• UWG and GT Connections

West Georgia's winningest head coach, Roger Kaiser, is a basketball legend at UWG and Georgia Tech. As a player, he was a two-time All-American at Georgia Tech, where he was also an All-SEC outfielder. For his outstanding career, Kaiser's no. 21 GT basketball jersey was retired. As the head UWG men's basketball coach (1970-90), Kaiser tallied a record-setting 381 wins while posting a stellar .671 winning percentage. He is in both the UWG and GT Athletics Hall of Fames.

THINGS TO HOWL ABOUT

The Wolves look to get back in their winning ways after posting a 6-25 (4-14 ASUN) inaugural DI campaign.

The team returns three starters, no. 4 Shelton Williams-Dryden, no. 11 Kolten Griffin and no. 23 Malcom Noel. Williams-Dryden is a talented forward who posted a UWG-best 17.6 points per game (third in the ASUN), 7.5 rebounds per game (third in the ASUN), 38 total steals (13th in the ASUN) and led the Wolves with a 55 percent field goal percentage (fourth in the ASUN) last season. His 17.6 points per game average ranks him 44th nationally for all returning DI players. Griffin is a high-motor, defensive minded wing who served as one of the UWG captains last season. Posting 94 games played and 93 career starts, Griffin is not only approaching the 100-game mark, but also the UWG record for most games started (116). Starting at point guard this past season, Noel is notorious for taking care of the ball, highlighted by his ASUN-leading 2.9 assist to turnover ratio (totaled 80 assists to a league-low 30 turnovers). These three serve as the 2025-26 team captains.

The Pack also brought in six transfers. One transfer is no. 6 Matija Žuzic, a guard that has proven himself to be an offensive weapon at Eastern Florida State College and most recently UT Martin. Last season with the Skyhawks, he played in 32 games and started in 24, averaging 7.9 points and 2.8 rebounds while shooting 42 percent from the field and a UTM-best 37 percent from three. Another transfer poised to put together a big season is no. 9 Micah Smith. Making his way from Georgia Southern, the forward appeared in 21 games and started four for the Eagles, averaging 3.4 points, 1.9 rebounds and racking up 15 assists, 10 blocks and nine steals. Coming out of high school (2024), 247Sports tabbed Smith a three-star player while ranking him the 14th-best in Georgia, 34th among power forwards nationally and 155th overall.

HEAD COACH DAVE MOORE



Since taking over in 2017, the University of West Georgia men's basketball program has flourished under head coach Dave Moore. Totaling seven All-GSC selections, four all-region players, two All-Americans, one GSC Commissioner's Trophy winner (annual trophy given to the top athlete in the conference), one GSC Player of the Year and one South Region Player of the Year, Moore has taken the Pack to new heights. In addition to finding success at the collegiate level, seven Wolves who played for coach Moore have gone on to play professional basketball.

UWG has not only found individual success under Moore's direction, the Wolves also continued its rich tradition of being one of the top teams in the GSC until the Pack left for the ASUN. In the fifth season of his tenure (2022-23), West Georgia made it back to the GSC Championship for the first time since 2016 after beating top-ranked Alabama Huntsville in the semifinals. Following a tight championship loss, the Wolves returned to the hardwood with a vengeance. In the 2023-24 campaign, UWG capped off its final year competing in DII by posting a 27-6 record and securing a GSC Regular Season and Tournament Championship. West Georgia's 27 wins ranks as the third most in Wolves' history. The championship victory also resulted in UWG earning its third NCAA Tournament playoff berth with Moore at the helm. After the

historic season, Moore was awarded GSC and South District Coach of the Year, making him the first coach in UWG men's basketball history to be named the District Coach of the Year. With the Wolves entering its second season competing in DI and in the ASUN, coach Moore and the pack have their sights set on climbing back to the top of the league's leaderboard.

Prior to taking over at UWG, Moore spent 11 years as an assistant coach at St. Bonaventure, where was responsible for a consistent and successful player development program as well as taking on the opponent scouting duties during the season. Moore's impact on the player development at St. Bonaventure was highlighted by the individual accolades collected during his time with the Bonnies. In the 2007-2018 timeframe, players in the program amassed a multitude of awards: Atlantic-10 Player of the Year (2x), Atlantic-10 Freshman of the Year, Atlantic-10 Sixth Man of the Year, Atlantic-10 Most Improved of the Year and All-Atlantic 10 Team Selection (14x). As a result, the Bonnies appeared in two NCAA Tournaments (2012 & 2018), earned a no. one seed in the NIT (2016), and won the Atlantic-10 Tournament (2012) and Regular Season (2016) titles.

A true student of the game, Moore helped guide 24 players to sign professional contracts between St. Bonaventure and UWG, including Andrew Nicholson, who was the 19th pick in the 2012 NBA Draft. Moore was integral in day-to-day game preparation as well as recruiting efforts that helped take a program from 15 wins in 2007-08 to 26 wins in 2017-18.

