#### BOSTON COLLEGE VS. GEORGIA TECH - ALL-TIME SERIES

- Saturday marks the 35th all time meeting between BC and Georgia Tech.
- The Yellow Jackets holds a 20-14 series lead.
- BC won the most recent matchup against Georgia Tech (2/22/25), where Donald Hand Jr. finished with 20 points and seven rebounds.

#### WELCOME TO CONFERENCE PLAY

- BC opens the new year with ACC play, traveling to Georgia Tech to start.
- The team enters with one of the best defenses in the conference, holding opponents to 66.7 points per game, which ranks sixth.
- Donald Hand Jr. and Fred Payne rank second in minutes per game (34.4), while Aidan Shaw and Jayden Hastings rank fifth in blocks per game (1.5).
- The Eagles hit the road in three of their first four ACC contests.

#### LAST TIME OUT

- Boston College hosted Le Moyne in its final non-conference game on December 28 at Conte Forum, earning a 72-64 win to improve to 7-6.
- Donald Hand Jr. (26) and Fred Payne (22) surpassed 20+ points to lead the Eagles.
- Boden Kapke added 11 rebounds, while Jayden Hastings and Chase Forte both recorded four stocks (Stl + Blks).
- Payne's 22 point showing was a career-high and Kapke's 11 boards were a season-high.
- BC finished with a 3-1 record over NEC teams this season, holding the to 62.0 points per game and 38.7% from the field.

#### EDGERLEY FAMILY COURT

- The basketball court at Silvio O. Conte Forum will officially be named the Edgerley Family Court starting this season.
- The Edgerley's are active members of the Parents Leadership Council and are supporters of undergraduate financial aid at Boston College, having co-chaired Pops on the Heights in 2023 and 2024.
- Sandra Edgerley serves on the Boston College Board of Trustees, where she is a member of the Academic Affairs Committee. Paul Edgerley is a senior advisor at Bain Capital, where he was a managing director and played a leadership role for more than 30 years.
- The court is a lasting symbol of the Edgerleys' commitment to enhancing the tradition of excellence at Boston College.

## ON THIS DATE: JANUARY 3

- Boston College is 11-10 all-time when playing on January 3. The most recent contest was played against Notre Dame in 2023, where BC took a 70-63 win over the Fighting Irish in Chestnut Hill.
- The Eagles' first win on January 3 came against Fitchburg Normal in 1925, winning 22-13.
- January 3 marks National Chocolate Candy Day and Call a Friend Day.
- Basketball players born on January 3: Deni Avdija, Doug McDermott and Rondae Hollis-Jefferson
- Notable events to occur on January 3 - The Curse of the Bambino begins as Babe Ruth is traded from the Red Sox to the Yankees (1920); Alaska admitted as 49th US state (1959); Aaron Holiday, Steve Wozniak and Steve Jobs incorporate Apple Computer, Inc. (1977); Jimmy Butler breaks Michael Jordan's Chicago Bulls record for points in an NBA half, scoring 40 of his 42 points in the second half (2016).

## MARK THE MILESTONES

- Chase Forte is two points away from reaching 1,000 career points.
- Donald Hand Jr. is 131 points away from reaching 1,000 career points - all have come with Boston College.
- Aidan Shaw reached 100 career games played against Harvard (11/26).
- Caleb Steger and Marko Radunovic made their collegiate debuts in the season opener against FAU (11/3). Radunovic also scored his first career points in that game, while Steger claimed his in BC's home opener against The Citadel (11/6).

## RISING ABOVE THE CROWD

- Boston College is making their mark nationally through the first 13 games this season.
- Defensively, the Eagles rank 20th in the nation and third in the ACC in blocks per game (5.4). Aidan Shaw and Jayden Hastings rank fourth in the ACC individually in total blocks (20) and 74th in the NCAA.
- The team also holds the 20th best 3pt percentage defense (27.9) and 51st best scoring defense (66.7) in the country.
- BC is cleaning up the boards efficiently, collecting 40.0 boards per game, good for 61st in the NCAA. The team is also taking care of the ball, allowing just 10.2 turnovers per game. That mark ranks 45th in the nation and seventh in the ACC.

