STORYLINES

- DePaul assistant coach Jack Owens and Georgia Tech's Greg Gary were on staff together at Purdue from 2011-17.
- The Blue Demons are coming off back-to-back games with 93+ points for the first time since 2021.
- DePaul's offense seemed to click against Detroit Mercy, hitting a season-high 14 three-pointers at a 51.9 percent clip.
- Chris Holtmann is 3-1 at DePaul in non-conference games decided by single-digits, the only loss being Northwestern this year.
- DePaul held its first three opponents of the season to under 70 points, marking the first occurrence since the opening of the 2019-20 season.
- NJ Benson was the first Blue Demon to open the season with back-to-back double-double since Mac Koshwal in 2009.
- The Blue Demons opened their season Nov. 3 against Chicago State with a 92-62 win, the largest in a season opener since 2012.
- DePaul opened the season at 78 in the KenPom rankings, its highest to open a season since 2019-20.
- Holtmann has entered the season between 70-79 in KenPom rankings twice - in 2015 at Butler and 2018 at Ohio State. Both of those years his squads finished in the top-20.
- DePaul had the largest KenPom movement of any BIG EAST team last season and was one of only three teams with St. John's and Butler to have positive movement from the beginning of the season rankings.
- DePaul was picked ninth in the preseason BIG EAST poll, its highest since the Blue Demons were picked eighth in 2015-16.
- Additionally, CJ Gunn became the first DePaul player to earn preseason all-conference honors since Charlie Moore in 2020, being named Preseason All-BIG EAST Third Team.
- DePaul returns its leading scorer for the first time since Charlie Moore in 2020, with CJ Gunn returning this season.
- The Blue Demons are also the only team in the BIG EAST to return its leading scorer from 2024-25 this season. DePaul had a successful pair of Division 1 exhibitions prior to the season opener with wins over Loyola Chicago (92-90 OT) and Notre Dame (69-62).

- The Blue Demons rank secondly nationally with a 70.2 assist rate and are 31st nationally with 19.3 assists/game.

- 12 of DePaul's 13 players who have seen minutes this year have registered at least one assist, while five players are averaging multiple per game.
- Layden Blocker has a team high 4 assists/game followed by Brandon Maclin's 3/game.
- DePaul recorded 29 assists on 36 made field goals against Gardner-Webb, setting a Blue Demons record inside Wintrust Arena.
- It also marked the most assists for DePaul since 2010 and tied for the most under head coach Chris Holtmann in his career.
- With 23 assists Sunday against Detroit Mercy, DePaul notched back-to-back games with 23 or more assists for the first time since 1999.

GETTING TO THE LINE

- DePaul is averaging 26.5 free throw attempts per game, marking a drastic increase from last year's average of 16.1 attempts per game.

HOLT ON GETTING TO THE LINE

"Last year we couldn't get there when we needed to, we couldn't physically impose ourselves. I think we can do that more this year. Our intent with building this roster was to be able to touch the paint and get to the line more, relying less on threes."

- DePaul's average free throw attempts rank top-50 nationally and puts the Blue Demons on pace to reach a number DePaul hasn't seen in decades.
- The school record for free throws attempted in a season came way back in 1952-53 (966).
- The most free throws made in a season also came that year with 656 made.
- Layden Blocker leads DePaul with 23 makes this season, shooting 82.1 percent.

PUT IT IN KRUZ CONTROL.

- Freshman Kruz McClure has continued to show steady progress early this season.
- McClure showed just how high his ceiling may be against Northwestern, with one of the top performances by a DePaul freshman in years.
- He registered a team-high 15 points on 3-of-6 shooting and was 8-of-10 from the line, in addition to two assists.
- McClure became the first freshman to lead DePaul in scoring in a game since 2022 and the most points by a freshman since 2020.
- Additionally, his eighth made free throws mark the most by a DePaul freshman since Billy Garrett Jr. in 2014.

BIG FABI

- Sophomore Fabián Flores showed flashes against Northwestern of what the DePaul coaching staff saw in him during recruiting.
- Flores originally signed with DePaul and arrived on campus in September, expecting to be an academic redshirt this season.
- He was then granted an initial eligibility waiver following a DePaul appeal in November.
- The DePaul staff has gradually introduced him into game action, working on his conditioning.
- Flores played 15 minutes on Nov. 14 against Northwestern and made an immediate impact with eight rebounds and six points.
- He had his first career start Nov. 18 where he put up an insane stat line of 11 points, 5 rebounds, 4 steals and 2 assists in...**12 minutes.**

TRIPLE THREAT

- The Big Three, Terrific Trio – whatever you call them, they're back.
- DePaul returns three starters from the end of the 2024–25 season, including three of the teams top four leading scorers.
- NJ Benson, Layden Blocker and CJ Gunn all committed to returning to DePaul following the College Basketball Crown.
- The trio makes DePaul the only team in the BIG EAST to return more than two starters.
- UConn joins DePaul as the two teams in the league to return multiple top–4 scorers from last season.

