### TOP STORYLINES

- No. 3 Georgia Tech returns to The Flats for the first time in 17 days following a three-city, seven game road trip in which the team went 4-3.
- This will mark the third ranked matchup for the Yellow Jackets this season, and the first on home turf. Tech won the series at No. 8 Clemson (2-1) and dropped a midweek at No. 4 Auburn (0-1) for a 2-2 season record against Top 25 teams.
- The Jackets are the highest ranked team in the ACC across five different national top-25 polls, coming in at No. 3 across all five major polls.
- This is the second straight week that Georgia Tech has been ranked in the Top 3 of all the major college baseball polls, the first time that has happened since 2010.
- The Yellow Jackets enter this week as the best offense in the country and the best offense in modern college baseball history. In the 16 seasons of the BBCOR era, the 2026 Yellow Jackets have produced the best batting average (.373), on-base percentage (.495) and runs/game (12) of any Power 4 team after six weeks in the BBCOR era.
- Tech leads Division I in six standard statistical categories: batting average (.373), on-base percentage (.495), OPS (1.140), hits (317), walks (177) and runs (288) and are Top 10 in multiple others: slugging (2nd – .648), doubles (3rd – 68) and home runs (4th – 50).
- The Jackets also lead Division I in five advanced stats: BABIP (.425), WOPA (.507) WRC (274) WRAA (106) and WRC+ (163)
- Georgia Tech has scored 288 runs through its first 24 games, the most runs scored up to this point in GT's 131-year history. Tech eclipsed 200 runs scored for the season in just 15 games, breaking the previous program record by two games (reached 200 runs in 17 games back in 1987).
- Tech has outscored its opponents 288-119. That +169 margin is the highest through 24 games in program history and the 7.04 average margin of victory is the highest in Division I.
- The Jackets have already matched their record for 20-run games in a single season in the BBCOR era, with three – tying the record set in 2023 when the team did so over 57 games.
- Tech has scored 10 or more runs in 16 of its 24 games this season and are scoring 20+ at the same rate in which they are scoring 5 or fewer (three times).
- Tech stands at 19-5 and have won each of their first six series of the season for the first time since 2011.
- **Carson Kerce** leads the NCAA with 16 doubles this season, three doubles more than the next closest player. Will Baker is just behind with 12 (6th in Division I). GT is the only program in the nation with multiple players delivering more than 11 doubles this year.
- **Kerce** leads the nation with 0.67 doubles/game which puts him on pace for 36 by the end of the season. The program record is 27, set by Jay Payton in 1994.
- Two Tuesdays ago, vs. West Georgia on March 10, junior **Vahn Lackey** made GT history by becoming the first Yellow Jacket in recorded history to play eight different defensive positions in a single game, every position but pitcher and earning himself Perfect Game National Player of the Week honors. He leads the team in batting average (.425), OBP (.545), slugging percentage (.851), OPS (1.396), RBI (33), home runs (9), walks (21) and stolen bases (7-for-7).
- **Drew Burress** has hit a BBCOR era program record 49 home runs over his GT career, the 5th-most in Georgia Tech program history. He is now three home runs away from tying Andy Bruce (1988-91) for the fourth-most HRs by a Yellow Jacket and eight homers shy of the record (57) set by Jason Varitek (1991-94).
- The Yellow Jackets lead the nation with 3 different players batting over .420, only one other program has multiple (Mercer – 2): **Lackey** (.425), **Alex Hernandez** (.424) and **Kerce** (.420).
- There are 192 Division I teams that do not have a player with a batting average higher than GT's team batting average (.381).
- Georgia Tech is the only team in the nation with four players carrying an on-base percentage of at least .530: **Lackey** (.545), **Kent Schmidt** (.548) **Hernandez** (.542) & **Kerce** (.530).
- The Jackets will take on the Wolfpack for the first time since a series sweep in Atlanta in 2024.
- Tech leads the all-time series, 81-62 with a stellar 40-16 record against NCSU on The Flats.

**RECRUITING SUCCESS**

• Tech has now signed top-5 classes in four of the last seven years, top-10 classes in five of the last seven years, and had six-straight top-20 Perfect Game recruiting classes, leading the Atlantic Coast Conference in all categories.

• The 2025 class was ranked No. 28 overall, due to only having nine commits. Although the average player grade came in at 6.44 - the 15th best in the nation.

• The class featured three signees that signed MLB contracts, notably Ryan Mitchell (2nd round pick by the Cardinals) and Ryan Hall (5th round pick by the Tigers)

• It also features **Cooper Underwood**, the No. 1 LHP from the state of Georgia and the 2025 Prep Baseball Georgia Player of the Year out of Allatoona HS. He turned down a 7 figure signing bonus from the Brewers after they selected him in the 12th round of the 2025 MLB Draft.

• Underwood was named the third starter for the opening weekend series, becoming the first true freshman pitcher to start on opening weekend for the Yellow Jackets since Adam Finateri in 2022.

