STORYLINES

- Fresh off an impressive 82-36 rout of Radford Thursday morning, Georgia Tech returns to McCamish Pavilion for a Sunday afternoon showdown with the Princeton Tigers.
- After a back-and-forth opening frame, Tech outscored Radford 69-26 in the final three quarters to run away with its first win of the season. Tech also recorded the first scoreless defensive quarter in program history (2nd), holding Radford to 0-for-12 from the floor. Sophomore guard Talayah Walker, a Penn State transfer, led the team with 16 points while Brianna Turnage had a team-best 11 rebounds. Erica Moon recorded six assists while D'Asia Thomas-Harris entered off the bench and finished one rebound shy of a double-double (10 pts, 9
- Sunday marks the fifth all-time meeting between the Yellow Jackets and Tigers in program history. Georgia Tech is 4-0 in the series with the last game being a 67-56 road victory on Nov. 19, 2017. The last game at McCamish between the two came on Dec. 29, 2016 where Tech secured a 67-51 win.
- Blair is the seventh head coach in program history, arriving on The Flats after seven seasons at Maryland where she helped the Terps to three Big Ten championships and trips to the NCAA Tournament in every season the event was held. She brings over 25 years of coaching experience to Georgia Tech and is known as one of the nation's top recruiters.
- Three student-athletes from 2024-25 are back in a Tech uniform this season, including senior guard Inés Noguero, junior center Adiadna Termis and junior guard/forward D'Asia Thomas-Harris. Noguero played in 27 games with 21 starts a season ago, finishing second on the team with 39 steals. She has earned three-consecutive All-ACC Academic Team and Honor Roll awards. Termis made 21 starts for Tech last season while averaging 42.6% from the floor. She was named a 2024-25 Hawaii North Shore Showcase All-Star after leading Tech with 13 points in a 74-58 win over No. 21 Oregon. Thomas-Harris has played in 33 career games at Tech as she enters her junior season.
- Noguero is one of two captains on this season's squad, along with Florida State transfer Brianna Turnage. Turnage is one of 10 newcomers to the team this season, a group that collectively averages 20.7 minutes and 7.2 points per game at the NCAA level. Turnage played in 90 games for the Seminoles in three seasons, averaging 30.8% from the floor. Fifth year guard and Boston College transfer Savannah Samuel arrives on The Flats after leading the Eagles' bench last season with 6.3 points per game. She's joined by fellow upperclassmen Catherine Alben, La'Nya Foster and Jada Crawshaw. Alben earned an All-Big South First Team selection last season after being named to the second team in 2023-24 and the all-freshman unit in 2022-23. Foster, a transfer from Austin Peay, was named Atlantic Sun Freshman of the Year in 2023-24 and made 47 starts in 64 games played for the Governors. Crawshaw, a native of Darwin, Australia, comes to the Flats from Long Beach State where she earned Big West All-Freshman Team honors in 2023-24.
- The remainder of the Yellow Jackets' 2025-26 squad features three sophomores and two true freshmen. Sophomore guards Talayah Walker and Erica Moon (redshirt) and sophomore center Déborah Mukeba. Walker played 29 games at Penn State a year ago averaging 5.6 points on 44.6% shooting and 3.3 rebounds per game. Moon spent two seasons at Texas A&M and also played in 29 games last season, getting starts in seven of the Aggies' last eight games. Mukeba saw action in just three games at Boston College last season. True freshmen McKayla Taylor, a 6-1 center from Langston Hughes High School and Leyre Urdiain, a 5-11 guard from Zaragoza, Spain, round out this year's team.

WON-AND-ZERO

The Karen Blair Era opened in style on Nov. 6, when the Yellow Jackets took down Radford, 82-36, for 'Education Day' inside McCamish Pavilion. After a tight first quarter and only up by three, the Tech defense rose to the challenge and did not allow a single basket in the second guarter - the first scoreless defensive guarter in program history - holding the Highlanders to 0-for-12 from the floor. GT outscored Radford 69-26 in the final 30 minutes of game time and out-rebounded the Highlanders 51-23 in the game.

The victory marked the 13th-straight home-opening win for Tech and the fewest points allowed in a head coach's debut game in program history.