21 JUMP STREET.

- While DePaul's top three returners grabbed top-billing this offseason, a fourth returnee for the Blue Demons has made quite a jump this season.
- Theo Pierre-Justin has shown why he shouldn't be left out of the conversation as one of the most improved in the BIG EAST.
- He had a career showing in DePaul's season opener against Chicago State with 12 points, five rebounds and two three-pointers.
- Pierre-Justin averaged 6.2 minutes played as

- Pierre-Justin earned himself his first career start on Nov. 11 against Buffalo where he had six points and six rebounds in 17 minutes played on 2-of-2 shooting from three.

BENSON ON TPJ

"He's probably been in the gym more than anybody else during the summer and even now. He works with Coach Bailey every day on his defense and also his offense. I'm super excited to play with him this year and proud of him."

- He is now shooting 55.6 percent from both the field and three-point range this season.
- This summer, Pierre-Justin played with Team France at the U20 Eurobasket event.

REUNITED AND IT FEELS SO GOOD

- Kaleb Banks transferred to DePaul this offseason, reuniting with former Indiana teammate and roommate, CJ Gunn.
- Banks and Gunn played together at Indiana during the 2022-23 and 2023-24 seasons.
- The pair saw success separately last season with Banks averaging 14.7 ppg at Tulane and Gunn leading DePaul with 12.9 ppg.
- DePaul's coaching staff had their eye on Banks, long before realizing the connection.
- Banks became DePaul's first transfer commit for the 2025-26 roster.

LONG STORY SHORT: WE'RE TALL

- At the end of the 2024-25 season, Chris Holtmann made DePaul's offseason goals clear: get bigger – and get bigger they did.
- DePaul's average height entering the 2025-26 season stands at a whopping 6'7", making it the tallest roster in program history by average height.
- 2025-26 marks the first time in program history with multiple players above 7'0" as the Blue Demons have three in Khaman Maker, Isaiah Medina and Fabián Flores.
- Flores is tied with Kene Obi (2008-10) as the tallest players in program history.

- DePaul's average height ranks second in the BIG EAST, behind only Creighton.

- The Blue Demons have a total of 8 players listed at 6-8 or taller, tying for the most in the country according to the NCAA.
- There are 3 players tied at 7-2 for the BIG EAST's tallest – DePaul's Fabian Flores, UConn's Rrezon Elezaj and Seton Hall's Assane Mbaye.

PRESEASON LOOKS

- DePaul senior guard CJ Gunn was selected to the Preseason All-BIG EAST Third Team.
- The honor makes Gunn the first DePaul player to receive preseason honors since Charlie Moore ahead of the 2020-21 season.
- Gunn returns as DePaul's leading scorer from last season with 12.9 points per game.
- The Indianapolis, Ind. native averaged 13.7 points in conference play with a total of 21 games last season in double-digit scoring.
- Coach Holtmann's response to the preseason honor? "Make him earn it at the end of the season".

WORLD TOUR

- DePaul's roster features a total of five international student-athletes, marking the most international student-athletes for on a DePaul MBB roster in program history.
- The Blue Demons are also tied for the second-most international players in the BIG EAST, behind only St. John's with seven.
- Fabián Flores (Spain), Amsal Delalić (Bosnia & Herzegovina) Ilija Milijašević (Serbia) and Khaman Maker (South Sudan) are all the first respective players for the program from their home countries.
- DePaul assistant coach, Bryan Mullins, has led the Blue Demons international recruiting efforts.

ATTENDANCE ON THE RISE

- DePaul saw a 15 percent growth in average attendance last year, behind only St. John's for the largest growth among BIG EAST schools.
- Among that was over a 40 percent growth in student attendance.
- That trend looks to continue as DePaul saw nearly 600 students at the Blue Demons exhibition against Loyola Chicago, its largest in five years.

WHAT'S FOR LUNCH?

- At the beginning of his tenure, Coach Chris Holtmann said he was dedicated to getting DePaul students involved – and he's delivered.
- Prior to the season beginning, Holtmann announced that after every home win he would buy any student in attendance lunch the next day.
- Students can redeem this by bringing their student ticket from the night before to McGrath-Phillips Arena the following day during the designated time to pick up lunch, on Coach!

EXPERIENCE LEADS

- For the second-straight season, DePaul is the only school in the country where every member of its coaching staff has been a head coach at some level.
- The Blue Demons have three former D1 head coaches (Jordan, Mullins & Owens), a G League head coach (Bailey) and high school head coach (Parham) on its bench.
- The coaching staff combined has 504 Division I wins entering 2025-26.
- DePaul's entire coaching staff from 2024-25 returned this season making DePaul one of

four (Butler, St. John's, Seton Hall) BIG EAST schools to not have a change among its on-court coaching staff.