## MAKING THE LEAP - FRED PAYNE

- In his second full season with BC, Fred Payne has made improvements on both sides of the ball.
- Payne has seen increases in points (+5.6), rebounds (+1.1), assists (+1.6) across 13 games.
- The redshirt-sophomore has surpassed his total points tally (172) from last season in less than half of the season.
- His field goal shooting has been more efficient, seeing a +4.4% increase from his numbers in 2024-25.
- Defensively, the redshirt-sophomore has recorded more steals (12) and blocks (4) in the same number of games played.
- Using the PAR/G metric (points+assists+rebounds/game), Payne has jumped +9.2 year-over-year.

## DEFENDING THE HILL

- Boston College has defended home court through eight games, holding a 6-2 record on the Edgerley Family Court.
- The Eagles are holding opponents to 59.4 points per game and limiting them to 36.9% from the field and 24.2% from behind the arc.
- At least two BC players have scored in double figures in each home contest this season. Fred Payne scored a career high 22 and Donald Hand Jr matched a season high 26 points in the most recent contest against Le Moyne.

## CAREER ACCOMPLISHMENTS

- Boden Kapke logged a career-high 17 points, and Fred Payne dished a career-high seven assists against FAU (11/3).
- Marko Radunovic and Caleb Steger made their collegiate debuts against FAU. Radunovic recorded eight points, going 2-3 from behind the arc, and Steger played five minutes with two field goal attempts.
- Jason Asemota flourished in the home-opener against The Citadel (11/6), grabbing a career-high nine points and adding four rebounds to lead all bench scorers.
- Chase Forte swatted a career-high three blocks against Central Connecticut State (11/11).
- Aidan Shaw secured a career-high 14 rebounds and matched a career-high in blocks (5) against Temple (11/15). He became the first BC player to record five or more blocks since Quinten Post did against Louisville (2/13/24).
- Shaw dished a career-high three assists against Hampton (11/18).
- Hastings grabbed a career-high 10 rebounds and registered his first career double-double (11p/10r) against Davidson (11/21).
- Luka Toews recorded a career-high 21 points and six 3pt field goals, and Caleb Steger scored a career-high 12 points against FDU (12/22).
- Fred Payne scored a career-high 22 points in a win against Le Moyne (12/28), adding career-high in 3pt field goals (5) and field goals made (7).

## SIZZLING STREAKS

- Fred Payne has scored double-digit figures in 10 of his last 11 games. He has surpassed 15 points in five games of that streak, with his most recent display of 11 points coming against FDU.
- Donald Hand Jr. is on a five-game streak of double digit scoring, his longest of the season. The redshirt-junior most recently matched a season-high 26 points against Le Moyne, and has surpassed 10+ points in all but two games this season.
- Aidan Shaw rode a five game streak with at least one block. His season-best mark came against Temple (14).
- Shaw also rode a seven game streak of at least eight rebounds per game. The stretch saw Shaw surpass 10+ rebounds on multiple occasions, including a career-high 14 rebounds against Temple.

## IF THIS, THEN THAT...

### WITH A WIN AT GEORGIA TECH...

- Boston College would move to 8-6 overall on the season.
- BC would record its 15th all-time win versus Georgia Tech and improve to 1-0 in the ACC.
- Boston College would move to 1-0 in January and 2-1 in away games in 2025-26
- The Eagles would improve to 5-1 in day games and 4-1 in weekend games this season.
- Head coach Earl Grant would earn his 69th win at Boston College and his 196th as a collegiate head coach.
- BC would earn victory No. 1,293 all-time through 92 seasons of basketball, dating back to 1904-05.

### WITH A LOSS AT GEORGIA TECH...

- Boston College would fall to 7-7 on the season.
- The Eagles would record their 21st all-time defeat to Georgia Tech, moving to 0-1 in ACC play.
- The Eagles would move to 0-1 in January, 4-2 in day games, 3-2 on weekends, and 1-2 in home games.
- Boston College would register the 1,124th loss all-time in program history, dating back to the 1904-05 season.

