 runs, collecting eight doubles, crushing nine home runs and driving in 32 RBI. He has added 24 walks to 10 strikeouts and stolen three bases. His OPS has reached 1.347 throughout that span and his defensive excellence in center field has also ticked up a notch.

TAMED THE TIGERS AT DKS

Doug Kingsmore Stadium in Clemson, South Carolina, is one of the hardest places to win in the ACC, as the Tigers annually win upwards of 30 games at home. But for the Blue Devils, there is something special about playing on the road in DKS. Dating back to 2015, Duke has won the previous four series on the road in Clemson, including a masterclass in hitting this past weekend against the No. 9 Tigers. After dropping the series opener 9-7 on Friday, Duke proceeded to use a 10-run inning on Saturday and a five-run inning on Sunday to secure a massive weekend series on the road in the ACC.

THE ACC RACE TIGHTENS

The final week of the regular season is officially upon us, as the ACC has yet to determine its regular season champion or seeding for the ACC Tournament. Duke and Georgia Tech take to the diamond at Jack Coombs Field, looking to secure a double-bye. With a game separating the two squads, all three games of the series will determine seeding for Durham.

HOME SWEET HOME

The Blue Devils secured their 28th home victory of the season on Tuesday, run-ruling Queens. With three games remaining on the home slate, Duke eyes the program record of 29 victories inside the friendly confines of Jack Coombs Field, set in 1994.

GETTING THROUGH SIX WITH THE LEAD

The Blue Devils continue to get the job done when leading after six innings this season, posting a 30-0 (15-0 ACC) record. After seven innings the margins go up to 31-0 (15-0 ACC), and after eight innings 24-0 (12-0 ACC).

SCORE FIRST, SCORE OFTEN

The name of the game is scoring first and scoring in bunches for the Blue Devils. Since 2016, Duke has compiled a 219-72 (.753) record when scoring first and a staggering 244-53 (.822) record when scoring three or more runs in an inning.

WALLY KEEPS HITTING & GETTING HIT

Senior captain **Wallace Clark** continues to get on base by any means this season. Clark has scored 52 runs, collected 50 hits, 11 doubles, and six home runs. The Tusla, Okla., native has added 45 walks and has recently been hit by more pitches like he did last season. During his time at Duke, Clark as now been smoked by 39 pitches, tying **Will Piwnica-Worms** (2009-12) for third all-time. Duke's captain was recently named to the Brooks Wallace Award Watch List for the best shortstop in the country.

10+ RUNS = WINS

Since 2023, Duke has collected a record of 54-1 when scoring 10-plus runs in a contest. In 2023, the Blue Devils posted an impressive 18-0 record on the diamond, while in 2024 they tallied a mark of 18-1. In 2025, the Blue Devils have tallied a 18-0 record when scoring 10-plus runs in a contest.

30 WINS ONCE AGAIN

After hitting the 30-win mark once again in 2025, head coach **Chris Pollard** has now reached that milestone 18 times in his coaching career. Additionally, the 13th-year skipper, has now posted 30-plus wins in 10 of the 12 full seasons at the helm of the Blue Devils, including two years of 40-plus wins, the only coach in program history to do so.

DUKE TO THE PROS

Since 2014, the Blue Devils have had 46 players selected in the MLB Draft and an additional four free agent signings. Out of those 46 selected players, 31 have been pitchers and the five selected in 2024 were fourth in the country behind LSU (8), Mississippi State (8) and Oklahoma State (6). The Blue Devils welcomed three additional MLB Alumni during the 2024 MLB season, bringing the total number the past two years to five debuts.

