LEADING OFF

- Duke travels to No. 3 Georgia Tech for the final road conference series of the Blue Devils' season, with the Yellow Jackets serving as the second consecutive top-three team Duke has faced in conference action. Duke is set to take on back-to-back top-three foes in ACC play for the first time since 2007, when the Blue Devils took on No. 3 Virginia (April 6-8, 2007) and No. 2 North Carolina (April 13-15, 2007) in consecutive three-game sets.

- Duke is coming off four consecutive games against No. 2 North Carolina, taking one of three in a conference series on April 23-25, before dropping a non-conference contest in Chapel Hill on Sunday, May 3, and a Tuesday night setback to Queens.

- In the ACC series against the Tar Heels, the Blue Devils played to a close 3-1 defeat in the series opener before taking the second contest, 3-1, behind a career outing by **Peter Lemke**. North Carolina claimed the series with a run-rule win in the rubber match.

- Lemke, Duke's projected Friday starter against the Yellow Jackets, worked 7.2 innings on the mound against North Carolina, while getting tagged for a single run that scored after he exited in the eighth inning. The transfer from Division III Denison set new personal bests for innings pitched and total pitches (101) at the D-I level and earned his second win of the season.

- Duke scored all three of its runs in the first frame, with a fielding error and throwing error allowing both base runners, **Kaden Smith** and **Matthew Strand**, along with the batter, **Michael DiMartini**, to round the bases and touch home plate.

- Strand has started at catcher in all but two games since February 28, after both Cider Canon and Nolan Johnson suffered early injuries this season. Catcher was a position of strength entering the season, but Strand has taken on the bulk role in stride.

- Overall, the third-string catcher has evolved into one of Duke's most dangerous bats, with a .305 average at the plate, a .989 OPS and a team-high 36 RBI. The Sanford transfer led the team at the plate in March and hit seven home runs, with 22 RBI. Strand slashed .365/.423/.794 across 16 games in March and two of his homers were grand slams against ACC competition.

- Smith and DiMartini both registered multi-homer games against Queens. Smith, Duke's designated hitter since the spring transfer returned from a stress fracture in his leg, reached double-digit homers with his two blasts against the Royals. DiMartini hit his seventh and eighth homers of the season on Tuesday night.

- INF **Coltin Quagliano** ranks as the second-best infielder in the country for defensive runs saved (DRS), at 14.66. Quagliano is just one of two position players in top six nationally for DRS and has made several highlight plays on defense, including a jump throw from the third-base foul territory to get the batter at first base at NC State. The graduate has played and started at the hot corner in all but one game this season.

- INF/OF **RJ Hamilton** has been a steady starter, consistently batting second in Duke's lineup. The transfer from Vanderbilt is slashing .327/.430/.528 and blasted the sixth home run of his season in the first inning against Queens on Tuesday, May 5. The speedster is the only Blue Devil with at least 20 stolen bases and is 25-for-29 on the basepaths.

- Hamilton had a hitting streak reach 15 games with a base knock in the first game of the doubleheader at Boston College, but after having his streak snapped in the nightcap against the Eagles, he has logged at least one hit in all but one game since, good for a stretch of at least one hit in 20 of his last 22 games.

- Duke currently sits at 132 stolen bases this season, tied for eighth in the country.

- The Blue Devils set a new program record for stolen bases in a season on March 31, with a double steal in the first inning against Davidson that moved the Blue Devils' season total to 108, surpassing the previous record of 106.

- INF **Collin Anderson** has stepped into a consistent starting role for Duke's infield and led Duke at the plate in its three-game series against Louisville April 2-4. The freshman went 7-of-13 (.538), including a double and a home run. On defense, Anderson made several highlight plays at both second base and shortstop, while committing just four errors all season. At NC State, Anderson flashed the leather in the Sunday finale, with a diving stop at second to end a Wolfpack threat in the late innings.

- OF **Tyler Albright** has already worked 40 walks this season, 10th most nationally. The senior missed four games while in concussion protocol but through 39 games played, Albright is nearly 90% of the way to his previous season-high of 45, set last year in 62 games. The outfielder moved to leadoff to open the Miami series, with Albright's patience at the plate and base-running ability cited by Duke head coach **Corey Muscara** for the shift in lineup. Albright has also absorbed seven hit-by-pitches, and currently holds the best on-base percentage of his career (.441).

SCORE FIRST, SCORE OFTEN

The name of the game is scoring first and scoring in bunches for the Blue Devils. Since 2016, Duke has compiled a 237-80 (.749) record when scoring first and a staggering 265-60 (.815) record when scoring three or more runs in an inning.

10+ RUNS = WINS

Since 2023, Duke has collected a record of 66-3 (.957) when scoring 10-plus runs in a contest. In 2023, the Blue Devils posted an impressive 18-0 record on the diamond, while in 2024 they tallied a mark of 18-1. In 2025, the Blue Devils tallied a 20-0 record when scoring 10-plus runs in a contest. So far this season, Duke is 9-2 when reaching the threshold.

WALKING OFF AS WINNERS

Duke has registered three walk-off victories so far this season, with two coming in ACC play. **Kaden Smith** plated the winning run with a single against Notre Dame, **Coach Muscara's** first conference victory of his head coaching tenure. **Brooks Perez** left the yard in the bottom of the seventh against Miami, putting Duke up by 10 runs. Smith once again played the hero against East Carolina, with a three-run shot with one out and the Blue Devils trailing by two.

WINNING BY RUN RULE

Duke run-ruled Miami last Sunday, 20-10, with at least two runs in four of its six trips to the plate. Six different players finished with at least two RBI, led by **Matthew Strand's** six-RBI day with a grand slam in the first inning and a two-run homer in the third inning. **Kaden Smith** and **Brooks Perez** joined Strand in leaving the yard, with Smith tallying his third homer of his season and Perez ending the game in the bottom of the seventh with a two-run shot. The Blue Devils have tallied four run-rule victories so far this season.

