### ST. JOHN'S OPENS CAYMAN ISLANDS CLASSIC ON FRIDAY

- Riding a four-game winning streak, the St. John's women's basketball team will open the Cayman Islands Classic on Friday against Georgia Tech at 5 p.m. ET.
  The Johnnies two contests at John Gray Gymnasium in George Town, Grand Cayman will be streamed
- on FloSports with Jess and Joanna Settles on the call.

  The Red Storm will play its first regular season game outside of the United States or its territories since
- it competed in the Junkanoo Jam in Freeport, Bahamas on Nov. 25-26, 2011

  It is contests against lowa and Temple in its last time playing in foreign territory 14 years
- ago. The Johnnies will play the program's first-ever contests in the Cayman Islands
- St. John's has won each of its last four games and is off to a 5-1 start or better for the third time in the last four seasons. In its last contest
- In its last contest, the Red Storm moved to 4-0 at Carnesecca Arena after dominating the second half
  to sink Central Connecticut State, 71-46, on Monday
- The Johnnies led by just a single point heading into the second half before orchestrating a 20-0 run to start the third quarter and held the Blue Devils scoreless for 7:35
- The Red Storm dominated the glass, 50-27, marking the program's first 50-plus rebound performance in regulation since it tallied 52 against Bethune-Cookman on Dec. 11, 2022.
- The Johnnies have locked down the three-point line preventing their last five opponents to just 17.4 percent (12-69) from beyond-the-arc during that span
- St. John's ranks second in the league in scoring defense allowing just 56.3 points per game
- Head Coach Joe Tartamella has entered his 14th season at the helm and carries a 244-174 (.583) overall
  record into the 2025-26 campaign and has qualified for four NCAA Tournaments, logged nine topfive BIG EAST finishes, eight postseason appearances and a 2016 BIG EAST Tournament Championship
- Over the last four seasons, the Red Storm have recorded a 30-8 (.789) record in non-conference regular season games
- Brooke Moore paced St. John's with her first-ever double-double racking up career-highs of 20 points and 11 rebounds in the win over CCSU. The junior went 8-for-10 from the charity stripe to lead the Johnnies in scoring for the fourth time this season. The Liberty transfer is averaging a team-high 13.5 points per game on 56.6 percent shooting from the field.
- The Red Storm will close out the Cayman Islands Classic on Saturday night when it faces Memphis at 7:30 p.m. ET

### LAST TIME OUT

- St. John's outscored Central Connecticut State 39-15 in the second half to blow past the Blue Devils, 71-46, for its fourth consecutive victory
- The Red Storm limited CCSU to just 15 second half points and 14.8 percent (4-27) over the final 20 minutes.
- Brooke Moore finished a 20-point, 11-rebound double-double to lead the Red Storm logging the first 20-point scoring outing of the season.
- Shaulana Wagner dished out eight assists as the Red Storm are averaging 19.3 helpers per contest over the last three games
- Kylie Lavelle finished with a season-high 13 points to notch back-to-back double-figure scoring outings

Coach Joe Tartamella will enter with student-athletes, unless detained by radio/television intePrviews. Coach and student-athletes will complete interviews and be available for one-on-ones.

### **Radio Policy**



### **DEFENSIVE DOMINANCE**

- As long has been customary for the Red Storm under Tartamella, St. John's has continiously ranked highly in defensive metrics
- The Red Storm rank second in the BIG EAST this season allowing 56.3 points per game
- The Red Storm ended the 2024-25 campaign ranked 27th in NCAA Division I and second in the BIG EAST limiting opponents to 56.6 points per game
- Oklahoma State came into the game as one of two teams this century to averaged at least 105.6 PPG and hold opponents to 51.8 PPG through five contests joining National Champion 2022-23 LSU. St. John's held them without a field goal for 9:36 and to nearly 40 points below their season average
- Over the last five games, the Johnnies have limited their opponents to 17.4 percent (12-69) from 3-point range
- No opponent has scored more than 71 points on the Red Storm in the last 13 games
- The Red Storm rank second in the league averaging 5.65blocked shots per game, including its most since 2020 recording 12 swats at Harvard (Nov. 7)
- Last season under the tutelage of Tartamella, Lashae Dwyer became the third player in program history to win the BIG EAST Defensive Player of the Year award.