NOT ONCE, NOT TWICE, THRICE

- Chris Holtmann is among an elite list of active Division I coaches who have won a Coach of the Year honor at three or more schools.

- He is one of three in the BIG EAST to do so at three or more different conferences, along with St. John's' Rick Pitino and Butlers' Thad Matta.

WALK-ON, STAND TALL

- DePaul freshman Jonas Johnson stands at 6-7, ranking him among one of the tallest walk-ons in the country and the second-tallest in the BIG EAST.

SIXTH SENSE

- Freshman Jonas Johnson dons the No. 6 this year, making him the first ever Blue Demon to wear the number.
- This is due in part to a 2023 rule change, allowing players to wear single-digits above five again for the first time since 1957.
- Additionally, Isaiah Medina will wear No. 7 - becoming the first Blue Demon to do so since Earl Wylder in 1950-53.

BLUE DEMONS IN THE NBA

- On opening day of the 2025-26 NBA Season there were a pair of Blue Demons on rosters - Max Strus and Paul Reed.
- Strus signed a four-year contract with the Cavaliers ahead of the 24-25 season and was an integral part of the Cavaliers securing the best record in franchise history at 64-18 before falling to Eastern Conference Champions, the Indiana Pacers, in the second round of the playoffs.
- Strus is out to open the season due to a foot injury.
- In his young career, Strus has appeared in 373 games including 64 playoff games. He's totaled 3,209 career points in the NBA, which rank among the top-15 in all former DePaul players in the NBA.
- Reed is in his second season with the Detroit Pistons after playing in 45 games and five playoff appearances for the team.
- He has appeared in 260 regular season games throughout his career and has 1,295 career points for the 76ers and Pistons.

CONFERENCE COACHING DEPTH

- The BIG EAST has arguably the deepest roster of coaches in the country.

- Eight of current league head coaches have made a Sweet 16 as a head coach.
- Additionally, eight coaches have a career win percentage above .550 and six, including DePaul's Chris Holtmann, have been named BIG EAST Coach of the Year.
- The BIG EAST has won four of the last 10 national championships, and has the fourth most all-time among any conference.

BRING THE DREAM HOME

- In August 2023, DePaul University and DePaul Athletics announced a transformative \$60 million facility campaign.
- The campaign began with the renovation of McGrath-Phillips Arena and Sullivan Athletic Center which was concluded in August 2024.
- DePaul turns its attention to the construction of a new basketball-dedicated practice facility across the street.
- The renovations will give each DePaul varsity team their own locker room for the first time in school history in addition to upgraded strength and conditioning spaces, updated sports medicine and training rooms.
- The new practice facility will feature a first floor with facilities for all athletic programs including weight training and sports medicine spaces.
- The second floor will be dedicated to team locker rooms for the men's and women's basketball teams and staff offices.
- The third and fourth floor will feature two courts with floor to ceiling windows, allowing the men's and women's programs individual practice space available around the clock.

BLUE DEMONS HONOR MALIK MURRAY WITH JERSEY PATCH

- DePaul men's basketball will don a "MM" patch on their white jerseys this season to honor alum, Malik Murray.
- Murray passed away suddenly in April at the age of 50.
- He was a member of the men's basketball program from 1992-96 where he played under head coach Joey Meyer.
- Murray served as a member of the DePaul University Board of Trustees, and co-chaired the Athletics sub-committee.
- He was a constant presence around the program - at games and practices - and was dedicated to helping build back the Blue Demon program.

WHY THE BLUE DEMONS?

DePaul's Blue Demons nickname dates back to the very beginning of the University's athletics program, where athletes and teams sported sweaters with large "D" on the front.

This led to them being called the D-Men, which eventually became the Demons. In 1901, the student body voted to select blue as the school color, signifying loyalty.

Nov. 28, 2007: Draelon Burns tied his personal career high 32 points and set a school record by going 8-for-8 from three-point range as DePaul defeated Texas A&M, 85-70. Burns' eight made three-pointers came without a miss, marking the most made at a perfect field goal percentage in program history. He became the fifth player in school history to have 30+ points in back-to-back games, after also doing so against North Carolina A&T.

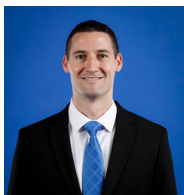

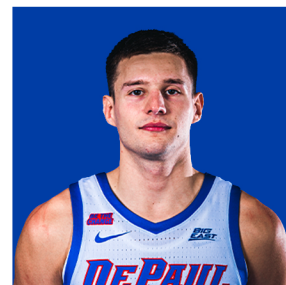
