

SCOUTING GEORGIA TECH

Georgia Tech comes into the contest with a 1-0 record after knocking off Colorado 27-20 in Boulder, Colo. last Friday. Do-it-all quarterback Haynes King was as good as advertised against the Buffaloes, rushing for 156 yards and three scores while also airing it out for 143 yards on 13-of-20 passing. The Yellow Jackets offensive line was stout, allowing just one sack on the night. The receiving corps was by committee for Georgia Tech with seven different receivers making a catch. Bailey Stockton led the team with four catches and 48 yards. Defensively, Omar Daniels led the way with five tackles, including one tackle for loss. Georgia Tech racked up 463 yards of total offense with 320 of those yards coming on the ground.
