STORYLINES

- The Yellow Jackets close out a season-opening five-game homestand Wednesday against in-state foe West Georgia inside McCamish Pavilion. Tech is looking to leave the stretch with a winning record after dropping Sunday's 69-64 game to Jacksonville.
- Tech started off solid in the first half before a third-quarter surge from Jacksonville (including five made treys), helped the Dolphins secure the victory. Talayah Walker led the team in scoring for the second-straight game with 15 points in 26 minutes of action on top of five rebounds. Inés Nogueros 10 rebounds led Tech. 'Snoop' (Brianna Turnage) finished a board shy of her second career double-double (10 points, 9 rebounds).
- Walker leads the Jackets in scoring so far this season (14.8 PPG) while Turnage paces the squad in rebounds (10.8 RPG). Walker is one of two averaging in double figures points-wise this season (Catherine Alben - 12.5 PPG). Walker (60%), Jada Crawshaw (57.1%) and Noquero (56%) led the team in shooting percentage
- Wednesday is the seventh all-time meeting between the Yellow Jackets and Wolves, and the second in as many seasons. Tech won last season's meeting, 88-53, which was the first in the series since January 1985. Georgia Tech has won each of the last three games against UWG.
- Georgia Tech has made a living on starting games strong through the early part of the season. The Yellow Jackets have outscored teams 70-38 in the first quarter. The second quarter hasn't been too bad either for Karen Blair's squad, where they outscore teams 61-39 including not allowing a single point in the second quarter versus Radford (Nov. 6).
- Another key spot for Tech through the first three games has been crashing the boards. The Yellow Jackets have out-rebounded teams 194-130 (+64) so far, including a +35 (95-60) rebounding margin in the second half. The third quarter has been the primary spot for Tech's board protection with a +22 (50-28) margin. Georgia Tech allowed just one rebound in the third quarter to Radford (Nov. 6). The Jackets' rebounding margin of +16.0 per game is second in the ACC and 17th in the country. Full breakdown on Page 11
- Defense has taken center stage for the Yellow Jackets so far this season. Entering play this weekend, Georgia Tech ranks second in the nation and first in the ACC averaging 35.5 defensive rebounds per game. Tech has also made it difficult for teams to get clean shots off, ranking 14th in the nation (second in the ACC) with a 30.0 field goal defense. Entering Wednesday, Georgia Tech is just one of three teams to be top 14 in both categories (lowa and South Carolina). Tech is the ONLY team in the ACC to meet that criteria. Not to be outdone, The Yellow Jackets' three-point defense (24.2) is third in the ACC and 63rd in the country.
- Offensively, the Georgia Tech bench has been leading the charge through the season's early stages. In the Yellow Jackets' two wins so far, the bench alone has outscored the opposing team. On Nov. 6 against Radford, the Tech bench scored 41 (Radford total: 36). Thursday versus Charleston Southern, Tech's bench erupted for a season-high 56 points (CSU total: 40). Georgia Tech also posted 28 bench points vs. Princeton on Nov. 9. In seven of the Yellow Jackets' 16 quarters played this season, the bench has scored at least 10 points.

SHIP SINKERS

After dropping a hard-fought game to Princeton, 67-61, on Nov. 9, the Jackets returned to McCamish Pavilion on Nov. 13 and took out frustrations on Charleston Southern, 87-40. Jumping out of the gate immediately 25-8 in the first quarter, Tech limited the Bucs to just 23.4% from the floor on top of a 56-point performance from the bench.

Talayah Walker led the way offensively with a career-high 19 points. She was one of five Jackets to score at least 10. Brianna Turnage had her third 10+-rebound performance in as many games with a career-best 13. She also led the team in assists with a career-tying six.

The Yellow Jackets also shot a season-high 10 three's on another season-high of 45.5% shooting.

WON-AND-ZERO

The Karen Blair Era opened in style on Nov. 6, when the Yellow Jackets took down Radford, 82-36, for 'Education Day' inside McCamish Pavilion. After a tight first quarter and only up by three, the Tech defense rose to the challenge and did not allow a single basket in the second quarter - the first scoreless defensive quarter in program history - holding the Highlanders to 0-for-12 from the floor. GT outscored Radford 69-26 in the final 30 minutes of game time and out-rebounded the Highlanders 51-23 in the game.

The victory marked the 13th-straight home-opening win for Tech and the fewest points allowed in a head coach's debut game in program history.

Talayah Walker led the charge with 16 points while Brianna Turnage led the team in rebounds (11) and Erica Moon in assists (6).

HOME SWEET HOME

All time, the Yellow Jackets are 433-240 (.643) when playing at home. The Jackets have won the last 10 games at McCamish Pavilion dating back to the 2024-25 season. The Jackets opened the 2025-26 season with an 82-36 throttling of Radford to get that mark to double digits.

Since 2020-21, Georgia Tech is 28-4 inside the friendly confines of McCamish Pavilion when facing non-conference opponents, and is 16-1 since 2023-24.

GUESS WHO'S BACK? BACK AGAIN?

Inés Noguero, D'Asia Thomas-Harris and Ariadna Termis return to The Flats in 2025-26 as the lone returners.

Noguero enters the season having played 78 games in a Tech uniform with 59 starts. She has accrued 93 career steals and 137 assists on top of 393 points and 1,571 minutes of action.

Thomas-Harris returns after playing in just five games last season due to injury. She has appeared in 33 games at Georgia Tech and has made the most of her floor time, shooting 52.5% in her career.