THE MILLER EXPERIENCE

Graduate **Ben Miller** has thrived since returning to his home town of Durham over the past two seasons. In his first year with Duke, Miller started 55 games at third base, posting a .360 average with 18 doubles and 15 home runs. He recorded 82 hits during the 2024 season, helping the Blue Devils claim their second ACC title. Through the first 51 games of the season in 2025, Miller has started all 51 games for the Blue Devils, posting a .319 average and collecting 11 doubles and 18 home runs. He currently is tied for fourth all-time in a single season with 18 home runs and tied **Gregg Maluchinuk** (1995-98) for sixth all-time in a Duke uniform. Miller is on pace to become the 14th player in program history to hold a career average of above .300 and hit 20-plus home runs. If Miller can keep his pace throughout the rest of the 2025 season, he would become just the third player in Duke lore to hit for a .350-plus average and 30-plus home runs, joining **Jeff Becker** (1996-00) and **Nate Freiman** (2006-09).

NEW LOOK COOMBS

Following the 2024 season, Duke began renovations on Historic Jack Coombs Field. The new facility includes upgraded dugouts, a new indoor training lab, training room, coaches offices, team room, club house and suites. Along with upgrading all of that, seating will be expanded in the coming years to create what head coach **Chris Pollard** calls "The Cameron Indoor of College Baseball". Construction began on August 12, 2024, as Coombs was

treated to updated dimenons, a new playing surface, and MLB quality dugouts.

KICK THE DOOR DOWN

Duke baseball has been knocking on the door of Omaha since head coach **Chris Pollard** arrived in Durham, but has yet to get past the threshold. Following the 2023 Super Regional appearance in Charlottesville, Pollard coined a phrase that has resonated through the program, “Kick the Door Down”.

ACC TOURNAMENT MAKES A CHANGE

The Atlantic Coast Conference made a change to the ACC Tournament for the 2025 season alongside the addition of new conference mates Cal and Stanford, two squads the Blue Devils will face in the first two weekends of ACC play. New for the 2025 season, the Atlantic and Coastal divisions are no more. With that, the conference tournament held at the Durham Bulls Athletic Park at the end of May, expands to 16 teams. The entire league will participate in the conference tournament, eliminating pool play and moving to a single elimination tournament. The top four teams at the end of the regular season will earn spots in the quarterfinals played on Thursday or Friday, while the next four seeds earn spots in Wednesday’s second round action. The final eight teams will begin tournament action on Tuesday, forcing the bottom half of the league to win five games to claim the automatic qualifier for the NCAA Tournament.

CAREER DAY AGAINST PITT

• Southpaw **Owen Proksch** enjoyed his best outing of his career against Pitt, working six innings of three-hit baseball against the Panthers. The Southlake, Texas, native punched out a career-high nine batters on 96 pitches, working into the seventh inning.

STARTER MATERIAL

• The Southlake, Texas, native solidified himself as a Friday night guy in the ACC last weekend, stretching out to a new career-high five innings of work and shutting down the NC State offense. Proksch allowed two hits, walked three and punched out six batters, earning his first win of the season, and first in a starter role.

PROKSCH GETS THE CALL ON FRIDAY NIGHT

• Junior **Owen Proksch** takes the bump for the Blue Devils on Friday evening for his first collegiate start. Proksch has appeared in 61 career contests, but has never started for the Blue Devils during his time. In his time with Duke, Proksch has posted an 8-3 record with a 4.71 in 70.2 innings of work.

FIRST START IN VIRGINIA

• Proksch gave Duke a spark on the mound Friday in Charlottesville, working a career-high 3.1 innings and punching out three batters. Proksch did not factor into the decision, but his length and competitive fight, propelled Duke to its first Friday night ACC victory this season.

FROM RELIEVER TO STARTER

• The 6-foot-3 junior from Southlake, Texas, has primarily been a relief pitcher for the Blue Devils, doing anything from a long relief roll to a closer. Proksch will look to use that length on Friday to give Duke a quality start on the mound to open the series at Virginia.

CONWAY REGIONAL DOMINANCE

• Proksch was one of the best arms for the Blue Devils out of the bullpen his freshman year on campus, appearing in 32 games.
