MATCHUP AT A GLANCE

- Virginia Tech leads the all-time series against Georgia Tech, 12-8.

- The Hokies' series with the Yellow Jackets dates to 1990 - the lone non-ACC regular season meeting between the two programs.

- Virginia Tech has won three of the last four matchups against Georgia Tech, including two consecutive games in Atlanta (2019, 2021).

- The Hokies won their most recent meeting against the Yellow Jackets (2024), notching the 21-6 victory at Lane Stadium/Worsham Field. Kyrn Drones threw a 20-yard touchdown pass to Benji Gosnell, caught a 6-yard touchdown pass from Jaylin Lane and ran for a 1-yard touchdown to ice the score.

- Virginia Tech's 45-0 shutout victory at Bobby Dodd Stadium during the 2019 season was the first of consecutive shutout wins by the Hokies, leading into their 28-0 triumph against Pitt. These two shutouts mark the program's most recent to date.

- During the ACC divisional era (2005-22), few matchups carried more weight in the Coastal Division race than those between Virginia Tech and Georgia Tech. The programs combined to top the division 11 times - six by the Hokies and five by the Yellow Jackets.

- Virginia Tech is making its second trip to Atlanta this season, having opened the 2025 season against then-No. 13 South Carolina in the Aflac Kickoff Game at Mercedes-Benz Stadium. The Hokies trailed, 10-8, after three quarters, despite the Gamecocks completing the 24-11 win.

- Historically, Virginia Tech has played multiple games in the same city during the same season 44 times, most recently in 2013: against Alabama at the Georgia Dome and later at Georgia Tech. In 2009, the Hokies made three trips to Atlanta.

- Three Hokies call the state of Georgia home: offensive lineman Montavious Cunningham (Athens, Ga.), long snapper Christian Epling (Dacula, Ga.), and defensive lineman Elhadji Fall (Marietta, Ga.).

► EXIT LIGHT, ENTER HOKIES

MONTGOMERY LEADING THE HOKIES

- Offensive coordinator Philip Montgomery was named Virginia Tech's interim head coach for the remainder of the season on Sept. 14.

- Montgomery led the Hokies to a 38-6 win over Wofford in his debut as the Hokies' interim head coach, following that up with a 23-21 win at NC State, helping the Hokies open the ACC slate with a victory.

- The Eastland, Texas native is now in his 32nd year as a coach, spanning a career that includes positions at Houston, Baylor, and Auburn University.

- Montgomery served as the head coach at Tulsa University from 2015-22. His second year in 2016 was his most successful, a season that saw his Golden Hurricane team achieve nine regular season wins and a 55-10 thumping of Central Michigan in the Miami Beach Bowl. The 2016 squad scored an average of 42.4 points per game and put up 50 or more points four times.

- During his time at Baylor (2008-14), Montgomery oversaw the development of the offense in a variety of roles. As the co-offensive coordinator in 2011, the coaching veteran mentored then-Baylor quarterback Robert Griffin III, who won the Heisman Trophy behind 3,998 passing yards and 36 passing touchdowns.

- Montgomery was the head coach at Tulsa who opposed the Hokies' Frank Beamer in the 2015 Independence Bowl won by Tech 55-52 in Beamer's final game as head coach.

LUNCH PAIL 'D' STIFF AGAINST THE RUN

- The Hokies' defense has held its last three opponents under a hundred yards rushing, holding Wofford to negative rushing yards, keeping NC State to just 59 yards and giving up 91 yards on the ground to Wake Forest.

- In ACC games, the Hokies are allowing just 75 rushing yards per game, ranked second in the conference.

SPENCER STRONG

- LB Kaleb Spencer has been a force for the Hokies in what is now his second season in maroon and orange. The 6-foot-2, 221-pound junior leads the team in tackles (30) through six contests, 17 of which have come in the last two games. His 81.2 run defense grade on Pro Football Focus (PFF) is third among defensive Hokies alongside a seventh-ranked pass rush grade of 71.7.

- The Gloucester, Virginia native recorded a career-high 11 tackles against NC State two weeks ago to lead the team. The Miami transfer delivered a critical fourth down stop in the first half to thwart an NC State drive.

IBM: INTELLIGENT, BOLD, MENACING

- DB Isaiah Brown-Murray tallied four tackles and a pass breakup against Wake Forest while recording his first interception at Virginia Tech, the second of his career, picking off Robby Ashford and returning it to the 4-yard line.

- Prior to his interception, IBM served as the gunner on the punt team, downing the ball at the 2-yard line, tiptoeing along the goal line to make the play.

TAKYE TIME

- Hailing from Richmond, Virginia, redshirt sophomore WR Takeya Heath has been a steady contributor in the pass game this fall.

