

2026 Georgia Tech Football Student Ticket Policy

Georgia Tech students must meet one of the following criteria to be eligible to claim/purchase a student ticket for games at Bobby Dodd Stadium:

1. Must be an enrolled full-time undergraduate student
2. Graduate/Intern/Co-Op/Part-Time student

A list of eligible students is provided to the GTAA by the GT Registrar. Students who are deemed eligible may purchase student season tickets.

Eligible students have two options for student tickets at Bobby Dodd Stadium:

OPTION 1: RESERVED STUDENT SEASON TICKETS

General Information

- Students have two reserved season ticket seating options:
 - 1) Reserved block seating in the North Endzone (includes general student SWARM Block)
 - 2) Reserved general seating in the South Endzone (Sections 133-136)
- Sales for the North and South Endzone will open at the same time and will close when capacity is exhausted. North endzone reserved student season tickets regularly sell out. If and when this occurs, all remaining student season ticket sales will be in the south endzone, regardless of block preference.

North Endzone Block Seating (\$115)

- All block seating, including the SWARM Block, will be located in the North Endzone. Approximately 5,100 seats are available in the North Endzone. Blocks require at least 10 members. If a block does not hit the minimum number of members, it will be added to the general SWARM block.
- Students purchasing season tickets in the North endzone will have 2 options for seating selection:
 - Register as part of a student organization group, including greek chapters.
 - Register and sit in the 'SWARM'
 - The "SWARM" block will include the sections to the right of the Georgia Tech Marching Band (if you are looking from the field) – sections 117L-120. Seating is general admission each game.
- Deadline for block changes will be 11:59PM on Monday, August 24, 2026.
- Wristbands are required to enter the North Endzone Student Section. Please see the "Wristband Information" of this ticket policy for more information

South Endzone Seating (\$115)

- Student seating in the South endzone will be in Sections 133-136. Seating in these sections will be general admission.
- Once purchased in the South Endzone, season ticket holders cannot complete a block change to the North Endzone.
- Wristbands are required to enter the South Endzone. Please see the "Wristband Information" of this ticket policy for more information

OPTION 2: FREE SINGLE-GAME TICKET DISTRIBUTION

General Information

- Single-game tickets will be distributed the week of the game on a first-come, first-served basis based on availability.
- Free single game ticket distribution for students will occur in the Goldzone, sections 210-217 in the upper north endzone. Should student sections 133-136 not sell out for season tickets, these sections will be used for single game ticket distribution as well. Students who claim a ticket in the Goldzone must sit in the section, row, and seat that is assigned to them on their ticket as this area is sold to the general public as well.
- All single-game tickets must be reserved online at ramblinwreck.com/students. Once a ticket has been claimed, you will receive a confirmation email and link to download ticket.
- Single-game student ticket holders do not need a wristband to enter the game.

The Ticket Claim period opens the Tuesday of game week at 10:00am and lasts until ticket supply is exhausted.
Students cannot purchase a season ticket and claim a single-game ticket.

Wristband Information

- Student season ticket holders in the North and South Endzones will be required to wear wristbands to enter the student section.
- Students must wear the corresponding wristband for each home game at Bobby Dodd Stadium. Wristbands will display the GAME, color and section each student's ticket is assigned to.
- **Wristbands will be distributed for the entire season prior to the first home game by the Georgia Tech Ticket Office. Each student season ticket holder will be required to pick-up their own wristbands. Block leaders will NOT be able to collect wristbands for their entire group.**
- To maintain safety and security of the student sections, wristbands must be worn securely fastened on your wrist and cannot slip on and off. Any wristband that is NOT securely fastened, has been tampered with, stretched, or duplicated, will be denied entry to the student section and referred to the North concourse ticket office resolution table OR Gate 7 GTAA ticket office location for resolution.
- Anyone caught counterfeiting wristbands will lose their GTAA ticketing privileges for the season.

Gameday Entrance Procedures

- **All student season tickets will be delivered via Mobile Delivery. You will receive an Apple Wallet/Google Pay version of your season ticket. You must present your mobile ticket at the gate upon entry to the stadium.**
- Students with tickets in the North End Zone in Sections 113-120 must enter through Gate 7 (Callaway Plaza) and students with tickets in the South End Zone in Sections 133-136 must enter through Gate 10 (North Ave & Techwood Dr.).
- **Wristbands as well as tickets are required upon entry into any student season ticket section.**
- Students with single game claim tickets in the Goldzone must enter through Gate 4 or 5 (Bobby Dodd Way).

Student Away Game Tickets

- Students will have the opportunity to purchase full price tickets to select GT away games.
- Tickets can be purchased now online at ramblinwreck.com/tickets.
- Seat assignment for away games is first-come, first-served. If you wish to sit with a friend, tickets must be purchased together or seating preference notated in the comments box when ordering.

Block Seating Locations

- Block seating assignments will be made by student leadership in conjunction with the GTAA based on overall group attendance from 2025 (tracked via ticket scans).

Student Behavior Policy

- Misconduct at GT football games will be subject to review by the Office of Student Integrity and will result in forfeiture of student ticket for the next home game.
- Misconduct includes but is not limited to:
 - Violent or aggressive behavior.
 - Excessive public intoxication.

Resale Policy

- Georgia Tech students are prohibited from reselling football student tickets (home or road) and wristbands (including creation of counterfeit wristbands) for profit. Students found to be in violation of this policy will be penalized. Penalties include the cancellation of season tickets or single-game tickets, cancellation of tickets already purchased or claimed, and the loss of student ticket privileges. Students can transfer tickets to other Georgia Tech Students free of charge by logging in to their student account at www.ramblinwreck.com/students.