**RAMMER TIME - A NEW ERA OF TECH BASEBALL**

• 2026 is the first season for new Head Coach **James Ramsey** who had been serving as an assistant coach for the past seven seasons.

• Since Ramsey took over coaching the offense in 2019, Georgia Tech leads the ACC in batting average (.311), OPS (.929), OBP (.413), slugging (.516), hits (4,278), doubles (864) and SAC Flies (219), they are second in runs (3,125), triples (90) and RBI (2,978) and third in HR (597).

• Ramsey takes over for the legendary head coach, and Hall of Famer, **Danny Hall**, who retired after his 32nd season in 2025 with the ninth-most wins in college baseball history - 1,452

• This is the first time Tech has had a new head coach since Hall took over in 1994, leading the Yellow Jackets to the College World Series final on the backs of three 1st round draft picks: Nomar Garciaparra, Jason Varitek and Jay Payton.

• This season, Ramsey takes over a team with similar expectations and possibly more 1st round picks. Drew Burress is considered the top outfielder in the upcoming draft along with Vahn Lackey, the top catcher in the class. Jarren Advincula and Alex Hernandez are both projected as Top 50 prospects with the opportunity to play themselves into the 1st round with a strong 2026.

**Returning the Culture**

• Georgia Tech baseball returns eight of the nine players from the starting lineup of the opening game of the Oxford Regional last season: CF Drew Burress, 1B Kent Schmidt, RF Alex Hernandez, C Vahn Lackey, LF Caleb Daniel, 3B Carson Kerce, 2B Will Baker and DH Drew Rogers.

• The Jackets return 11 hitters from last years team, returning 519 hits (82%), 119 doubles (80%), nine triples (75%) 72 home runs (77%) and 375 RBI (80%).

• They return the 2025 team-leaders in batting average (Kent Schmidt - .397), slugging pct. (Drew Burress - .693), on-base pct. (Drew Burress - .469), runs scored (Drew Burress - 77), hits (Vahn Lackey and Alex Hernandez - 77), RBI (Alex Hernandez - 69), doubles (Drew Burress - 23) and home runs (Drew Burress - 19)

• Alex Hernandez was named 2025 ACC Freshman of the Year, giving Tech back-to-back ACC Freshman of the Year after Drew Burress took home the award in 2024. Georgia Tech was already the only program in conference history to win the award in back-to-back seasons after doing so in 1991 (Jason Varitek) and 1992 (Nomar Garciaparra) - now having done so twice.

• Hernandez became the 7th Yellow Jacket to win Freshman of the Year, joining GT legends Drew Burress (2024), Matt Wieters (2005), Micah Owings (2003), Mark Teixeira (1999), Nomar Garciaparra (1992), and Jason Varitek (1991).

• He earned the award after setting a Georgia Tech freshman record with 69 RBI.

• Georgia Tech is now tied with North Carolina for the most freshman of the year awards in ACC history. Since the conference first began awarding them back in 1991, GT and UNC are the only programs with more than five.

• Burress earned his ACC FOTY award and the National Freshman of the Year honor after slugging .821 in 2024- the highest single season slugging percentage in program history, with a minimum of 200 at bats. It was the 4th highest slugging percentage in a single season by a Yellow Jacket, the best since 1926 and the first .800+ slugging season in 45 years (Tommy Thompson (.811) – 1979).

• Tech led the nation in doubles last season (149) and return 119 of those to the lineup this year, while adding in Jarren Advincula (17) & Ryan Zuckerman (16).

• The Jackets were the only Power 4 team with three players at 20+ doubles last year: Burress (23), Kyle Lodise (20) & Carson Kerce (20)

• Tech also returns 60 % of its innings pitched from 2025, including Friday night starter Tate McKee and National Stopper of the Year Finalist/NCBWA All-American, Mason Patel.

• The Jackets pitching staff delivered a 9.37 K/9 rate last season, the third highest in program history.

**2025 REGULAR SEASON ACC CHAMPIONS**

• The Yellow Jackets won their 10th ACC regular season championship with an ACC leading 19 wins in conference play.

• It was the first outright Atlantic Coast Conference regular-season championship in 20 years: 1987, 1993, 1997, 2000, 2004, 2005, 2011 and now 2025 (Divisional titles in 2019 and 2021).

• In true #CardiacJackets form, the team clinched the regular season title on the final day of conference play, with an 8-2 victory at Duke in which Drew Burress went 4-for-4 in the win, reaching base five times with a single, two doubles, a home run and a hit-by-pitch for his 5th-career four-hit game and his second of the weekend.

• Tech finished the 2025 season with a 41-19 record, the best winning percentage since 2019.

• GT pitching held opponents to 8.84 hits-per-nine innings this year, the lowest mark in over a decade (8.43 in 2014).