- Heath hauled in the first TD of his career against Wake Forest as the receiver converted a slant route from Kyrn Drones into six points with just under 10 minutes left in the second quarter. Heath has seven receptions for 35 yards through three games this season.

- Heath is one of 16 Hokies to catch a pass this season.

GREENE MEANS GO

- WR Donavon Greene hauled in four receptions for 52 yards against Wake Forest to lead the Hokies. Greene has 16 receptions for 274 yards and two TDs this season.
- Now in his seventh season of college football, Greene leads the Hokies in average yardage per catch (17.1) and receiving yards per game (45.7).

TOUGH TERION

- RB Terion Stewart leads the Hokies in rushing with 301 yards while playing in four of Tech's six games.
- Stewart broke out two weeks ago against NC State with 174 yards and followed that up with 62 yards against Wake Forest.
- Stewart is averaging 8.6 yards per carry to lead the team. He has forced 21 missed tackles on the season and gained 249 yards after initial contact.
- The Bowling Green transfer has 11 career 100-yard rushing games and his five of at least 150 yards.

IN LOVE WE TRUST

- Virginia Tech placekicker John Love nailed three more field goals against Wake Forest and now has 51 field goals in his career, spanning 58 attempts for a make percentage of 87.9.
- The redshirt junior ranks in a tie for seventh all-time in scoring at Virginia Tech with 254 points and has made 101 straight PAT atemptps, never missing in college.
- The product of Spartanburg, South Carolina, was named to the Lou Groza Award watch list this summer.
- Love has made four field goals of 50 yards or longer and owns four of the top six longest kicks spanning Virginia Tech program history.

NO QUIT IN NICK

- P Nick Veltsistas has waited patiently for his turn to be the Hokies' starting punter and is finally getting the opportunity as a redshirt senior.
- The Fairfax, Virginia native is off to a solid start in the 2025 season, punting 24 times through the first six games of the season for a total of 1,055 yards, averaging 44 yards per punt.
- Veltsistas is proving his worth in the battle for field position. He has had five kicks of 50-plus yards and eight have been downed inside the 20-yard line. His season-long is a 57-yard punt.
- For his efforts, Veltsistas has been added to the watch list for the Ray Guy Award, which goes to the nation's top FBS punter.

SCORING STREAK IS ALIVE

- Virginia Tech's 23-point game against Wake Forest marked the 389th consecutive game during which the Hokies have scored.
- On both the active and all-time lists, Virginia Tech's current streak ranks as the fourth longest.
- During the Hokies' scoring streak, they have shut out their opponent 34 times.

NO PLACE LIKE HOME

- Like Antwaun Powell-Ryland, Kelvin Gilliam and Kaleb Spencer before them, four members of Virginia Tech's 2025 transfer class have returned home to the Commonwealth of Virginia after starting their careers out of state:
- **S - Jordan Bass (Hampton, Va.):** Spent the past two seasons at Pitt, where he played in 19 games, recording 25 tackles, 5.5 TFLs and a sack. Bass is a former four-star

recruit and was the No. 4 player from Virginia in the Class of 2023 according to 247Sports.

- **S - Sherrod Covil (Chesapeake, Va.):** Arrives in Blacksburg following three seasons at Clemson. The senior played in 32 games with the Tigers, registering 36 tackles (14 solo), 1.0 TFL and a pass breakup. Covil was a top-10 player from Virginia in the Class of 2022.
- **DL - Immanuel Hickman Sr. (Chesterfield, Va.):** Joins Virginia Tech after starting his career at East Carolina, playing in 31 games through three seasons, making 16 starts. Hickman spent the 2023 and 2024 seasons at South Florida where he saw action in 14 games with the Bulls.
- **WR - Cameron Seldon (Browns Store, Va.):** Spent the previous two seasons at Tennessee, playing in 19 games at running back (despite making the move to wide receiver). Seldon carried the ball 48 times for the Volunteers, totaling 224 rushing yards and a touchdown, averaging 5.1 yards per carry during the 2024 season. The junior was the top ranked player from Virginia in the Class of 2023 according to 247Sports.

PLENTY OF NEW FACES DOT ROSTER

- Virginia Tech welcomed 30 transfers since the end of the 2024 season. Eleven (11) of the new additions were added following the conclusion of spring practice.
- The Hokies' 2025 roster includes 19 freshmen, including 11 from the Commonwealth of Virginia.

