# **STORYLINES**

- An international twist on the 2025-26 schedule is up next for the Yellow Jackets at the Cayman Islands Classic for a pair of games against St. John's and Florida. It marks Tech's first trek out of the United States since 2023-24 where it faced Creighton and New Mexico in Cancun, Mexico.
- The Yellow Jackets enter the event at 3-3 after being dealt a defeat in their first road game of the season Sunday at Georgia, 59-87. Three reached double figures scoring including Savannah Samuel, Catherine Alben and Jada Crawshaw. Brianna Turnage once again led Tech in rebounds with nine.
- Turnage has dominated the defensive glass this season, averaging 7.5 defensive rebounds per game, good for first in the ACC and 25th nationally. She also ranks second in the ACC in rebounds per game (10.5) and total rebounds (63).
- Georgia Tech has made a living on starting games strong through the early part of the season. The Yellow Jackets have outscored teams 111-61 in the first quarter. In the first half overall, Tech is outscoring teams
- Another key spot for Tech through the first three games has been crashing the boards. The Yellow Jackets have out-rebounded teams 273-204 (+69) so far, including a +41 (136-95) rebounding margin in the second half. The third quarter has been the primary spot for Tech's board protection with a +26 (71-45) margin. Georgia Tech allowed just one rebound in the third quarter to Radford (Nov. 6). The Jackets' rebounding margin of +11.5 per game is third in the ACC and 29th in the country. Full breakdown on Page 11
- Defense has taken center stage for the Yellow Jackets so far this season. Entering the Cayman Islands Classic, Georgia Tech ranks seventh in the nation and first in the ACC averaging 33.8 defensive rebounds per game. Tech has also made it difficult for teams to get clean shots off, ranking 44th in the nation (fifth in the ACC) with a 34.2 field goal defense. Entering the Cayman Islands Classic, Georgia Tech is just one of six teams to be top 18 in both categories (Iowa, Iowa State, Oklahoma, South Carolina, Stanford and TCU). Tech is the ONE of two teams in the ACC to meet that criteria (Stanford).
- Offensively, the Georgia Tech bench has been leading the charge through the season's early stages. On Nov. 6 against Radford, the Tech bench scored 41 (Radford game total: 36). Nov. 13 versus Charleston Southern, Tech's bench erupted for a season-high 56 points (CSU game total: 40). Georgia Tech also posted 28 bench points vs. Princeton on Nov. 9 and 39 against West Georgia (Nov. 19). In 11 of the Yellow Jackets' 22 quarters played this season, the bench has scored at least 10 points. Tech's 36.8 bench points per game is first in the ACC and sixth in the country.

### **SAV MAKES A STATEMENT**

Savannah Samuel's first start as a Yellow Jacket on Nov. 19 vs. West Georgia saw her lead the team with 15 points in Tech's 68-60 victory. She was one of four Jackets to reach double figures, joined by 11 points apiece from Jada Crawshaw, La'Nya Foster and D'Asia Thomas-Harris. Brianna Turnage once again led the team in boards (11) and assists (5) in the win.

Tech rolled out to a 25-12 lead after one and 44-22 at halftime before a second-half surge from West Georgia closed the gap. The Wolves got as close as five points in the late stages before the Jacket defense slammed the door and secured the victory.

The win marked Tech's eighth-straight win over a DI program from the state of Georgia, the 12th of its last 13th game against an in-state foe and 13th of its last 15.

# **SHIP SINKERS**

After dropping a hard-fought game to Princeton, 67-61, on Nov. 9, the Jackets returned to McCamish Pavilion on Nov. 13 and took out frustrations on Charleston Southern, 87-40. Jumping out of the gate immediately 25-8 in the first quarter, Tech limited the Bucs to just 23.4% from the floor on top of a 56-point performance from the bench.

Talayah Walker led the way offensively with a career-high 19 points. She was one of five Jackets to score at least 10. Brianna Turnage had her third 10+-rebound performance in as many games with a career-best 13. She also led the team in assists with a career-tying six.

The Yellow Jackets also shot a season-high 10 three's on another season-high of 45.5% shooting.

### **WON-AND-ZERO**

The Karen Blair Era opened in style on Nov. 6, when the Yellow Jackets took down Radford, 82-36, for 'Education Day' inside McCamish Pavilion. After a tight first quarter and only up by three, the Tech defense rose to the challenge and did not allow a single basket in the second quarter - the first scoreless defensive quarter in program history - holding the Highlanders to 0-for-12 from the floor. GT outscored Radford 69-26 in the final 30 minutes of game time and out-rebounded the Highlanders 51-23 in the game.

The victory marked the 13th-straight home-opening win for Tech and the fewest points allowed in a head coach's debut game in program history.

Talayah Walker led the charge with 16 points while Brianna Turnage led the team in rebounds (11) and Erica Moon in assists (6).

# **HOME SWEET HOME**

All time, the Yellow Jackets are 435-242 (.643) when playing at home. The Jackets have won the last 12 of the last 14 non-conference games at McCamish Pavilion dating back to the 2024-25 season. The Jackets opened the 2025-26 season with an 82-36 throttling of Radford to get that mark to double digits.