• The Jackets finished with a 13-7 record on the road (.650 winning %) – tied for the best road record since 2011 (14-3) and the 5th-best road record with at least 20 games played in program history.

• Vahn Lackey was named a semifinalist for the Buster Posey National Collegiate Catcher of the Year award. Georgia Tech is one of three programs with multiple Buster Posey Award winners (Kevin Parada in 2022 and Joey Bart in 2018), alongside Florida State and Southern California.

• Mason Patel became the first finalist for the National Stopper of the Year award in program history, after becoming the first Yellow Jacket in program history to win 11 games without making a single start. His 11 wins last year was the 13th-most in a single season in GT history, most since Kyle Bakker posted 13 wins in 2002.

• Over Ramsey's tenure, the Georgia Tech offense has led the nation in multiple categories and have been the class of the ACC - one of the nations most difficult conferences.

**LIVING UP TO EXPECTATIONS IN 2026**

- The Yellow Jackets offense entered the 2026 season with as lofty of expectation as you can imagine, being lauded as "the best position player group... and it's not even close," by D1 Baseball's Aaron Fitt. Additionally, D1 Baseball's Bradley Smart gushed over the talent in the Tech lineup when he said, "This position player group has a chance to be the best in the country. Full Stop."
- Through 24 games, the Yellow Jackets have lived up to the hype, exploding for a Power 4 BBCOR era record 288 runs against Bowling Green (50), Georgia Southern (25), Stony Brook (51), Georgia State (8), Northwestern (44), Virginia Tech (36), West Georgia (14), Clemson (28), Auburn (2) and Pitt (32).
- In six weekend series, the Jackets are averaging 12.7 runs/game overall and 10.67 runs/game across three ACC series.
- 288 runs through the first 24 games of the regular season is the most in the program's 131-year history and the + 169 margin of victory is also the largest in program history.
- Tech has scored at least 10 runs in 16 of 24 games this season.
- The Jackets are the only Power 4 team, and one of only two programs in the BBCOR era to record this many runs through the first six weekends of a regular season. (Also New Mexico State in 2019).
- The 50 runs against BGSU were the most Tech has scored over an opening weekend three-game series in program history.
- The 50-11 overall score was the largest margin of victory (39) for a three-game series since Tech swept Western Carolina by a 47-run margin back in 2019.
- The Jackets went on to win three of their weekend series by at least a 30-run margin: +39 vs. BGSU, +33 vs. Stony Brook and +32 vs. Northwestern.
- The 27 run outburst in the second game of the series vs. Bowling Green is tied for the most runs scored by GT in a single game since 1994 – Danny Hall's first year with Georgia Tech, and the year the Yellow Jackets finished runners-up at the College World Series.
- 25 runs at Georgia Southern are the most GT has ever scored in the series' 144 game history, while the 24-run victory was the largest margin of victory in the BBCOR era (since 2011) and the largest since defeating Virginia Tech by 25 runs on May 14, 2005 (27-2).
- Tech delivered its third 20+ run game of the season on Sunday against Stony Brook (Feb. 22). It was the third 20-run game of the season, matching the BBCOR era record for a single season and the most, overall, since 2010.
- GT smashed Virginia Tech 16-1 in its ACC opener, the most in an ACC opener since scoring 25 against Maryland in 1995.
- The 15-run margin of victory is the most in Tech has had an ACC game since beating Clemson, 18-2, last year.
- The Yellow Jackets enter this week as the best offense in the country and the best offense in modern college baseball history. In the 16 seasons of the BBCOR era,

- the 2026 Yellow Jackets have produced the best batting average (.373), on-base percentage (.495) and runs scored (288) of any Power 4 team after six weeks in the BBCOR era.
- Tech leads Division I in six standard statistical categories: batting average (.373), on-base percentage (.495), OPS (1.140), hits (317), walks (177) and runs (288) and are Top 10 in multiple others: slugging (2nd – .644), doubles (3rd – 68) and home runs (4th – 50).

- The Jackets are the only team with a batting average over .370 and lead the nation by .009 over the next closest team (Texas Tech - .364).
  - There are 192 Division I teams that do not have a single player with a batting average higher than GT's team batting average (.373).
  - Tech is the only team in Division I with an OBP over .475, coming in .024 points ahead of the next best team: Mercer (.471).
  - The Jackets are scoring an average of 1 run/game more than the next closest team - Texas Tech (11.0).
  - Carson Kerce leads the NCAA with 16 doubles this season, three doubles more than the next closest player. Will Baker is just behind with 12 (6th in Division I). GT is the only program in the nation with multiple players delivering more than 11 doubles this year.
  - Kerce leads the nation with 0.67 doubles/game which puts him on pace for 36 by the end of the season. The program record is 27, set by Jay Payton in 1994.
  - vs. West Georgia on March 10, junior Vahn Lackey made GT history by becoming the first player in recorded history to play eight different defensive positions in a single game, every position but pitcher. He went 3-for-4 at the plate, finishing a single shy of the cycle. He would go onto finish a triple shy of the cycle in the series opener at Clemson that weekend, on his way to earning Perfect Game National Player of the Week honors.
  - The Yellow Jackets lead the nation with 3 different players batting over .420, only one other program has multiple (Mercer – 2): Lackey (.425), Alex Hernandez (.424) and Kerce (.420).

