LAST TIME OUT: Marist won its fifth straight with an 82-74 road victory at Bryant on Saturday, Dec. 13. **Justin Menard** led all scorers with 27 points, going 7-for-12 from the field, 5-for-7 from three-point range, and 8-for-8 from the free-throw line. **Elijah Lewis** scored 18 on 7-for-11 shooting, and **Jason Schofield** added 12 off the bench on 6-for-9 shooting. Marist shot 20-for-21 (.952) from the free-throw line.

ABOUT GEORGIA TECH: In their last contest on Saturday, Dec. 6, the Yellow Jackets earned a 79-67 home victory over Monmouth. **Kowacie Reeves Jr.** leads Georgia Tech in scoring (14.8 ppg), and is followed by **Baye Ndongo** (11.8 ppg) and **Mouhamed Sylla** (11.2 ppg). Sylla leads the team in rebounds (8.8 rpg) and field goal percentage (.608), followed by Ndongo (7.8 rpg, .603). Georgia Tech was picked to finish 13th in the ACC Preseason Poll, with Ndongo named Preseason Second Team All-ACC.

WHAT'S NEXT: Marist closes out its non-conference schedule with a home game against Stony Brook on Sunday, Dec. 21. Tip-off is set for 1 p.m.

Top Tidbits

This is the fifth all-time meeting between Marist and Georgia Tech. The first occurred in the Red Foxes' first NCAA Tournament game in program history in 1986. ... Marist is looking for its first win against an ACC opponent in program history (13 previous games). ... Marist ranks ninth in the NCAA in free-throw percentage (.789) after going 20-for-21 (.952) at Bryant. The Red Foxes are shooting .815 from the line in their last eight games. ... Marist has forced an average of 17.0 turnovers in its last three games. ... **Justin Menard** has set a new career high in scoring three times in his last seven games.

Record at Marist: 103-112

John Dunne was hired as the 12th head coach in Marist men's basketball program history on April 3, 2018. He won his 250th career game at Dartmouth on Nov. 9, 2015.

At Marist (2018-present)

- Led Marist to its fifth 20-win season in program history in the 2024-25 season with 20, the program's highest total in 18 years. The Red Foxes were ranked #25 in the Feb. 3 College Insider Mid-Major Poll, their first ranking in the poll in program history. Marist's nine-game winning streak from Dec. 6 through Jan. 16 was its longest in 18 years, and was tied for the fourth-longest winning streak in the nation at that time. Josh Pascarelli became the first Red Fox to be named First Team All-MAAC in 18 years.
- In the 2023-24 season, led Marist to its highest win total (18) in 16 years, and its best seed in the MAAC championship (#3) in 17 years. Road win total (8) was also the program's best in 17 years.
- Led Marist to its first berth in the MAAC Championship final in program history in the 2022-23 season. Coached Patrick Gardner, who then appeared in NBA Summer League with the Miami Heat and later signed a contract with the Brooklyn Nets.
- In 2020-21, he led the Red Foxes to their first winning season in 13 years, and best MAAC finish in 14 years.
- In his first season in 2018-19, Dunne led the Red Foxes to their highest win total in five years.

- 2017 CollegeInsider.com postseason tournament (CIT). Came from behind in three road victories, including championship game at Texas A&M Corpus Christi.
- 2011 MAAC Tournament. Won as #4 seed, with victories over #1 Fairfield on its home court in semifinals and #2 Iona in championship game.

Head Coach, Saint Peter's (2006-18)

- 2017-18: Became the first #9 seed to reach MAAC Championship semifinal round with victory over top-seeded Rider.
- 2016-17: Won CIT championship, the program's first national postseason championship. Won 23 games, second-highest total in school history. Set program record with 14 MAAC wins (went 14-6 in conference, finished second). Had program's first MAAC Defensive Player of the Year (Chazz Patterson), two All-MAAC selections (Quadir Welton, First Team; Trevis Wyche, Second Team), and CIT

MVP (Welton). Went 18-6 after New Year's Day, including winning 11 out of 12 to close the season.

- Went 26-14 in MAAC play, 2015-16 and 2016-17.
- Won six MAAC Tournament games and had three semifinal appearances from 2015 to 2018.
- 2010-11: Program's first MAAC championship since 1995, went 20-11 (first 20-win season in 20 years).
- Won 11 MAAC games in the 2009-10 and 2010-11, which hadn't happened at Saint Peter's since 1989.
- Increased the program's win total in each of his first five seasons.
- Defensive success: Ranked second in NCAA in defensive field goal percentage in both 2009-10 (.377) and 2010-11 (.376). Finished 18th in NCAA in defensive efficiency in 2016-17, becoming one of just 11 teams since 2001-02 to finish in the nation's top 75 in all four factors of defensive efficiency.
- Won five MAAC Tournament games as the lower-seeded team (two in 2011, one in 2015, two in 2017). Two of these victories occurred in the quarterfinals, one in the semifinals, and one in the championship game.
- Power conference success: Went 3-3 vs. Rutgers (Big Ten), recorded victories against Alabama (SEC) and Seton Hall (Big East).
- Coached nine 1,000-point scorers, 13 All-MAAC selections, three All-Rookie Team selections, four MAAC All-Tournament Team selections (including one MVP), one MAAC Defensive Player of the Year, and six MAAC All-Academic Team selections.
- Graduated 100 percent of his recruits who completed their eligibility at Saint Peter's.
- Players & coaches donated their time to local soup kitchens and elementary schools.