### **NEW TO QUEENS**

- Tartamella welcomes a group of six newcomers to the 2025-26 roster to fortify a roster with three returning starters
- ASUN Freshman of the Year Sa'Mya Wyatt was the lone freshman in the league to earn all-conference honors, landing on the All-ASUN Third Team
- Over the last three games, Wyatt is averaging 11.5 points on 86.7 percent shooting and 5.5 rebounds per contest
- Brooke Moore arrives following two seasons and 51 total appearances at Liberty
- The junior paces the team logging 13.5 points and 1.8 blocks per contest and is shooting 56.6 percent from the floor
- Beautiful Waheed was the top-ranked junior college prospects in the country coming out of Wabash Valley
   The guard was named a 2025 NJCAA Second Team
- The guard was named a 2025 NJCAA Second Team All-American and was an Honorable Mention All-American in 2024
- Waheed has scored in double-figures in two of her last fouroutings. The Milwaukee native is shooting a teambest 50 percent from 3-point land
- Shaulana Wagner transferred from Troy and ranked fourth in NCAA Division I last season logging 6.7 assists per game
- The Preseason All-Sun Belt selection averaged 9.0 points, 6.7 assists, 5.5 rebounds for the Trojans
- The graduate student currently leads the BIG EAST dishing out 5.5 assists per outing
- Wagner has added three or more assists in all 5 games
- The graduate student is five assists shy of becoming the 22nd active player in NCAA Division I to reach the 400-career assist mark
- Daniela Abies fortifies the frontcourt after transferring in from Miami. The 6-foot-1 forward has tallied 5.8 points and 7.5 rebounds to start the year
- Abies has grabbed seven or more boards in 4 games
- The redshirt junior has averaged 6.3 rebounds per game over her three year career
- Prior to Miami, the Spain native spent two years at Wichita State where she was an All-AAC Third Team

### A LOOK AT THE POLLS

- St. John's was picked to finish sixth in the BIG EAST Presesason Coaches poll released on Oct. 21 at the league's media day at Madison Square Garden
- The Red Storm accumulated 56 points as voted on by the conference's 11 head coaches
- The last two times the Johnnies were predicted to finish in the bottom half of the league they logged topfour finishes. In 2023-24, the Red Storm were picked sixth and placed tied for third, the program's highest finish since 2019-20. In 2022-23, the Johnnies were selected seventh and got off to their best start in program history, 13-0, ultimately finishing fourth in the BIG EAST and qualifying for the NCAA Tournament
- The defending national champions Connecticut were picked to finish atop the conference (100 points)

### SCHEDULE AT A GLANCE

- St. John's will embark on its 51st season in program history with another challenging 31-game slate on deck for the 2025-26 campaign
- The non-conference schedule features 11 teams from six different conferences, including three squads that made the 2025 NCAA Tournament
- The Johnnies will host a Big 12 opponent at Carnesecca Arena for the first ime since 2017 when they
  welcome No. 18 Oklahoma State on Nov. 19. Wednesday's game will mark the first ranked nonconference opponent St. John's has faced since then-No. 19 UCLA on Nov. 26, 2022
- Over the Thanksgiving holiday, the Red Storm will compete in the Cayman Islands Classic taking on Georgia Tech (Nov. 28) and Memphis (Nov. 29). The Yellow Jackets are coming off an NCAA Tournament appearance and the Red Storm and Tigers last MET in an MTE three years ago at the Las Vegas Invitational
- The BIG EAST will return to a true round-robin 20-game schedule in 2025-26. The Red Storm will play all 10 conference foes both home and away beginning with welcoming Creighton on Dec. 4
- The conference entered a new comprehensive media rights agreement ahead of the 2025-26 basketball season. The Johnnies will play four games on national neworks- at UConn (Jan. 7 on truTV), vs. Marquette (Jan. 21 on Peacock), vs. Villanova (Jan. 24 on FS1) and vs. UConn (March 1 on truTV)

### **SERIES HISTORY**

- St. John's and Georgia Tech will meet for the third time and the first on a neutral floor
- The Johnnies and Yellow Jackets have faced off twice in the early 2000's, splitting the series 1-1
- The Red Storm won the last meeting on Dec. 17, 2004, 69-65, in Queens
- The first meeting took place on Dec. 30, 2002 with Georgia Tech winning in Atlanta, 61-53. Joe Tartamella was a graduate assistant as St. John's at that time.