- Earlier this season, Vahn Lackey set a career high with an 11 game hit streak.
- Kent Schmidt set a career high with a 26 game on-base streak that extended back into 2025.
- Alex Hernandez' current 26 game on-base streak is the longest on the team and tied with Schmidt for the longest by any Yellow Jacket since Burress' 56 game streak last season.

**Last Friday: GT 11- Pitt 9**

- The Yellow Jackets got out in front, 8-0 after the first two innings thanks to a three-run blast from Pitt transfer Ryan Zuckerman and a grand slam by Alex Hernandez. After a 45-minute rain delay, the Panthers cut the lead to 11-9 through five, only for Caden Gaudette and Mason Patel to deliver 4.0 hitless innings out of the bullpen, securing the victory and giving GT its sixth straight series opening win.
- Tech improved to 18-4, matching the 22-game record from last season and tied for the best start since 2010.
- GT has scored at least 10 runs in all three ACC series openers, scoring an average of 12.3 runs in those games.
- Alex Hernandez hit a grand slam in the second inning, already the second grand slam the Jackets have hit through seven ACC games after Kent Schmidt hit one last weekend at Clemson.
- Junior Ryan Zuckerman enjoyed his first game back at his former institution, driving a pitch 435 feet for a three-run home run in the first inning.
- It was his ninth home run of the season, tying him with Vahn Lackey for the most on the team. Zuckerman is now four HR shy of the career high he set last season, over 55 games played.
- The Yardley, Pa. native drove in three runs for the day, all coming on the home run. He brings his season total to 31, also tied with Lackey for the most on the team.
- Sophomore Alex Hernandez extended his hit streak to three games with a grand slam in the second inning. He was jammed on an inside fastball but muscled it over the right field wall anyway, giving Tech an 8-0 lead.
- It was his 5th home run of the season and already the third grand slam of his GT career, having hit two last season as a freshman.
- Sophomore Caleb Daniel went 1-for-4 with three RBI thanks to a two-run single in the fourth inning and a productive out in the third. That brings his season total to 18 RBI with five multi-RBI games.
- Junior Kent Schmidt got the scoring started with an RBI single in the first inning. It was his 16th RBI of the season and his 10th in ACC play, 2nd on the team, only behind Zuckerman's 11.
- Junior Jarren Advincula continued his consistent hitting, going 3-for-5 with two runs scored. He has now recorded a team-high 13 multi-hit games this season and extends his hitting streak to a team-high six games.
- Junior Drew Burress drew a walk and was hit by a pitch twice. He would come around to score, becoming Tech's sixth player with 26 runs scored.

**Last Saturday: GT 9 - Pitt 14**

- Junior Carson Kerce led the team with three hits, going 3-for-5 with two doubles. He has hit 15 doubles this season, the most in the NCAA.
- This was his fourth game of the year with multiple doubles after doing so only twice in his previous two seasons. Kerce is five doubles shy of his career high, set last season.

- He is hitting doubles at a .65/game pace, which would give him 35 by the end of the season. The program record is 27, set by Jay Payton in 1994.
- Sophomore Drew Rogers delivered the hardest hit ball of the season, smashing a line drive home run at 117.3 mph in the fifth inning. It was his fifth home run of the season and his first in ACC play.
- Senior Parker Brosius connected for a solo home run in the second inning. It was his second HR of the season and the fifth of his career.
- His two home runs match his career high, set back in 2024.
- Junior Jarren Advincula extended his hitting streak to a team-high seven games, connecting for his first double of the season in the first inning.