# **GUESS WHO'S BACK? BACK AGAIN?**

Inés Noguero, D'Asia Thomas-Harris and Ariadna Termis return to The Flats in 2025-26 as the lone returners.Noguero enters the season having played 78 games in a Tech uniform with 59 starts. She has accrued 93 career steals and 137 assists on top of 393 points and 1,571 minutes of action.

Thomas-Harris returns after playing in just five games last season due to injury. She has appeared in 33 games at Georgia Tech and has made the most of her floor time, shooting 52.5% in her career.

Termis, who made 24 starts a season ago, finished third on the team with 62 assists and led Tech with 13 points in a victory over No. 21 Oregon in Hawaii. She has a 44.1% shooting mark in 57 games at Georgia Tech.

### **PORTAL PRESENCE**

Georgia Tech added eight to the roster in the offseason via the transfer portal. With those eight comes a plethora of experience: the group (entering 2025-26) averages 20.7 minutes and 7.2 points per game in their careers with 403 combined games played, 168 starts and 2,913 combined points.

The Yellow Jackets' incoming from the portal are Savannah Samuel (5th - Boston College), Brianna Turnage (Sr. - Floida State), Catherine Alben (Sr. - Charleston Southern), Jada Crawshaw (Jr. - Long Beach State), La'Nya Foster (Jr. - Austin Peay), Erica Moon (r-So. - Texas A&M), Déborah Mukeba (So. - Boston College), Talayah Walker (So. - Penn State).

# **FRESH YELLOW JACKETS**

Along with the eight additions from the portal, Georgia Tech welcomed two freshmen to campus, McKayla Taylor and Leyre Urriain

Taylor, a GHSA 6A region 5 player of the year, Taylor averaged 11.5 points and 11.8 rebounds per game in her three seasons at Langston Hughes High School. She was the No. 4-ranked center in the state of Georgia by Sandy's Spiel and was tabbed a 2023-24 6A all-state honorable mention by the same organization. Taylor was a 2024 Atlanta Journal Constitution 6A all-state second team selection and is a two-time Atlanta Public Schools MVP (2019 and 2020). She helped Langston Hughes reach the 2023 GHSA 6A Final Four after averaging 10.0 points and 10.7 rebounds per game her sophomore season. She currently owns over 500 career points and 500 career rebounds at Langston Hughes.

Urdiain, from Zaragoza, Spain, brings several seasons of international experience to The Flats, having been a part of several successful Spanish National Teams. In 2024, she helped her team to a bronze medal at the FIBA U17 Women's Basketball World Cup. Urdiain was selected as a team captain and averaged 8.1 points and 4.9 boards per game. She opened the tournament with three-straight double-digit scoring games and ended the event with a tourney-best 14 points on 66.7% from the floor against France. She will miss the 2025-26 season due to an injury sustained in the preseason.

# A LOOK AT THE CALENDAR

The 2025-26 schedule features 30 challenging games including 18 games of treacherous ACC action.

After five games inside the friendly confines of McCamish Pavilion to start the season, the Yellow Jackets road slate begins Sunday, Nov. 23 against Georgia. Immediately after, Tech treks to the Cayman Islands for the Cayman Islands Classic against St. John's (Nov. 28) and Florida (Nov. 29).

Intense road action against Texas A&M in the ACC/SEC Challenge (Wednesday, Dec. 3) and West Virginia (Thursday, Dec. 11) high-light the non-conference slate before that list of games concludes

# **51 YEARS OF PRESTIGE**

Last year, Georgia Tech celebrated the 50th anniversary of women's basketball on The Flats during the 2024-25 season. Tech's first varsity female sports team, women's basketball started in 1974-75 and has amassed 799 wins since. In 50 seasons, Georgia Tech has made 12 NCAA Tournament appearances, eight WNIT appearances, and seven GAIAW State Tournaments. The Yellow Jackets made their first postseason appearance in school history in 1992 and won the NWIT in Amarillo, Texas. The win also marked the first NWIT title for an ACC school.

Tech made its first NCAA Tournament appearance in 1992-93. The Jackets didn't return for 10 years, making its next trip in 2003, but then participated in every Big Dance from 2007-2012. In 2012, Tech made its first-ever run to the Sweet 16. The Jackets would return to the Sweet 16 in 2021.

# **2024-25 SEASON RECAP**

Georgia Tech returned to March Madness last season behind a 21-9 regular season record. The Yellow Jackets captured three ranked victories, the most by the program in a single season since 2021-22. Tech captured victories over Georgia (83-67), No. 21 Oregon (74-58), Mississippi State (78-75, SEC/ACC Challenge), No. 14 North Carolina (82-76) and No. 23 Nebraska (72-61). Georgia Tech spent 11 weeks ranked in the top 25, including three weeks at No. 13 in the Associated Press Top 25 poll. Tech opened the season with the best start in program history at 15-0 en route to its 12 NCAA Tournament appearance.