Prior to his time at St. Bonaventure, Moore spent the 2006-07 season as an assistant at Robert Morris University, where he managed skill development, scouting and recruiting. For over two decades, Moore understood the rigors of Gulf South Conference basketball, as Moore spent two seasons, 2000-02, on the staff at GSC rival Christian Brothers University, where he specialized in game preparation with film breakdown and scouting opponents. Moore's first collegiate basketball coaching experience came at his alma mater, Bethel College in McKenzie, Tenn., in the 1997-98 season. He moved into the NCAA ranks in 1998, taking an assistant coach position at the College of Mount Saint Joseph in Cincinnati, Ohio.

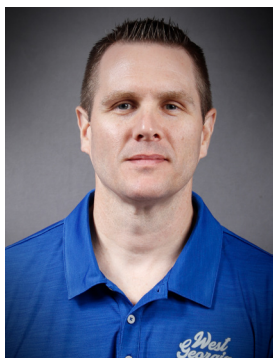
As a player, Moore was awarded a full athletic scholarship to play basketball at Bethel, where he played for four years. In the 1996-97 season, Moore was named a Scholar-Athlete by the TranSouth Conference. In that year, Moore was the team captain and led Bethel in assists. Moore graduated from Bethel in 1998 with a bachelor's degree in history and a minor in secondary education. He received his master's degree in education from Christian Brothers University in 2002.

ANDY YOUNG

Assistant Coach

Coming up on his 25th season at UWG, coach Andy Young has made a major impact at West Georgia as a player, coach and administrator. Now in his 19th season as a full-time UWG coach, Young kicked off his coaching career serving as a graduate assistant under Ed Murphy, before spending a decade as top assistant to former head coach Michael Cooney. Continuing to serve as the top UWG assistant, Young has been key in recruiting standout players, including All-GSC and All-American athletes, as well as helping UWG reach multiple NCAA South Regional Semifinals.

A legendary UWG player in his own right, Young led the Wolves to an NCAA Division II Elite Eight appearance and won several honors, including All-GSC and All-South Region Team selections in his two seasons competing for the Pack. Young's 160 three-pointers ranks coach eighth all-time in UWG history. He also is tied for the most three-pointers made in a game with nine. In 2012, Young was inducted into the UWG Athletics Hall of Fame.

Coach Mark Schult enters his third season serving as an assistant coach for UWG. Prior to coming back to Carrollton, Schult spent two seasons as an assistant coach at Centre College (2021-23). While with the Colonels, Schult also served as a member of the Rising Coaches Digital Content Team in the 2020-21 season. For his efforts, he was selected as one of 13 coaches (from a pool of over 1500+ eligible members) as a recipient of the inaugural Rising Coaches Honors Award in Fall of 2021.

Before his stop at Centre, Schult spent his time serving as the graduate assistant for the UWG men's basketball team (2019-2021). Prior to UWG, Schult worked for Clark State College (2017-19) in his first full time coaching position. Schult also served as a student assistant at Wittenberg University, where he also played two seasons. He began his coaching career on the AAU circuit on 15U, 16U, and 17U staffs for the Cincinnati based program Shining Stars.

Willie Evans returns to the University of West Georgia for his second season as an assistant coach for the men's basketball team. Prior to making his return to UWG, Evans served as an assistant coach at Pace Academy (2023-24), where he helped the team achieve a 24-5 record and a second-round State Championship appearance. Between coaching stops, Evans worked as a consultant for OnTheRadarHoops, a premier scouting service. Before working as a consultant, he served as a graduate assistant for South Florida (2018), helping the Bulls post a 24-14 record.

As a player, Evans showcased his skills for UWG from 2014-17. In this stretch, the guard helped the Wolves reach two NCAA South Region Quarterfinals and win a GSC Championship in 2016.

Jalen Sasser enters his second season as the UWG men's basketball graduate assistant coach. Prior to coaching with the Wolves, Sasser spent the 2023-24 season as an assistant coach for Chattahoochee Valley Community College (Phenix, AL).

Before hanging up his cleats for a clipboard and whistle, Sasser played professional basketball with Raiders Basket Jarvenpaa Finland, a 1A divisional team located in Keski-Uusimaa, Finland. In college, Sasser had a stellar three-year career with UWG, averaging 10.2 points and 5.4 rebounds on 59% shooting over his three seasons with the Wolves. Prior to UWG, Sasser earned his Associate's Degree from Allen Community College in Iola, KS.

FUN FACTS

- The UWG road trips this season total 14,880 miles, with the 4,302 mile round trip to UCLA being the longest and the 106 mile round trek to Georgia Tech being the shortest of the away games.
- Combined, the team has played in 230 games and started in 115 at the DI level coming into the 2025-26 season. Last year's team had a combined one DI game of experience under their belts.
- 11/16 players are from outside the state of Georgia, with this year's team hailing from nine states and three different countries.
- West Georgia's all-time winningest coach, Roger Kaiser (pictured below in light colored suit), is a basketball legend. As a player, he was a two-time All-American at Georgia Tech, where he was also an All-SEC outfielder. For his outstanding career, Kaiser's no. 21 GT basketball jersey was retired. As the head UWG men's basketball coach (1970-90), Kaiser tallied a record-setting 381 wins while posting a stellar .671 winning percentage. He is in both the UWG and GT Athletics Hall of Fames.