**Last Sunday: GT 12 - Pitt 4**

- Tech pitching answered the bell, holding the Panthers scoreless, with only two hits allowed, through the first six innings as the Jacket offense scored 12 unanswered runs.
- The Jackets used five doubles and some errors from Pitt to score multiple runs in the second, fourth, sixth and seventh innings, headlined by a six-run sixth inning. Nine different Jackets recorded base hits, led by three apiece from Jarren Advincula and Carson Kerce. Jackson Blakely delivered an incredibly strong start, pitching 4.0 innings of shutout baseball, allowing only two hits and striking out five. He was followed by 1.1 scoreless courtesy of Brett Barfield before the Panthers eventually got four across prior to the lightning stoppage.
- Georgia Tech has won its first six series of the season for the first time since 2011.
- Tech has won each of their first three ACC series in back-to-back years for the first time since 2010-11.
- Tech hit five doubles, one shy of its season high. GT has now hit 68 doubles this season, the most in the ACC.
- This marked the fifth time this season that Tech pitching has held the opponent scoreless through six innings. The Jackets are unsurprisingly, 5-0 when that has occurred.
- Junior Carson Kerce led the team with three hits, going 3-for-4 with a double. He has hit 16 doubles this season, the most in the NCAA.
- He is hitting doubles at a .67/game pace, which would give him 36 by the end of the season. The program record is 27, set by Jay Payton in 1994.
- He finished with two RBI, bringing his season total to 22. It was his sixth multi-RBI game of the season and his second straight, marking the first time this season he has recorded multiple RBI in consecutive games.
- He has produced RBI in three consecutive games for the first time this season, putting him one shy of the longest streak of his career, set in 2024.
- Junior Jarren Advincula recorded his team-leading 14th multi-hit game of the season, going 3-for-5 with a double, and RBI and a run scored.
- He finishes the series with two doubles after entering the weekend zero to his name.
- Those three hits extended his team-leading hitting streak to eight games.
- Junior Ryan Zuckerman came around to score three times, his ninth multi-run game of the season.
- Zuckerman led the team with five runs scored this series, in his return to Pittsburgh.

- Junior Kent Schmidt also came around to score three times, matching his season high. This was his seventh multi-run performance of the season over 16 games played.

**Last Midweek: GT 2 - Auburn 9**

- Junior Jarren Advincula was responsible for two of the Jackets' three hits, going 2-for-4 with two RBI. He now leads the team in both multi-hit games (12) and multi-RBI games (nine).
- Advincula extended his hitting streak to a team-high five games heading into the weekend, recording at least one hit in each of the last four games against Top 10 opponents.
- Sophomore Alex Hernandez recorded his 32nd hit of the season. Georgia Tech is the only program in the nation with three players totaling at least 32 hits this year: Hernandez (32), Vahn Lackey (34) and Advincula (32).
- Junior Drew Burress drew a pair of walks and came around to score in the first inning. It was his 25th run of the season.
- Georgia Tech is the only program in the nation to have six different players score at least 25 runs this year: Hernandez (29), Lackey (28), Will Baker (26), Advincula (25), Ryan Zuckerman (25) & Burress (25).

The Yellow Jackets were the highest ranked team in the conference across four different national preseason top-25 polls: No. 2 (Perfect Game), No. 4 (Baseball America), No. 4 (USA Today Coaches Poll) and No. 5 (D1 Baseball).

The No. 2 preseason ranking is the fourth highest in program history and the highest since 2003 (BA), 2001 and 1994 when the Jackets were preseason No. 1.

Tech earned its highest preseason ranking from Baseball America since 2006 (the last time GT reached the College World Series)

The No. 4 ranking from the Coaches Poll was the highest in that poll since Tech was ranked preseason No. 2 in 2003.

The No. 5 ranking from D1 Baseball was the best Tech has received since the publication began doing preseason rankings in 2014.

The Yellow Jackets are officially a consensus Top 5 team headed into the season. It is the first time Tech has been consensus Top 5 at any time since 2006, the last time the Jackets went to the College World Series.

is the first time GT is a consensus Top 5 team in the preseason since 2003, 23 years ago.

"It's great to see us ranked so highly to start the season," head coach James Ramsey said. "It's a reflection of all the hard work that our players and staff have been putting in since the end of last season both in recruiting new players and continuing to develop the talent that helped us to an ACC Championship last year. We're all excited to get to work and put a product on the field that Georgia Tech can rally behind and be proud of. We know our fanbase is ready for championship level baseball on The Flats and our team couldn't be more excited to play this season in front of them."

This week, Georgia Tech was a consensus Top 3 team for the second straight week, the first time that has happened since 2010.

## PITCHING

### The Matt Taylor Effect

• 2026 is the third year on The Flats for pitching coach Matt Taylor and Director of Pitching Jason Richman.

• Last season, the Tech pitching staff improved in just about every statistical category and with 60% of the innings pitched returning for 2026 infused by a very well regarded freshman and transfer class. The Jackets are hoping to be even stingier on the mound this year.

• GT pitching finished 2025 with a 4.91 team ERA, its lowest in six years (2019 – 4.46) and 4th lowest in the ACC.

• It was the first time Tech has been in the Top 5 of the conference in ERA since 2011.

• The Jackets struck out 527 opposing hitters this past season and have struck out at least 500 in every season since the pandemic shortened 2020 campaign – one of only four ACC programs to have done so (also FSU, Duke and UNC).

• GT improved its ERA by 1.57 runs from 2024 to 2025, the third largest improvement among Power 4 programs and the largest improvement by any Power 4 team to make a Regional.

• So far, through 21 games, Tech pitching is striking out opponents at a 10.5 K/9 clip, the 39th best rate in the nation and the 7th best in the ACC.