### TARTAMELLA'S TRADITION OF SUCCESS

- Joe Tartamella enters his 24th year with the program and his 14th as the head coach of the Red Storm
- Tartamella began his tenure in Queens over 20 years ago as a graduate assistant in 2002 and climbed the ladder to take over the reigns of the program in 2012. He holds a career record of 244-174 (.583)
- The Johnnies' lead man reached 225 career victories on Nov. 8, 2024 at LIU, which made him the fifthactive BIG EAST Coach to reach that threshold. He is seven victories away from reaching the 250-win
- Tartamella led the program to his eighth postseason appearance in 12 seasons at the helm. The
  Johnnies lead man has brought the school to four NCAA Tournaments, three WNIT's and one WBIT
  appearance. Tartamella and the Red Storm captured the BIG EAST Tournament Championship in 2016
  for the first time in 38 years
- Tartamella has led the program to nine top-five finishes in the BIG EAST and four placements inside the top-three of the league
- Tartamella has led the Johnnies to 10 or more BIG EAST wins nine times in his career and matched the program record with 13 league wins in 2022-23
- A proven developer of talent, Tartamella has mentored 16 players during his head coaching tenure that went onto play professionally, including four WNBA draft picks
- In 2024-25, Lashae Dwyer became the third Johnnie under Tartamella to be named the league's
  defensive player of the year, to go along with an all-conference second-team selection. During his
  tenure, Tartamella has mentored 20 All-BIG EAST selections
- Tartamella added another ranked victory to his decorated resume defeating No. 18/21 Oklahoma State, 74-67, on Nov. 19.

### YELLOW JACKET BUZZ

- Georgia Tech comes to the Cayman Islands with an even 3-3 record on the year under first year Head Coach Karen Blair
- The Yellow Jackets suffered a 87-59 setback in their first contest away from home on Sunday at Georgia
- The Yellow Jackets have excelled on the glass ranking top-30 in the country in rebounds per game (45.5), defensive boards per game (26.6) and rebounding margin (+11.5).
- Georgia Tech ranks seventh in the country in bench scoring with the reserve unit recording 36.8 points per game, which comprises 52.5 percent of the team's scoring
- Three of the team's top four scorers have primarily come off the bench.
- Talayah Walker leads the team logging 12.2 points per game while Brianna Turnage ranks top-25 in NCAA Division I collecting 10.5 rebounds per contest
- Last year, Georgia Tech posted a 22-11 record and qualified for its first NCAA Tournament since 2022 eventually falling to Richmond in the first round.



Joe Tartamella was introduced as the ninth head coach in the history of the St. John's women's basketball program on April 27, 2012 and is entering his 14th season at the helm.

In his 13 completed years at the helm of the Red Storm, Tartamella has continued the tradition of success that he helped mold over the last 20-plus years, boasting an overall record of 244-174 (.583) as a head coach.

In 2024-25, Tartamella led the Red Storm to its third straight winning season and orchestrated an above .900 winning percentage for the second time in three years in non-conference play. The Johnnies went 10-1 in out-of-league competition. He mentored a BIG EAST Major Award winner in the conference's defensive player of the year Lashae Dwyer.



After a slow start to the 2023-24 campaign, Tartamella righted the ship and led an impressive turnaround. St. John;s is the only Power 6 conference program in the country to start 2-5 and finish top-3 in its respective conference. The Red Storm went 11-7 in league play and earned the third-seed in the BIG EAST Tournament. Tartamella led the program to a WBIT at-large bid, the eighth postseason trip of his 13-year tenure and the 15th in the last 20 years.

In 2022-23, he had one of his most outstanding years as a head coach after being named the 2023 BIG EAST Coach of the Year and a semifinalist for the Naismith National Coach of the Year award.

In 2023, Tartamella led the Johnnies to their first NCAA Tournament appearance since 2016 and the program's first win in the "Big Dance" in nine years. St. John's finished the year with an overall record of 23-9 and a 13-7 mark in BIG EAST play.

In a year where the league sent five teams to the NCAA Tournament, Tartamella led the Red Storm to a top-four finish for the seventh time in 11 years at the helm. The Johnnies resurgence garnered attention on the national scale as the team spent nine-straight weeks ranked or receiving votes in one of the two national polls.