TRUE FRESHMEN IN THE MIX

- Through six games in 2025, 11 true freshman have taken the field for the Hokies, including LB Noah Chambers, DL Zeke Chinwike, LB Brett Clatterbaugh, OL Gavin Crawford, CB Jojo Crim, CB Jahmari DeLoatch, OL Christian Evans, CB Knahlij Harrell, S Brennan Johnson, WR Shamarius Peterkin, and S Sheldon Robinson.
- Chambers and Robinson each had a coming out party against NC State two weeks ago. Chambers made his Tech debut in emphatic fashion with six tackles, and the first sack of his career, while Robinson also registered six tackles.
- Robinson followed up with four more tackles, a quarterback hurry and a pass breakup against Wake Forest.

DRONES ZONE

- Redshirt senior quarterback Kyron Drones completed 20 of his 34 passes against NC State for 177 yards and two touchdowns.
- Named to the watch list for the Johnny Unitas Golden Arm Award and the Maxwell Award in the preseason, Drones hit eight different receivers in the win.

TOUGH TERION

- The Hokies rushed for 229 yards against NC State, led by a career-high 174 yards from Terion Stewart on 15 carries. It was the most rushing yards for the Hokies since a 249-yard outburst against Syracuse during the 2024 season.
- Stewart averaged 11.6 yards per carry against the Wolfpack. His 85-yard gallop in the third quarter led to a touchdown pass from Kyron Drones to Cam Seldon.

- The Bowling Green transfer recorded his 11th career 100-yard rushing game and his fifth of at least 150 yards.
- Stewart forced 11 missed tackles and gained 153 yards after contact against the Wolfpack.

ELLIS ISLAND

- S Christian Ellis was all over the field against NC State. Ellis had his most productive game as a Hokie with two tackles and three critical pass breakups.
- The Jacksonville, Florida product broke up a deep pass in the end zone to save a touchdown in the third quarter and his last one on Justin Joly with under a minute to play sealed the Tech victory.

SPENCER STRONG

- LB Kaleb Spencer is tied for second on the team in tackles with 24, and is coming off a career outing against NC State.
- The Gloucester, Virginia native recorded a career-high 11 tackles against the Wolfpack to lead the team. The junior who transferred from Miami delivered a criticla fourth down stop in the first half to thwart an NC State drive.

NO QUIT IN NICK

- P Nick Veltsistas has waited patiently for his turn to be the Hokies' starting punter and is finally getting the opportunity as a redshirt senior.
- The Fairfax, Virginia native is off to a solid start in the 2025 season, punting 20 times through the first five games of the season for a total of 894 yards, averaging 44.7 yards per punt.

GOOD WORKS NOMINEE

TYSON FLOWERS

Safety **Tyson Flowers** has been nominated for the Allstate AFCA Good Works Team, and is on the watch list for the Wuerffel Trophy, college football's highest community service honor.

The Allstate AFCA Good Works Team is comprised of 22 college football student-athletes and one honorary head coach who make outstanding contributions in the areas of volunteerism and civic involvement, 11 of which are FBS players. These individuals embody the true spirit of teamwork and giving back through commendable acts of kindness. The Allstate Wuerffel Trophy is presented to the FBS player who best combines exemplary community service with leadership achievement on and off the field.

Flowers, from Fort Worth, Texas, transferred this offseason to Virginia Tech from Rice where he played in 10 games, making 38 tackles, recording two interceptions, two breakups and a forced fumble en route to being named All-AAC Honorable Mention by College Football Network.

During his time in Blacksburg, Flowers has embraced the university's **Ut Prosim** motto, "That I may serve," making a positive impact in the New River Valley and surrounding area. Among his efforts he has volunteered with Night to Shine, a program of the Tim Tebow Foundation that provides a prom-night experience for people with special needs, ages 14 and older. Tyson's role involved greeting guests, assisting with activities, and ensuring each participant felt celebrated and included throughout the night.

Flowers has also given his time to visit students at Pulaski County Schools and created Valentine's Day cards for patients at Warm Hearth Village Senior Living and Carillion Children's Hospital, in addition to volunteering for the Ronald McDonald House of SW Virginia. He helped celebrate their annual "Tab Top" recycling event, by greeting families, signing autographs and inspiring young fans. The event allows elementary schools and local businesses to collect aluminum tab tops from any container (soda pop, soup, pet food, etc.) and work with a local recycling company to turn those tabs into money for families of hospitalized children.