• Tech pitching surrendered five or fewer runs in each of its first eight games for the first time since 2014 and only the second time in the 21st century. This marks the 14th season that Tech has accomplished this overall: 2026, 2014, 1993, 1987, 1965, 1964, 1959, 1957, 1925, 1920, 1917, 1913, 1909 and 1905.

• GT matched a program record with 19 strikeouts at Georgia Southern, the most since 1989 and only the third time it has been accomplished in 131 years of Tech baseball.

• Prior to joining the Yellow Jackets, Taylor was the minor league pitching coordinator for the Atlanta Braves after three seasons as the pitching coach at Georgia State.

• On opening weekend, the Jackets recorded 37 strikeouts in 25.0 innings, good enough for a 13.33 K/9 clip, the 23rd best mark in the country and the fifth highest in the ACC.

• Sophomore Jackson Blakely recorded nine strikeouts in his first career start, the most Ks by any Tech pitcher making career start No. 1 since at least the turn of the century.

• R-freshman Dimitri Angelakos also made his first career start, one week after Blakely against Georgia State, pitching 5.0 scoreless innings with five strikeouts and only two hits allowed. He was perfect through the lineup for the first time, retiring the first nine batters he faced.

### Last Friday: GT 11- Pitt 9

• The pitching struck out 10 batters today, the eighth time this season the staff has struck out double-digits and the second time in ACC play.

• Junior Tate McKeemade his 22nd consecutive series opening start, battling across 4.0 innings with six strikeouts and six earned.

• He becomes the first Yellow Jacket to breach the 30-strikeout mark, bringing his season total to a team high 31.

• Tech improves to 18-4 in series openers started by McKee (.818 win %).

• R-junior Caden Gaudette made his team-leading 10th appearance of the season out of the bullpen, no other Tech pitcher has more than seven.

• He put the Pitt comeback hopes to bed with 2.0 scoreless and hitless innings, allowing only one baserunner off a walk.

• This was his fifth scoreless outing of the season and his third outing of at least 2.0 innings.

• He lowers his ERA to 4.09 over 11.0 innings on the season.

• Mason Patel got the ball for the final two innings, earning himself a 2.0 inning save by shutting down the Pitt lineup with only one baserunner allowed (via a two-out walk) and striking out two.

• This was Patel's sixth career save and first of the season. He recorded a team-high five saves last season on his way to becoming Tech's first NCBWA All-American pitcher since 2019.

• Since recovering from an injury that saw him miss 20 days, Patel has made two appearances out of the bullpen, pitching 3.2 scoreless innings with a victory and a save.

• Over the last two seasons, Patel has made 25 appearances out of the bullpen, posting 12 wins and six saves.

### Last Saturday: GT 9 - Pitt 14

• Junior Dylan Loy made his fifth start of the season and fourth consecutive weekend start. He only made it through 1.0 innings and would ultimately get saddled with the first loss of his career.

• Junior Porter Buursema stopped the bleeding on the mound, delivering the first two scoreless innings of the day for either side, ultimately pitching 3.0 innings with only one earned run allowed, off a SAC fly.

- The 3.0 innings pitched were the most he has delivered in White & Gold and the most since his freshman season at Georgia Southern.
- He recorded three strikeouts, bringing his season total to 12 with only 8.0 innings pitched and lowering his season ERA to 3.38.
- Buursema is holding opponents to a .083 batting average this season, the lowest on the pitching staff.
- Freshman Jamie Vicens faced one batter in the ninth inning, doing his job by recording his eighth strikeout of the season.
- Senior Brett Barfield pitched a scoreless final 0.2 innings. It was his seventh appearance of the season and the fifth in which he has not allowed a run.

**Last Sunday: GT 12 - Pitt 4**

- The pitching struck out 10 batters, the ninth time this season the staff has struck out double-digits and the third time in ACC play.
- This marked the fifth time this season that Tech pitching has held the opponent scoreless through six innings. The Jackets are unsurprisingly, 5-0 when that has occurred.
- Sophomore Jackson Blakely was nearly flawless in his 4.0 innings of work as the starter. He allowed only two hits and two walks while striking out five.
- This was his third start of the season and his second scoreless start – he went 5.0 innings with nine strikeouts in his first-career start earlier this season against Georgia State.
- He would get credit for the win after the weather called the game to a halt, improving his record to 2-1 this season.
- Senior Brett Barfield pitched a scoreless 1.1 innings in relief. It was his eighth appearance of the season and the sixth in which he has not allowed a run.
- R-sophomore Justin Shadek came out of the bullpen to record the final two outs of the seventh, after Pitt broke up the shutout. He would strike out both batters he faced, ending the seventh inning before the weather ended the game.
- Shadek has now recorded 14 strikeouts over 10.2 innings this season and lowers his ERA to 3.38.