Assistant Coach Experience

- Seton Hall University (2001-06). Pirates reached NCAA Tournament twice and Postseason NIT once.
- Siena College (1999-2001). Won MAAC regular-season title both seasons, advanced to Postseason NIT Second Round in 2000, had 44-20 overall record.
- Manhattan College (1998-99). Worked under head coach John Leonard.
- Adelphi University (1996-98). Worked under current Orlando Magic head coach Steve Clifford; team posted record of 43-17 in two seasons.
- Wilkes University (1992-94, 1995-96). Had 28-2 record and trip to Division III Elite Eight in 1995-96.
- Western Michigan University (1994-95). First Division I job, worked under head coach Bob Donewald.

Education/Playing Experience

- Earned Master's degree in Sport Management from East Stroudsburg University (1996).
- Earned Bachelor's degree in Psychology from Ithaca College (1992). Was a four-year men's basketball letterwinner. Graduated as the program's all-time leader in steals and third in assists (currently sits fourth in steals, fifth in assists). His 60 steals as a senior rank second in a season.
- Graduated from Archbishop Molloy High School (1988). Played for legendary head coach Jack Curran.

The Opponent

- Marist is 0-4 against Georgia Tech all-time. The first meeting was Marist's first NCAA Tournament game in 1986. This is the first meeting since 2003.
- Marist has never defeated a team that was in the ACC at the time the Red Foxes faced them (0-13 - four losses to Georgia Tech; one apiece to Boston College, Clemson, Duke, Florida State, Maryland, Miami, North Carolina State, Notre Dame, and Wake Forest). Marist defeated Miami on Feb. 18, 1988, but the Hurricanes were an independent at that time.
- The last ACC foe Marist faced was Notre Dame on Dec. 22, 2023. That is the only other time Marist faced an ACC team in head coach **John Dunne's** tenure.

Trending Topics

- Marist has won five straight, its fifth five-game winning streak in the last five years. A win would give the Red Foxes a six-game winning streak in back-to-back years (reached nine last year), and three times in the last five seasons.
- Marist has started 7-2 each of the last three seasons, and a win would give the Red Foxes and 8-2 start for the second straight year.

Tough on D

- Through Dec. 13, Marist ranks sixth in the nation in three-point percentage defense (.252), Marist's has held six of its nine opponents under 30 percent this season from deep this season.
- Marist's 61.9 points allowed per game ranks ninth in the nation. The Red Foxes held their first eight opponents under 70 points.
- Marist held all of its first eight opponents below 40 percent shooting from the field, and is allowing the opposition to shoot .377 from the field, which ranks 14th in the nation.
- Marist has had five halves holding a team under 25 points this season. The Red Foxes' best defensive first half this season is 20 against Mount St. Mary's on Dec. 5, and their best defensive second half is 21 at Dartmouth on Nov. 9.
- Marist forced at least 20 turnovers twice this season, with a high of 21 vs. Mount St. Mary's on Dec. 5. That total is the highest Marist has forced in a game since turning Manhattan over 26 times on Dec. 19, 2020. Marist has forced an average of 17.0 turnovers over its last three games.
- Marist has had at least 10 steals three times this season, with a season-high 15 steals twice: at Dartmouth, Nov. 9; vs. Mount St. Mary's, Dec. 5.

Balanced & Efficient O

- Marist is ninth in the NCAA in free-throw percentage at .789. The Red Foxes went 20-for-21 (season best .952) at Bryant on Dec. 13, and are shooting .815 (88-for-108) from the line in their past eight games.
- Marist has scored at least 40 points in a half in eight of its 18 halves this season. Marist's best first half this was season was 47 points against Vassar on Nov. 12, and its best second half was 48 points against Army on Nov. 21. The only games this season in which Marist did not have a 40-point half were against Harvard on Nov. 16 and Mount St. Mary's on Dec. 5.
- 10 different Red Foxes have scored in double figures in a game this season.
- Marist's 93 points against Vassar on Nov. 12 were the Red Foxes' most since scoring 95 against Fairfield on Jan. 13, 2018.
- Marist drained a season-high 12 three-pointers against Vassar on Nov. 12.
- Marist shot at least 47 percent from the field in each of its first three games, and have done so four times this season.

November/December Numbers

- Marist has won eight straight December games going back to last season.
- Marist went 4-2 in November this season for the third straight year.
- Prior to the 2023-24 season, Marist had last enjoyed a winning November in the 2007-08 season.