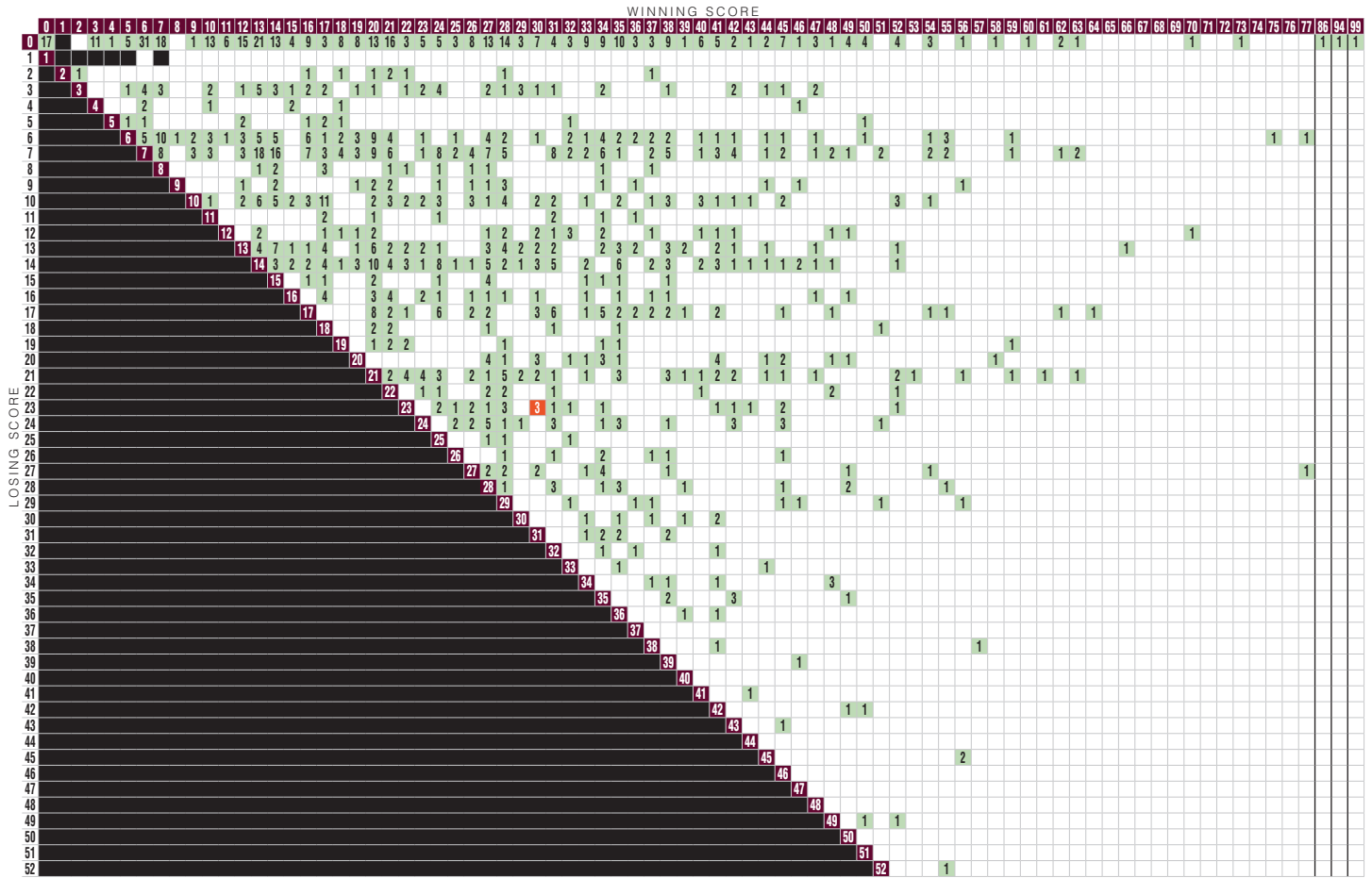

What is Scorigami?

Scorigami is the art of building final scores that have never happened before. The concept was thought of by Jon Bois who sought to find unique scores in NFL history. In this case, we use it to see how often a score or range of points scored occurs, essentially creating a heat map of results across Virginia Tech football's history. Each data point is the final score of a Virginia Tech football game.

How do I read this chart?

The winning team's score is along the top (horizontal axis) and the losing team's score is along the left (vertical axis). Scores marked in green have happened, scores in white have not yet happened, scores in black are impossible. The bottom half is all black because the losing team can not score more points than the winning team. The orange square is the most recent game. The numbers inside the squares are the amount of times that score has happened. The higher the number in the square, the more common the score.

Tech has scored on its first offensive possession **132** times, plus another five occasions where it scored on returns on its first touch of the game. The Hokies have scored in the first quarter **284** times during the streak, and have had it extended by halftime in **369** of the **389** games.

Only twice did Tech's lone score come in the fourth quarter of a game: 2005 when Marcus Vick scored on a 5-yard run with 8:06 left in a 27-7 loss and in 2014 when Isaiah Ford caught a 14-yard pass from Mark Leal with 1:30 left in a 30-6 loss and once it came in overtime, 2014 at Wake Forest.