St. John's was one of nine teams in NCAA Division I to sweep through its non-conference schedule with an undefeated record at 9-0. Furthermore, the Red Storm recorded wins in each of its first 13 contests, the best start in program history.

In league competition, the Johnnies picked up 13 BIG EAST wins, the program's most since 2013-14 and finished tied for fourth in the standings.

On Feb. 21, Tartamella earned the highest ranked win of his career at No. 4/5 UConn, 69-64. On a magical night in Hartford, the Red Storm rallied from an eight-point, third-quarter deficit to shock the 11-time National Champion Huskies at home. The Red Storm became one of three conference opponents to defeat UConn in the last 10 years.

In early December, the Johnnies picked up their first marquee victory over then-No. 13/14 Creighton, 66-62, on Dec. 4. St. John's tallied two wins over top-15 teams for the first time since the 2011-12 season.

Tartamella mentored a new-look roster that welcomed five new players, including three transfers that started nearly every game. Under the direction of Tartamella, Pittsburgh transfer and unanimous 2022-23 All-BIG EAST First Team selection Jayla Everett, who held the highest scoring average of her five-year career. The shooting guard averaged 16.1 points per game, the highest mark for a Red Storm player in their first-year with the team since Tawana Jackson in 1994-95.

Over his time leading the program, Tartamella has coached 19 All-BIG EAST selections, most recently Drake in 2023-24 who became the ninth first team choice under Tartamella.

During the 2021-22 season, Tartamella took over sole possession of first place on the program's all-time wins list with an 83-63 triumph over Xavier at Carnesecca Arena in 2022. The head coach passed his former mentor Kim Barnes-Arico to become the all-time winningest head coach in program history.

In 2019-20, the Red Storm enjoyed its highest scoring output since the 1994-95 season, averaging 72.3 points per game. Under the direction of Tartamella, the Red Storm finished 19-12 overall, and third in the BIG EAST with an 11-7 conference mark. Prior to the season being cut short, Tartamella and the St. John's women's basketball program were in line to make their seventh postseason appearance in the last eight seasons.

In 2018-19, Tartamella helped lift the Johnnies to their most notable win in terms of national rankings in nearly a decade, as the Red Storm upset No. 8/7 Marquette, 81-74.

During the 2017-18 season Tartamella led St. John's back to the postseason for the 11th-straight year as the Johnnies advanced to the Quarterfinal Round of the WNIT for the first time in program history. Three of Tartamella's athletes garnered accolades by the BIG EAST following the 2017-18 campaign as Qadashah Hoppie was named BIG EAST Freshman of the Year, the first freshman to earn the award for the Johnnies since Da'Shena Stevens, in 2008-09 season. Hoppie and Tiana England both earned unanimous selection to the BIG EAST All-Freshman Team, while Maya Singleton was tabbed to the All-BIG EAST Second Team. On Jan. 10th, Tartamella moved up to third place on the All-Time Win List with 119 wins after defeating Butler, 73 to 55.

Tartamella led the 2016-17 St. John's team back to the postseason for the 10th-consecutive season as the Johnnies advanced to the WNIT Round of 16 for the fourth time in five total appearances. Additionally, the Red Storm reached the 20-win mark for the fourth-straight year. Three of Tartamella's players were recognized by the BIG EAST following the 2016-17 campaign as Jade Walker earned a spot on the All-BIG EAST First Team, while Aaliyah Lewis became just the second player in program history to be named Defensive Player of the Year after the senior earned a share of the award. Finally, rookie Alisha Kebbe was named to the BIG EAST All-Freshman Team after taking home the conference's Freshman of the Week Award a league-best four times during the regular season. On Jan. 22, 2017, Tartamella became the fifth coach in program history to win 100 games with a 60-50 win over Providence at Carnesecca Arena.

In March of 2016, Tartamella returned the Red Storm to a place of prominence that the program had not experienced in nearly three decades. Following three magical days in Chicago, the Johnnies claimed their first BIG EAST Title since 1988. The road to the championship proved difficult, as the Red Storm had to face off against top-seeded DePaul on its home court in the semifinals less than a week after the Blue Demons wrapped up the best regular season in the history of the new BIG EAST with a 16-2 mark. Trailing by double digits in the second half, the Johnnies stormed back to take the lead in the final period, knocking down their final 11 shots from the floor and securing a spot in the BIG EAST Championship game for the second time in three years. In the final, the Red Storm put forth its best defensive effort of the season, limiting Creighton to just 37 points and claiming the BIG EAST title.