Termis, who made 24 starts a season ago, finished third on the team with 62 assists and led Tech with 13 points in a victory over No. 21 Oregon in Hawaii. She has a 44.1% shooting mark in 57 games at Georgia Tech.

PORTAL PRESENCE

Georgia Tech added eight to the roster in the offseason via the transfer portal. With those eight comes a plethora of experience: the group averages 20.7 minutes and 7.2 points per game in their careers with 403 combined games played, 168 starts and 2,913 combined points.

The Yellow Jackets' incoming from the portal are Savannah Samuel (5th - Boston College), Brianna Turnage (Sr. - Floida State), Catherine Alben (Sr. - Charleston Southern), Jada Crawshaw (Jr. - Long Beach State), La'Nya Foster (Jr. - Austin Peay), Erica Moon (r-So. - Texas A&M), Déborah Mukeba (So. - Boston College), Talayah Walker (So. - Penn State).

AROUND THE ACC

FRESH YELLOW JACKETS

Along with the eight additions from the portal, Georgia Tech welcomed two freshmen to campus, McKayla Taylor and Leyre Urdiain.

Taylor, a GHSA 6A region 5 player of the year, Taylor averaged 11.5 points and 11.8 rebounds per game in her three seasons at Langston Hughes High School. She was the No. 4-ranked center in the state of Georgia by Sandy's Spiel and was tabbed a 2023-24 6A all-state honorable mention by the same organization. Taylor was a 2024 Atlanta Journal Constitution 6A all-state second team selection and is a two-time Atlanta Public Schools MVP (2019 and 2020). She helped Langston Hughes reach the 2023 GHSA 6A Final Four after averaging 10.0 points and 10.7 rebounds per game her sophomore season. She currently owns over 500 career points and 500 career rebounds at Langston Hughes.

FRESH YELLOW JACKETS (CONT.)

Urdiain, from Zaragoza, Spain, brings several seasons of international experience to The Flats, having been a part of several successful Spanish National Teams. In 2024, she helped her team to a bronze medal at the FIBA U17 Women's Basketball World Cup. Urdiain was selected as a team captain and averaged 8.1 points and 4.9 boards per game. She opened the tournament with three-straight double-digit scoring games and ended the event with a tourney-best 14 points on 66.7% from the floor against France.

A LOOK AT THE CALENDAR

The 2025-26 schedule features 30 challenging games including 18 games of treacherous ACC action.

After five games inside the friendly confines of McCamish Pavilion to start the season, the Yellow Jackets road slate begins Sunday, Nov. 23 against Georgia. Immediately after, Tech treks to the Cayman Islands for the Cayman Islands Classic against St. John's (Nov. 28) and Florida (Nov. 29).

Intense road action against Texas A&M in the ACC/SEC Challenge (Wednesday, Dec. 3) and West Virginia (Thursday, Dec. 11) highlight the non-conference slate before that list of games concludes Sunday, Dec. 28 against Wofford at home. ACC action begins Sunday, Dec. 14 on the road in Winston-Salem against Wake Forest. The Yellow Jackets host Notre Dame (Jan. 1) and also welcome UNC (Jan. 22) and Louisville (Feb. 26) to the Flats this season.

51 YEARS OF PRESTIGE

Last year, Georgia Tech celebrated the 50th anniversary of women's basketball on The Flats during the 2024-25 season. Tech's first varsity female sports team, women's basketball started in 1974-75 and has amassed 798 wins since. In 50 seasons, Georgia Tech has made 12 NCAA Tournament appearances, eight WNIT appearances, and seven GAIAW State Tournaments. The Yellow Jackets made their first postseason appearance in school history in 1992 and won the NWIT in Amarillo, Texas. The win also marked the first NWIT title for an ACC school.

Tech made its first NCAA Tournament appearance in 1992-93. The Jackets didn't return for 10 years, making its next trip in 2003, but then participated in every Big Dance from 2007-2012. In 2012, Tech made its first-ever run to the Sweet 16. The Jackets would return to the Sweet 16 in 2021.

2024-25 SEASON RECAP

Georgia Tech returned to March Madness last season behind a 21-9 regular season record. The Yellow Jackets captured three ranked victories, the most by the program in a single season since 2021-22. Tech captured victories over Georgia (83-67), No. 21 Oregon (74-58), Mississippi State (78-75, SEC/ACC Challenge), No. 14 North Carolina (82-76) and No. 23 Nebraska (72-61). Georgia Tech spent 11 weeks ranked in the top 25, including three weeks at No. 13 in the Associated Press Top 25 poll. Tech opened the season with the best start in program history at 15-0 en route to its 12 NCAA Tournament appearance.

A coaching veteran and one of the nation's top recruiters, Blair brings over 25 years of coaching experience to The Flats. Blair most recently spent the last seven seasons at Maryland, serving as associate head coach the final five, helping the Terrapins to three Big Ten titles and NCAA Tournament berths every season the tournament was held. During her tenure, the Terps advanced to four Sweet 16s and made an Elite Eight appearance in 2023. Prior to her seven successful seasons at Maryland, Blair held coaching stops at VCU, North Texas, Texas-Arlington, Colgate, and her alma mater, SMU.

One of the most decorated players in SMU women's basketball history, Blair was a three-year starting point guard and helped the Mustangs to NCAA Tournament berths. She graduated cum laude with a bachelor's degree in business administration from SMU in 1999.