**Last Midweek: GT 2 - Auburn 9**

- R-freshman Dimitri Angelakos made his third consecutive Tuesday start. He allowed his first earned runs as a starter today and would exit in the second inning.
- R-sophomore Jake Lankie made his sixth appearance out of the bullpen, recording a pair of strikeouts to get the Jackets out of the second inning. Those would be the first of eight consecutive outs recorded for Lankie, who delivered 2.2 scoreless innings with only one hit allowed before the first three batters reached in the fifth and eventually scored after Lankie was relieved.
- Lankie recorded three strikeouts, bringing his season total to 13, one more than his season total from his r-freshman season last year (12).
- R-Junior Carson Ballard entered the game in the 6th inning, getting a flyout and allowing a walk before striking out the next 4 batters he faced. He struck out the side in the bottom of the 7th to bring his season totals to 12 Ks in 9.0 innings of work and a very impressive 1.00 ERA.

**Jim Poole Number - Carson Ballard**

Georgia Tech baseball continues the legacy of former Yellow Jacket standout and Major League Baseball relief pitcher Jim Poole, who passed away from ALS in October of 2023, by designating a student-athlete each year to wear his No. 21 jersey. The student-athlete selected must exemplify Poole's characteristics both on and off the field.

This year, r-junior RHP Carson Ballard (Alpharetta, Ga./Wesleyan HS) becomes the fourth Yellow Jacket to earn the honor, continuing the tradition begun by Jack Rubenstein in 2023, Ben King in 2024 and John Giesler last season.

"Carson Ballard is the epitome of what it means to be a student-athlete at Georgia Tech," head coach James Ramsey said. "He has been a mainstay on the ACC Academic Honor Roll as both a Biomedical Engineering major and a trusted arm for us over his three years with our program. He embodies the kind of dedication and love for Georgia Tech, both in the classroom and on the mound, that made Jim Poole such a beloved Tech Man. He has heard Jim's legacy preached since he stepped on campus. Not only about what a great pitcher he was and the incredible MLB career he enjoyed, but the husband, father, coach and advisor that Jim was and the life after baseball that he earned through the hard work that he put in while in White & Gold. That work ethic is perfectly reflected in Carson. Beginning as a walk-on and working his way to becoming a focal point of our 2025 ACC regular season championship roster and now, becoming a scholarship player on a 2026 team that has hopes of being one of the very best to represent this incredible Institution. The No. 21 has a deserved venerable legacy here and Carson is the perfect player, leader and engineer to continue this tradition into 2026."

Ballard will wear No. 21, having shown a longstanding commitment to Poole's ideals – self-determination, a strong academic work ethic, and high moral fiber on and off the field. He is a three-time member of the ACC Academic Honor Roll, a two-time Academic All-ACC honoree and a member of the 2024 CSC Academic All-District Team. He is currently pursuing a degree in Biomedical Engineering.

On the diamond, Ballard is entering his fourth season as one of the more reliable arms on the Tech pitching staff that has shown dramatic improvements from his freshman season to now. He has made 30 appearances including seven starts over his two years on the active roster, collecting three wins and a 5.07 ERA, with 64 strikeouts over 71.0 innings pitched. He was leaned on most when the lights were brightest, pitching a team-high 14.2 innings against SEC competition last year and delivering 13 strikeouts and a .226 opponent's batting average over those appearances with a 4.30 ERA. He introduced a knuckleball into his arsenal last season, throwing it with great effect down the stretch, including heavily relying on it during his 4.0 innings of work in an elimination game at the Oxford Regional.

"It's an incredible honor and privilege to wear No. 21 this year," Ballard said. "I hear all the time about the legacy Jim Poole left behind at Tech. Not just as a player, but as a person who impacted so many people on and off the field. He's someone I strive to be more like every day. I'll do everything I can to honor him and his family and to wear his number with pride."

**ABOUT JIM POOLE**

Poole arrived on The Flats in 1985 and had an immediate impact, as Georgia Tech baseball would win the first of four-straight ACC Tournament Championships. During his four years, he pitched in 120 games and struck out 263 batters in 188 innings. He still ranks first in the Tech record book with 22 career saves, including 10 as a junior and nine as a senior. He was named all-ACC his last two seasons. Poole would be enshrined into the Georgia Tech Sports Hall of Fame just nine years later in 1997.

A stellar worker in the classroom, Poole elected not to turn professional after being selected in the 34th round of the 1987 MLB Draft by the LA Dodgers, and returned to Georgia Tech for his senior year, recording a 2.03 ERA and 113 strikeouts in only 71 innings. Once again, the LA Dodgers would call his name in

the 1988 MLB Draft, this time taking him in the ninth round. He would return to graduate from the Institute with a degree in electrical engineering in 1990.

Poole played 11 years in the major leagues, predominantly with the Baltimore Orioles, Cleveland Indians, and San Francisco Giants. In 431 games played, he finished with 22 victories and a 4.31 ERA, as well as 256 strikeouts and four saves. He helped pitch Cleveland to two American League Championship Series (1995, 1998), making it to the 1995 World Series where he would face the Atlanta Braves.