## INSTANT IMPACT

- The freshmen tandem of Radunovic and Steger have translated well through the first two games, combining for 6.8 points, 3.3 rebounds, and 0.4 assists per game.
- Kapke, Chase Forte, Jason Asemota, and Aidan Shaw are making their presence known on Chestnut Hill. The quadruple is averaging a combined 24.1 points, 17.4 rebounds, 15.0 assists, 9.5 blocks and 6.0 steals per game.
- Individually, Shaw leads the team in rebounds (7.4), and Forte ranks first on the team in steals (1.2) and assists (2.9).

## HAND PICKED

- Redshirt junior Donald Hand Jr. was one of seven players to earn an ACC Preseason Player of the Year vote.
- The 2024-25 ACC Most Improved Player of the Year led the Eagles in points and rebounding last season.
- Hand Jr. is the first Boston College player since Ky Bowman (2018) to garner an ACC Preseason Player of the Year vote.

## EAGLES ELITE EIGHT

- Boston College adds eight newcomers to the 2025-26 roster – four freshmen and four transfers.
- Freshmen: Jack Bailey (New York, N.Y. / Blair Academy); Akbar Waheed III (North Bethesda, Md. / Georgetown Prep); Caleb Steger (Dallas, Texas / Jesuit Dallas); and Marko Radunovic (Montenegro / KK Podgorica Bemax).
- Transfers: Chase Forte (South Dakota – one season remaining); Aidan Shaw (Missouri – one season remaining); Boden Kapke (Butler – two seasons remaining); Jason Asemota (Baylor – three seasons remaining).
- Boston College enters with one of the youngest cores in the ACC – suiting up with 11 underclassmen – the second most in the conference.

## TERRIFIC TRANSFERS

- The four transfer additions are sure to bolster the Eagle rotation, all providing an important part to the game.
- Graduate student transfer Chase Forte, previously of South Dakota, was the 2024-25 Summit League Defensive Player of the Year and named to the Summit League All-League First Team and Newcomer Team; also a 2024-25 NABC All-District team selection.
- Forte led the Coyotes in scoring (17.9 ppg), assists (3.1) and steals (1.9), ranking in the top 50 in the NCAA in free throw attempts (253, 5th) and in total steals (62, 44th).
- Aidan Shaw joins after three seasons at Missouri, where he was a key reserve for Mizzou in its run to the 2025 NCAA Tournament.
- Shaw scored 273 career points for the Tigers, connecting on better than 64% of his shot attempts (115-179) ranking him 39th-best among all active players during that time span (100 FGM min.).
- Boden Kapke is a 6-11 big coming from Butler. He appeared in 34 of 35 games for the Bulldogs last season, starting 16 of the last 17 contests.
- Kapke averaged 4.1 points and 2.8 rebounds in a little over 13 minutes per game.
- The final addition is Jason Asemota, formerly of Baylor. Ranked the 29th best player in the class of 2024, Asemota appeared in 24 games for the Bears and averaged averaged 1.6 points and 1.5 rebounds per game across 148 total minutes.

## FRESH FACES

- Four freshmen join the 2025-26 roster, providing a spark to the rotation.
- Includes Jack Bailey (New York, N.Y. / Blair Academy); Akbar Waheed III (North Bethesda, Md. / Georgetown Prep); Caleb Steger (Dallas, Texas / Jesuit Dallas); and Marko Radunovic (Montenegro / KK Podgorica Bemax).
- Bailey was the first Boston College Class of 2025 commit; earned National Prep All-American honors as a three-star recruit; helped Blair Academy in back-to-back New Jersey Prep Open titles.
- Waheed III was a consensus four-star recruit out of Georgetown Prep, ranked as the 39th best small forward in the nation; was named to consecutive Washington Post All-Met teams; Played grassroots basketball with Team Durant in the EYBL.
- Steger was also a consensus four-star recruit from Jesuit, Texas, ranking inside the top 40 shooting guards in the class of 2025 per 247 Sports; was the 2024-25 District 7-6A Most Valuable Player, averaging 18.3 points and 5.8 rebounds per game.
- Radunovic is the last addition for the Eagles, hailing from Podgorica, Montenegro and KK Podgorica Bemax; represented Montenegro at the U20 European Championship B Division, averaging 15.9 points per game, 8.6 rebounds per game, and 2.3 assists per game in seven games.