Talayah Walker led the charge with 16 points while Brianna Turnage led the team in rebounds (11) and Erica Moon in assists (6).

HOME SWEET HOME

All time, the Yellow Jackets are 433-240 (.643) when playing at home. The Jackets have won the last 10 games at McCamish Pavilion dating back to the 2024-25 season. The Jackets opened the 2025-26 season with an 82-36 throttling of Radford to get that mark to double digits.

Since 2020-21, Georgia Tech is 28-4 inside the friendly confines of McCamish Pavilion when facing non-conference opponents, and is 16-1 since 2023-24.

GUESS WHO'S BACK? BACK AGAIN?

Inés Noguero, D'Asia Thomas-Harris and Ariadna Termis return to The Flats in 2025-26 as the lone returners.

Noguero enters the season having played 78 games in a Tech uniform with 59 starts. She has accrued 93 career steals and 137 assists on top of 393 points and 1,571 minutes of action.

Thomas-Harris returns after playing in just five games last season due to injury. She has appeared in 33 games at Georgia Tech and has made the most of her floor time, shooting 52.5% in her

Termis, who made 24 starts a season ago, finished third on the team with 62 assists and led Tech with 13 points in a victory over No. 21 Oregon in Hawaii. She has a 44.1% shooting mark in 57 games at Georgia Tech.

PORTAL PRESENCE

Georgia Tech added eight to the roster in the offseason via the transfer portal. With those eight comes a plethora of experience: the group averages 20.7 minutes and 7.2 points per game in their careers with 403 combined games played, 168 starts and 2,913 combined points.

The Yellow Jackets' incoming from the portal are Savannah Samuel (5th - Boston College), Brianna Turnage (Sr. - Floida State), Catherine Alben (Sr. - Charleston Southern), Jada Crawshaw (Jr. - Long Beach State), La'Nya Foster (Jr. - Austin Peay), Erica Moon (r-So. - Texas A&M), Déborah Mukeba (So. - Boston College), Talayah Walker (So. - Penn State).

FRESH YELLOW JACKETS

Along with the eight additions from the portal, Georgia Tech welcomed two freshmen to campus, McKayla Taylor and Leyre

Taylor, a GHSA 6A region 5 player of the year, Taylor averaged 11.5 points and 11.8 rebounds per game in her three seasons at Langston Hughes High School. She was the No. 4-ranked center in the state of Georgia by Sandy's Spiel and was tabbed a 2023-24 6A all-state honorable mention by the same organization. Taylor was a 2024 Atlanta Journal Constitution 6A all-state second team selection and is a two-time Atlanta Public Schools MVP (2019 and 2020). She helped Langston Hughes reach the 2023 GHSA 6A Final Four after averaging 10.0 points and 10.7 rebounds per game her sophomore season. She currently owns over 500 career points and 500 career rebounds at Langston

Urdiain, from Zaragoza, Spain, brings several seasons of international experience to The Flats, having been a part of several successful Spanish National Teams. In 2024, she helped her team to a bronze medal at the FIBA U17 Women's Basketball World Cup. Urdiain was selected as a team captain and averaged 8.1 points and 4.9 boards per game. She opened the tournament with three-straight double-digit scoring games and ended the event with a tourney-best 14 points on 66.7% from the floor against France.

51 YEARS OF PRESTIGE

Last year, Georgia Tech celebrated the 50th anniversary of women's basketball on The Flats during the 2024-25 season. Tech's first varsity female sports team, women's basketball started in 1974-75 and has amassed 796 wins since. In 50 seasons. Georgia Tech has made 12 NCAA Tournament appearances, eight WNIT appearances, and seven GAIAW State Tournaments. The Yellow Jackets made their first postseason appearance in school history in 1992 and won the NWIT in Amarillo, Texas. The win also marked the first NWIT title for an ACC school.

Tech made its first NCAA Tournament appearance in 1992-93. The Jackets didn't return for 10 years, making its next trip in 2003, but then participated in every Big Dance from 2007-2012. In 2012, Tech made its first-ever run to the Sweet 16. The Jackets would return to the Sweet 16 in 2021.