Following his retirement at the end of the 2000 season, Poole returned to Georgia Tech to join the Alexander-Tharpe Fund as a fundraiser and supporter of the baseball program. He then began serving as the pitching coach at Johns Creek High School in 2010, teaching many young men about pitching mechanics, while also conveying his personal pitching philosophy.

He later joined the business world as a Personal Wealth Advisor for the Baseball Division of BIP Wealth.

After being diagnosed with ALS in 2021, Poole worked tirelessly to raise awareness for the disease. In addition to serving on MLB ALS boards, he also worked with Georgia Tech, who together hosted an ALS Awareness Day during the 2022 baseball season, with Tech wearing Jim Poole shirts and both teams wearing honorary wristbands. Professional players also wore the shirt. Tech later designated the number 21 each year to be worn by a student-athlete who exemplify Poole's ideals – self-determination, a strong academic work ethic, and high moral fiber on and off the field.

- The Jackets will face nine of their top 10 most common opponents again in 2026 but will not play Virginia in the regular season.

- Tech extended its winning streak against Georgia Southern to eight games in a row, dating back to 2022, with an 25-1 win in Statesboro earlier this year. GT set a new record when it hung 25-runs on Georgia Southern - the most in the 144 game history of the series, while also tying the program record with 19 strikeouts from the pitching staff.

He hit 26 homers in 2024 but one was not official, since the game was called off for rain before enough innings were played.
- His freshman year, Burress became the 1st Yellow Jacket to ever slug over .800 with at least 200 at bats. His .821 slugging percentage led all Division I freshman and was 6th overall among those with 200+ ABs.

- Not only did Burress turn heads with his bat but he also set the Georgia Tech record for the most assists by an outfielder in a single season, gunning down 10 runners from his spot in center field in 2024
- In 2025, he was the only player from a Power 4 conference with at least 60 RBI (62), 20 doubles (23), 50 walks (53), 15 HR (19) and 70 runs (77).
- Last season, he led the ACC in extra base hits (43) and doubles (23) while finishing 2nd in the conference in home runs (19) and runs (77).

- He became the fastest Yellow Jacket in program history to reach 30 career home runs – doing so in just 73 games, a full 20 games faster than the previous record holder, Kevin Parada and faster than legendary Tech sluggers such as Jason Varitek, Mark Teixeira and Nomar Garciaparra.
- Burress was named a semifinalist for both the Dick Howser Trophy and the USA Baseball Golden Spikes Award for the second year in a row. One of only two players in the nation to do so (also FSU's Jamie Arnold).
- This season, Burress becomes the first Yellow Jacket to ever wear a "C" on his jersey as the team's permanent captain.

## A NEW ERA OF TECH BASEBALL

- **James Ramsey** became the 13th Head Coach in Georgia Tech baseball history this past summer, taking over for the legendary Danny Hall, who retired at the end of his 32nd season on The Flats.
- This is Ramsey's first season as head coach but his 8th year at Georgia Tech, after being associate head coach and recruiting coordinator for the past five seasons and an assistant coach for the two years prior to that.
- He has signed four Top 5 ranked recruiting classes and coached 22 All-ACC, 7 All-American, 5 Freshman All-American, 5 All-ACC, 2 ACC Freshmen of the Year hitters including one National Freshman of the Year (Drew Burress).
- He has coached 17 draft picks on the offensive side and three semifinalists for both the Golden Spikes Award (Kevin Parada, Drew Burress and Kyle Lodise) and the Dick Howser Award (Kyle McCann, Kevin Parada and Drew Burress).
- Ramsey is the first ACC Player of the Year to ever become an ACC Head Coach
- He was an ABCA National Player of the Year at Florida State, where he led his team to the College World Series twice - 2010 & 2012

- Since Ramsey took over the Georgia Tech offense in 2019, the Yellow Jackets have been among the very best in the vaunted Atlantic Coast Conference.

Last season, Tech set a program record, going 37 games without recording a loss from a starting pitcher.

This season, it took until the 20th game for a Tech pitcher to get saddled with a loss, when Jackson Blakely saw his inherited runners score for a total of 6 earned runs over his outing.

Last season, against Western Carolina, all three starters recorded wins, marking the first time that's happened over a three-game series since 2020 vs. Ohio State.

Underwood became the first true freshman to start on opening weekend since 2022.

Blakely recorded nine strikeouts in his first career start, vs. Georgia State on Feb. 24 - it was the most strikeouts by any Tech pitcher in their first career start since at least the turn of the century

Angelakos was excellent in his first career start, pitching 5.0 innings with 2 hits, five strikeouts and zero walks, becoming the first Tech pitcher to throw 5.0 scoreless innings in his first career start since Carson Ballard, against Georgia State back in 2024.