## BACK TO THE HEIGHTS

- The Eagles return eight players from the 2024-25 roster, highlighted by Donald Hand Jr., Jayden Hastings and Fred Payne.
- Donald Hand Jr. was named the 2024-25 ACC Most Improved Player and All-ACC Honorable Mention.
- Hastings had an impressive rookie campaign, averaging 4.0 ppg and 3.1 rpg; scored a season-high 18 points vs. Clemson and finished regular season ranked 10th in the ACC in blocked shots (39).
- Payne saw a +5.1 to his points average from his freshman season logging nine double-digit scoring games across the 2025-24 season; finished with a team-best 2.06:1 assist/turnover ratio and a 1.44 steal/turnover mark.

## WHOLE WIDE WORLD

- Boston College has had at least two international players on its men's basketball roster in each of the previous nine season - and 12 of the last 13.
- BC has had at least one foreign-born player on its roster for the last 12 seasons, dating back to 2013-14.
- This season, newcomer Marko Radunovic joins from Montenegro alongside sophomore Luka Toews from Japan and sophomore Kany Tchanda, hailing from the Democratic Republic of the Congo.

# EARL GRANT

## THE CLEMENT AND ELIZABETH IZZI FAMILY HEAD MEN'S BASKETBALL COACH



Earl Grant enters his fifth season as the Clement and Elizabeth Izzu Family Head Men's Basketball Coach at Boston College. Since his arrival at the Heights in 2021, Grant has established a culture of gritty and relentless play on the court, combined with selfless humility, a family atmosphere, and holistic development as people and players off the court.

This past season, Grant brought Boston College to a 12-19 record, providing wins over Boise State, Miami, and Florida State. The Eagles were led by guard Donald Hand Jr., finishing the 2024-25 season as the ACC Most Improved Player and a spot on the NABC All-

District Team. Hand Jr. had a breakout sophomore season, increasing his points per game total by +11.0 and PAR metric (points+assists+rebounds) by +16.0. He ended the season as one of four players to rank in the top 20 in the ACC in scoring (15th) and rebounding (19th), and as one of only three players in the ACC to register 20+ points and five rebounds in at least nine games. Along with his end-of-year award, the Virginia Beach, Va. native earned three ACC Player of the Week awards and was an All-ACC Honorable Mention.

Grant guided the Eagles to their deepest postseason run in 13 years as BC advanced to the second round of the National Invitation Tournament. Finishing with a 20-16 overall record, Grant's 2023-24 BC squad registered the highest overall win total for the program since the 2010-11 season and the most true road victories in a season (7) in nearly two decades. He also helped Boston College advanced to the quarterfinals of the 2024 ACC Championship, falling in overtime against Virginia. Grant tied Al Skinner for the most wins in ACC Tournament play by a BC coach, with five.

In 2023-24, BC was led by Quinten Post, who finished his three-year career as one of the top players in the ACC and in the nation. He earned 2023-24 ACC All-Conference Second Team honors, while also earning a spot on the conference's All-Defensive and All-Tournament teams. Post led Boston College in scoring, rebounding, and blocked shots, while ranking second in assists. The 7-footer was one of only two players in the ACC in 2023-24 to rank among the top 10 in the league in scoring, rebounding, blocked shots, and field goal percentage in the regular season. He became one of only five Boston College players over the last three decades to average at least 17 points and eight rebounds per game.

Additionally, Post was one of only three players in the last 30 years to record 50 3-pointers made, 100 assists, 50 blocked shots, and 30 steals in a single season. He was selected by the Golden State Warriors in the second round of the 2024 NBA Draft, becoming the 34th player in Boston College history to be drafted into the NBA.

During the 2022-23 campaign, Grant's gritty group tallied three wins over nationally ranked opponents, including a 63-48 drubbing of No. 6 Virginia - the first win over a top 10 team in nearly six seasons. Led by ACC Most Improved Player Quinten Post, Boston College won nine games in ACC play - the most since the 2010-11 campaign. Four of the Eagles nine ACC wins came on the road - the highest win total in away league games since 2008-09. As a result, BC and Grant extended their partnership through the 2028-29 season.