After its miraculous title run, the Red Storm secured a berth in the NCAA Tournament for the sixth time in the last seven seasons and earned a postseason bid for the ninth-straight campaign.

Two of Tartamella's players were recognized by the BIG EAST following the 2015-16 season, as super seniors Aliyyah Handford and Danaejah Grant were both named to the all-conference first team. In addition, Handford became the first player in St. John's history to take home BIG EAST Defensive Player of the Year honors after finishing second in the conference in steals on the season. Handford and Grant both indelibly left their mark on the St. John's record book in 2015-16, as Handford became the program's first



2,000-point scorer and Grant moved into ninth place on the career scoring list despite playing what amounted to just three full seasons in red and white.

In April 2016, the two seniors became the third and fourth players in the Tartamella era to hear their names called in the WNBA Draft, as Handford was selected 27th overall by the Connecticut Sun and Grant was taken four picks later at 31 by the Washington Mystics.

The Red Storm won 23 games for the third-straight season in 2015-16, bumping Tartamella's career record to 87-45, good enough for a winning percentage of .659.

In 2014-15, Tartamella guided St. John's to the postseason for the eighth-straight season, taking the Red Storm to the WNIT Round of 16 for the third time in school history. This past season marked the second time in Tartamella's three-year tenure as head coach that St. John's has won at least a pair of postseason games. The Red Storm also won 23 contests for the second-straight year.

Tartamella's star player, Aliyyah Handford, was named All-BIG EAST First Team and WBCA All-Region for the second-consecutive year after registering the second-most productive offensive season in school history. The junior guard scored 655 points during the campaign, propelling her into seventh place on the school's all-time scoring list. Two other members of the Red Storm were also recognized by the conference, as Danaejah Grant found a spot on the All-BIG EAST Second Team after scoring 580 points (fifth-most in school history) and Amber Thompson garnered All-BIG EAST Honorable Mention honors after shattering her own single-season rebounding record with 370 boards.

In 2013-14, Tartamella piloted the Red Storm to 23 victories and a trip to the second round of the NCAA Tournament, the program's fifth-straight trip to the Big Dance. Aside from the team's NCAA Tournament berth, the campaign featured a number of other highlights, including a win over nationally-ranked Texas A&M at Madison Square Garden, a 13-5 BIG EAST mark, the program's first appearance in the BIG EAST Tournament Final since 1988 and an 11-game winning streak.



Under Tartamella, St. John's has made three trips to the NCAA tournament, while his players have garnered an array of individual awards. Following his first year as head coach, Tartamella saw Shenneika Smith and Nadirah McKenith earn First Team All-BIG EAST honors. In addition, Smith earned a spot on the All-Met First Team, while McKenith was named the All-Met Player of the Year and Handford took home the hardware as the MBWA Rookie of the Year. Most notably, however, McKenith and Smith were both taken in that spring's WNBA Draft and McKenith became the first St. John's player to sign a WNBA contract, playing the 2013 season with the Washington Mystics. The duo also earned WBCA Honorable Mention All-America accolades.

Following the 2013-14 campaign, Handford found a spot on the All-Met and All-BIG EAST First Teams, while Eugeneia McPherson, Jade Walker and Amber Thompson were also recognized by the conference.

In his first season as head coach, Tartamella guided the Red Storm to its fourth-straight NCAA Tournament berth after finishing the season tied for third in the BIG EAST Conference with an 11-5 record and winning eight of its last 10 regular season games. St. John's was also the host school for the First and Second Rounds of the 2013 NCAA Tournament.

Tartamella made his head coaching debut at the WBI Tip-Off Invitational in November 2012. He earned his first-career coaching victory, 72-54, against UCF on Nov. 11 at the Ocean Center in Daytona Beach, Fla. Against Rutgers on Jan. 6, 2013, Tartamella killed two birds with one stone, recording his first-career BIG EAST win and his first-career BIG EAST road win, 48-44, over the Scarlet Knights. On March 9, 2013, Tartamella notched his first BIG EAST Tournament victory, 51-45, against Seton Hall.

Tartamella and his wife, Shannon, reside on Long Island, New York. The couple has four children, Brady, J.J., Riley and Tierney.