RUNNIN' WILD

A key philosophy under Coach Muscara will be Duke's aggressiveness on the basepaths. Through 48 games, the Blue Devils have demonstrated the willingness to run at any given moment, with 132 stolen bases - a new single-season program record that ranks tied for eighth nationally and second in the ACC.

CONTINUED COOMBS CONSTRUCTION

Renovations began following the 2024 season, and the 2025 season saw updated dimensions, a new playing surface and MLB quality dugouts. New to Coombs this year is Duke's bullpen behind the left field fence and construction began on the David Koch Jr. Player Performance Center on Feb. 23, with expected completion in mid to late November 2026.

PLAYER PERFORMANCE CENTER 101

The 8,000 square foot facility, designed by EwingCole and built by LeChase Construction Services, will feature a pitching lab, hitting lab, and training lab, with direct access to Jack Coombs Field. Duke student-athletes will be able to utilize several developmental technologies, including Trajekt, iPitch, NewtForce, Trackman and KinaTrax.

Through 11 starts this season, **Aidan Weaver** holds a record of 4-6, and has attacked the Friday role, tossing 51.1 innings this season after throwing a combined 53.1 innings in his first three seasons as a Blue Devil.

Weaver opened the season with 5.0 innings against Maine, striking out four and allowed two earned runs. The following Friday, Weaver once again went 5.0 innings, with nine K's and another pair of earned runs. Against Princeton, he posted a career-high 7.0 innings and 89 pitches, while striking out another nine batters and walking just one. His best outing of the year so far came in Duke's shutout win over Miami, where Weaver threw the first six innings, allowing just two hits and striking out eight.

The senior punched out double-digit hitters for the first time in his career with 11 K's at Florida State, in 5.2 innings of work, while allowing just two runs on four hits

MORE ON WEAVER

Coach Muscara has talked about Weaver's multiple preseason adjustments, including a move to the first-base side of the rubber. The shift has allowed Weaver's pitch mix (fastball, slider, changeup) to work more effectively for batters on both side of the plate.

The senior currently leads the team with 70 strikeouts and has only walked 25 batters, a 2.80 K-BB ratio

LEARNING ABOUT LEMKE

After a midseason injury to Duke's Saturday arm, Matthew Nochowitz, Duke has consistently turned to Denison transfer **Peter Lemke** for the middle game of weekend sets. Lemke made his first Division I start against Louisville on April 2, earning the win with 5.2 IP, five strikeouts and just one ER on four hits.

LEMKE IN MARQUEE ACC WEEKENDS

Duke's weekend set at No. 3 Georgia Tech represents yet another opportunity for Lemke to pitch against a top conference squad.

While still working out of the bullpen, Lemke threw four innings, while allowing just three runs, at Florida State. The right hander was tagged with the loss in start at Boston College, but was praised for his outing, bouncing back from three runs and two hits in the first inning to finish with five innings and just one more hits allowed across the remainder of his day.

Lemke's career outing came against No. 2 North Carolina, where he earned the win after tossing 7.2 innings and getting tagged for just one run -- which crossed the plate after he left the mound.

LEON STEADY AS HE GOES

The Blue Devils' typical Sunday starter, **Andy Leon**, started the season on a pitch limit after undergoing internal brace surgery last season. The Columbia transfer has not slowed his production, regardless of limits, punching out 42 across 47.0 innings. In his win against Milwaukee, Leon faced one over the minimum after a single HBP and exited after 4.0 innings and 60 pitches without allowing a hit.

At 10th-ranked Florida State, Leon struck out nine and allowed just one run in 5.1 innings to help Duke take the series finale, 11-4. The veteran presence steadied Duke after the Blue Devils lost the first two at NC State, silencing the Wolfpack offense to the tune of 6.0 IP, two hits and just one run

INNOVATING THE LEADERSHIP MODEL IN COLLEGE BASEBALL

The Blue Devils signaled its intentional investment in its student-athletes with the announcement of **Mike Salvino** as the program's General Manager. Salvino will help ensure Duke competes at the highest level, while positioning each individual for meaningful careers and impact through the "Beyond Baseball" framework. Salvino steps into the role with a goal of building championship teams while also mentoring student-athletes on how to grow their personal brands and prepare for professional careers beyond the game.

TWO PRESEASON ALL-AMERICANS

Michael DiMartini and Cider Canon both earned preseason All-America nods from the National Collegiate Baseball Writers Association (NCBWA). DiMartini, a transfer from Dayton, earned 1st Team All-America recognition after hitting .403 in 55 games as a sophomore. He logged 11 doubles, seven triples and 14 home runs, while tallying 65 RBI and an 1.150 OPS. Canon, who was recruited out of high school as a catcher, picked up Fourth Team honors following a sophomore campaign highlighted by a .371 average in 48 games, with 16 doubles, three triples, 17 home runs and a 1.193 OPS.

DUKE TO THE PROS

Since 2013, the Blue Devils have had 50 players selected in the MLB Draft and an additional four free agent signings. Out of those 50 selected players, 34 have been pitchers. James Tallon, Owen Proksch, Andrew Healy and Wallace Clark were the four representing Duke in the 2025 draft. The draft class marked the fifth consecutive season that four or more Blue Devils heard their name called in the draft and it marked the most selections inside the top-10 rounds in program history, with all four selected in the ninth round or better.

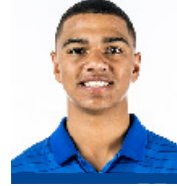