In his first season, Grant's Eagles advanced to the quarterfinals of the 2022 New York Life ACC Tournament in Brooklyn, narrowly missing a trip to the semis after a two-point overtime loss to Elite Eight participant Miami. Grant also orchestrated one of the highest-rated recruiting classes in program history, signing two four-star ranked players in the same class for the first time ever. The incoming class of newcomers ranked 30th nationally by Rivals.com and 33rd by 247sports.com.

On March 17, 2021 Grant was introduced as Boston College's 13th head men's basketball coach, bringing an impressive track record to Chestnut Hill after he turned the College of Charleston men's basketball program into a consistent championship contender in the Colonial Athletic Association.

Under Grant's leadership, the College of Charleston was one of only 21 NCAA Division I schools to have players drafted in both the 2019 and 2020 NBA Drafts. Grant led the Cougars to a top-four finish in the CAA in each of the last five seasons, including the 2018 regular season and conference tournament championship.

A finalist for the 2019 Skip Prosser Man of the Year Award, presented annually to a coach who not only achieves success on the basketball court, but who also displays moral integrity off the court, Grant led the Cougars to a memorable run in 2017-18 that included the program's second-straight 25-win campaign, an impressive 26-8 overall record and 14-4 mark in Colonial Athletic Association play. The co-regular-season champions earned the No. 1 seed in the CAA Men's Basketball Championship and defeated No. 2 seed Northeastern in an overtime thriller to punch the program's first ticket to the NCAA Tournament since 1999.

Grant guided the Cougars to three 20-win campaigns and a 67-22 home-court winning record over the previous six years and produced 12 all-conference honorees.

For the first time in program history, College of Charleston's men's basketball was recognized by the NCAA for the 2018-19 academic year. Under the guidance of Grant, the programs' four-year rolling APR was in the Top 10% of all men's basketball programs in the country. The Cougars were one of only 51 men's basketball programs honored nationally. In all, 24 players have gone on to earn their degree at The College.

In 2018-19, CoFC posted a 24-9 overall record with non-conference victories over Rhode Island, VCU and Memphis. Two players - Grant Riller and Jarrell Brantley - were named to the All-CAA First Team. Known for their gritty defense, the Cougars led the CAA in scoring defense for the fourth-straight year holding opponents to 68.6 points per game. CoFC also ranked No. 17 in the nation in turnovers per game (10.5 avg.) and No. 16 in free-throw percentage (76.4%).

Known as a player's coach, Grant and his staff helped develop Brantley into a 2019 NBA

Draft Pick and Riller into a 2020 NBA Draft Pick - the third and fourth-ever College of Charleston players to be drafted. Brantley is currently a two-way player with the Utah Jazz and was named to the 2020 NBA G League First Team and All-Rookie Team as a member of the Salt Lake City Stars. He was second in voting for NBA G League Rookie of the Year honors. Riller was selected in the second round by the Charlotte Hornets giving the Cougars back-to-back NBA Draft picks for the first time in school history.

In 2016-17, Grant led the Cougars to a 25-10 overall record and 14-4 mark in Colonial Athletic Association play. It marked the program's first 20-win campaign since 2013. Charleston, seeded a program-best No. 2, advanced to the championship game of the CAA Tournament for the first time since CoFC joined the Colonial in 2013. They were also selected and made their fifth all-time appearance in the Postseason NIT. It was their first postseason berth (NCAA or NIT) since 2011.

In his second season with the Cougars, Grant and his staff turned the program into one of the most improved in NCAA Division I and developed four all-conference players including Colonial Athletic Association Rookie of the Year and All-CAA Third Team selection Jarrell Brantley - the first freshman to receive such honors since 2006.

Known as a top recruiter, Grant has shown impressive credentials in both identifying and developing top-flight talent. No stranger to the ACC, he previously spent four seasons as an assistant coach at Clemson under Brad Brownell, where he made a positive impact on the Tiger men's basketball program, both in recruiting and with player development. He worked primarily with Clemson's point guards.

He recruited 2014 first-team All-ACC selection K.J. McDaniels to Clemson, where he ultimately ended up averaging 17 points per game as a junior and was named ACC Defensive Player of the Year, before declaring early for the NBA Draft. McDaniels was selected 32nd overall in the 2014 NBA Draft by the Philadelphia 76ers.

Several Tiger point guards have flourished under Grant's mentoring including incumbent starter Rod Hall. After recruiting the Augusta, Ga., native to Clemson, Grant has seen Hall develop into one of the leaders of the program. During the 2013-14 season, Hall was second on the team in scoring average and ranked among the ACC's top 10 in both assists per game and assist-to-turnover ratio.

In 2010-11, Grant worked with Demontez Stitt, who was named third-team All-ACC and was a member of the All-ACC Tournament Team. That same season, Grant helped Andre Young to an ACC-leading 2.55 assist-to-turnover ratio. Young went on to lead the conference in steals per game as a senior in 2011-12, earning All-ACC Defensive Team honors. He also led the Tigers in scoring under Grant's direction.

Clemson put together strong team results with Grant in the fold as well. In 2013-14, the Tigers went 23-13 overall and recorded a 10-win improvement from the previous season. Clemson advanced to the NIT semifinals and was 10-8 during the ACC regular season.

In Grant's first season in 2010-11, Clemson put together a 22-12 overall record and 9-7 league mark in the ACC. The Tigers earned the No. 4 seed at the ACC Tournament and advanced to the semifinals in Greensboro, N.C. Clemson also went to a fourth-consecutive NCAA Tournament and won its first-round game over UAB, 70-52, in Dayton, Ohio.

Clemson was strong defensively in four seasons with Grant part of its coaching staff. In 2010-11, the Tigers ranked No. 24 nationally in scoring defense. In 2011-12, Clemson yielded just 60.6 points per game to the opposition, the second-best figure among ACC schools. In 2012-13, the Tigers dropped their average even further to 60.1 points per game. That figure dropped to an ACC era-best at Clemson - 58.4 points per game - in 2013-14. The Tiger perimeter defense was No. 1 nationally defending the three-pointer (.286).

Grant personally signed 10 of Clemson's 15 players recruited by Brownell's staff. He was Clemson's lead recruiter for players such as Austin Ajukwa, Jaron Blossomgame, Gabe DeVoe, Ibrahim Djambo, Sidy Djitte, Hall, K.J. McDaniels and Patrick Rooks.

Prior to Clemson, Grant served as an assistant coach first at Winthrop and then at Wichita State. He helped the Eagles to three consecutive Big South championships and three straight NCAA Tournament appearances. In 2004-05, the Eagles were 27-6 overall. The next season, Winthrop finished the year with a 23-8 overall record and came within two points of upsetting Tennessee in the NCAA Tournament. In 2007, Grant helped the Eagles to a 29-5 overall record and unblemished 14-0 mark in Big South play.

The 2007 campaign was a memorable one for Winthrop. With Grant's assistance, the Eagles claimed a 74-64 upset over No. 6 seed Notre Dame in the opening round of the NCAA Tournament. It was Winthrop's first-ever NCAA Tournament win in seven tries.

Grant was at Wichita State from 2007-10, when the Shockers made gradual improvement each season. In 2008-09, Wichita State made its first postseason appearance in three years and also defeated one of the nation's top mid-major programs in Siena during the regular season. In 2009-10, Wichita State improved its win total by eight and finished 25-10 overall, 12-6 in the Missouri Valley Conference. The Shockers advanced to the championship game of the conference tournament and also earned a bid to the National Invitation Tournament.

Prior to his stint at Winthrop, Grant was an assistant coach at The Citadel from 2002-04. Grant played two years at the Division II level at Georgia College. He led the school to two appearances in the NCAA Tournament and to consecutive Peach Belt Conference championships (1999, 2000). In 2000, the Bobcats advanced to the Elite Eight of the Division II national tournament.

A native of North Charleston, S.C., Grant earned his bachelor's degree in psychology from Georgia College in 2000. He and his wife, Jacci, have three sons: Trey, Eyziah and Elonzo.
